Nine men trapped in swollen **Tawi river rescued**

Kashmir gets relief from heat after rains

STATE TIMES NEWS

JAMMU/SRINAGAR: Nine men were rescued Wednesday in a joint operation by police and SDRF teams after they were trapped in the Tawi river following a sudden rise in the water level due to rains that lashed many parts of Jammu and Kashmir, officials said

Heavy rains also disrupted along traffic Jammu Srinagar national highway for over three hours this morning, while a couple of vehicles were also washed away due to overflowing of a stream in Rajouri district, the officials said.

Madan Lal (52), a labourer, had gone for sand extraction in the Tawi around 8.45 am but got trapped due to sudden rise in the water level near Jewel chowk bridge in the city.

He was rescued by State Disaster Response Force personnel who

Eight more people, including some who had gone for "Pind Daan', were rescued in a joint operation by police, traffic cops, SDRF and local volunteers, the officials said. Several trapped horses were also rescued during the operation, the officials said. A traffic department triggered by heavy rains blocked Jammu-Srinagar national highway at Mehad and T2 tunnel in Ramban area around 6.30 am, forcing suspension of traffic from both sides. 

CBSE Class-10 board exams twice a year from 2026

First phase mandatory, second optional

STATE TIMES NEWS NEW DELHI: From 2026, Class-10 students will be able to take CBSE board exams twice in an academic session but it will be mandatory for them to appear for the first phase in February, officials said on Wednesday.

The second phase scheduled in May will be optional for students who wish to improve their performance. In case a student appears for both the phases, the best score of the two will be retained, they said.

The Central Board of Education


In 2021, the government Productionannounced Linked Incentive (PLI) schemes for 14 sectors with an outlay of Rs 1.97 lakh crore.

Shubhanshu Shukla enroute ISS, India returns to human spaceflight after 41 years; 'Kamaal ki ride thi'

NEW DELHI: Astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla was on Wednesday headed to the International Space Station (ISS) on a historic odyssey marking India's return to human spaceflight after a gap of 41 years following a successful launch of the Axiom Space mission in the US with a four-member multi-country crew

After multiple delays, Elon Musk's SpaceX launch vehicle with Crew Dragon spacecraft atop a Falcon-9 rocket blasted off from the Kennedy Space Center in Florida at 12:01 pm(IST) carrying mission pilot Shukla, a Group Captain in the Indian Air Force(IAF), former NASA astronaut Commander Peggy Whitson and mission specialists Tibor Kapu of Hungary and Slawosz



Uznanski-Wisniewski of Poland. Family members, scores of well wishers and space enthusiasts gathered at watch parties across India, Poland, Hungary and the US burst into cheers as the rocket soared into the Florida sky from the same spot from where

American astronaut Neil Armstrong, who was the first person to set foot on the moon, took off on the Apollo-11 mission in July 1969.

"Kya kamaal ki ride thi (what an amazing ride)," India's astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla remarked as

SpaceX's Dragon spacecraft entered the orbit around the earth within 10 minutes of launch from NASA's spaceport in Florida.

Shukla, who became the second Indian to travel to space, spoke in chaste Hindi to announce India's return to space after a gap of 41 years, and urged everyone to be a part of his journey.

"The Tiranga (Tricolour) on my shoulders tells me that I am not alone and I am with all of you," the 39-year-old fighter pilot-turnedastronaut said in his first remarks from the earth's orbit.

"Namaskar, my dear countrymen. What a ride! We have returned to space after a gap of 41 years and what an amazing ride it was ('kya kamaal ki ride thi')," he said

"We are orbiting the earth at a speed of 7.5 km per second... This journey to the International Space

Union Cabinet wishes Shubhanshu Shukla's mission success

NEW DELHI: The Union Cabinet on Wednesday welcomed the success ful launch of the Axiom-4 mission to the International Space Station featuring Indian astronaut Shubhanshu Shukla and three others.

Shukla and three other astronauts embarked on a journey to the International Space Station onboard the Dragon spacecraft that was placed in an orbit around the Earth by the Falcon-9 rocket of SpaceX.

"We welcome the successful launch of the Space Mission carrying astronauts from India, Hungary, Poland and the US," read the resolution adopted at the meeting of the Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The Union Cabinet noted that Group Captain Shubhanshu Shukla is on the way to becoming the first Indian to go to the International Space Station, Information and Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said, reading from the resolution.

"He carries with him the wishes, hopes and aspirations of 1.4 billion Indians. Wish him and other astronauts all the success," the Cabinet resolution said. The astronauts are expected to dock at the International Space Station on Thursday evening.
