

Poonch teacher killed by Pak shelling dubbed as terrorist by two national channels Legal notice seeking Rs 5 cr compensation each served upon 2 national TV channels

STATE TIMES NEWS JAMMU: The family members of Qari Mohd. Iqbal, a teacher who died on May 7, 2025 due to cross border Pak Shelling at Poonch have served a legal notice upon Zee News (A unit of Zee Media Corporation Ltd) and News 18 India(A unit of Network 18 Group) seeking damages/compensation to the tune of Rs 05 Crore each for airing/broadcasting a false, highly misleading and slanderous news item pertaining to Qari Mohd Iqbal, son of Peer Baksh, resident of Baila, Tehsil Mandi, District Poonch who died on May 7, 2025 at District Hospital Poonch because of Pakistan's Shelling but the two leading News Channels of the country maliciously labelled the deceased as a hardcore Terrorist associated with Lashkar-e-Toiba/Hizbul Mujahideen and further claimed that the deceased Teacher was on the most wanted hit-list of NIA and was killed by Indian Forces in a Terrorist Camp at Kotli (POK).

The News Channels also claimed that the deceased Qari Mohd Iqbal had played a pivotal role in the Pulwama Terrorist Attack and Indian Forces were in search of this 'Khoon khaar Commander'.

In the legal notice served through S S Ahmed & Associates Advocates, it has been alleged that the damage caused by the misleading/malicious reporting to the deceased and his family members is irreparable and is a classic example of Yellow/unethical Journalism and the said News items also exhibited the high level of carelessness, gross misconduct and lack of responsibility on the part of the two Channels as despite government advisories/Press Council of India guidelines and norms of journalistic ethics, the story of War like situation was carried out without verifying its contents from genuine Government sources and an innocent teacher was dubbed as a "dreaded terrorist" aligned to outlawed terrorist organisations and the damage which is irreparable can only be indemnified by paying exemplary damages quantified as Rupees 05 Crore each to the family members of the deceased teacher as no apology of any kind can repair the damage caused to the reputation of the deceased and his family mem-

A period of three weeks has been given to the Management of the two Channels to do the needful.

CAT quashes SSB's advt notification as same relates to post of Forester Jmu Division

JAMMU: A Bench of Central Administrative Tribunal (CAT) comprising Sanjeev Gupta (J) and Pragya Sahay Saksena (A) quashed the Advt Notification no. 04 of 2022 dated July 27, 2022 issued by the Service Selection Board in so far as the same relates to the post of Forester Jammu Division. CAT after hearing Sr. Adv Abhinav Sharma with Adv Ravi Abrol for the petitioner also imposed costs of Rs 25000 on Chairman, Secretary and Controller of Examination J&KSSB for violation of interim order dated September 23, 2022 passed by this Tribunal to be paid to Advocates Welfare Fund, High Court of J&K, within a period of one month. The petitioners filed a present petition seeking setting aside the impurped Advertisement Notification no. 04 of 2025 dated July 27,2022 issued by the SSB in so far as the same relates to the post of Forester Jammu Division, figuring at serial no. 193 and also seeking direction to the Service Selection Board to provide minimum qualification for direct recruitment to the post of Forester as "Bachelor's degree in Science or equivalent qualification with at least one of the subject in Forestry, Botany, Zoology, Agriculture, Bio-Technology, Environmental Science, Horticulture, Science Subject" in pursuance of the judgment dated December 4, 2017 passed by the High Court in case titled "Mohd. Yousuf Ganai & Ors. Vs. State of Jammu and Kashmir and Ors.

CAT after hearing both the sides observed that it is also not discernible as to how the minimum qualification for a junior post is higher than that of a senior post, that is, the minimum qualification for the post of Forest Guard (which is lower than that of Forester) is Bachelor's Degree whereas that of the Forester is 10+2 with science subject. With these observations and in the facts and circumstances of the case, Original Application No. 1338 of 2022 and O.A. No. 1048 of 2024 are allowed and stand disposed and ordered that the Advertisement Notification no. 04 of 2022dated July 27, 2022 issued by the Service Selection Board in so far as the same relates to the post of Forester Jammu Division, figuring at serial no. 193 is quashed and also ordered that the notices dated July 10, 2024 and September 5, 2024 to the extent they relate to the post of Forester Jammu Division, issued by respondent no. 4 in O.A. No. 1048 of 2024 are also quashed.
