ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

◆ Integrated Dairy Development Scheme, 2020-21

AIM: To make J&K self-sufficient in milk production

- ◆ **1143 DAIRY UNITS** established employment for more than **2400 PEOPLE.**
- ◆ **50% SUBSIDY** for establishment of dairy units.
- ◆ **50% SUBSIDY** on processing & marketing of milk.
- ◆ Milk ATMs, transportation vans, Paneer making machines extended to more than **111 BENEFICIARIES.**
- ◆ **20 MILK CHILLING UNITS** installed.
- ◆ For the first time **ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION** done **FREE OF COST.**



SHEEP HUSBANDRY

◆ Integrated Sheep Development Program 2020-2021.

Innovative & Self Sustaining.

AIM: Making J&K Self-Sufficient in Mutton

- ◆ Sheep/goat units established on participatory mode.
- ◆ **882** (10 sheep units) & **201** (25 sheep units) established direct employment for **1083** people
- ◆ **290 SHEEP/GOAT UNITS** established.
- ◆ **300 PURE MERINO LAMB BIRTHS** RECORDED from the elite merino sheep imported from Australia.
- ◆ **300 LAMBS BORN** by crossing Australian sheep with kashmir Merino.
- ◆ **2300 ELITE RAMS/BUCKS** distributed for genetic up gradation of livestock.
- ◆ Around **1000 RAMS/BUCKS** produced and distributed to livestock farmers.



VETERINARY HEALTH

- ◆ **66 MOBILE CLINICS** Service including **44 MOBILE VETERINARY CLINICS** with lift & **22 AMBULANCE** without lift made available.
- ◆ **27 LAC BOVINES VACCINATED** against Foot & Mouth disease.



POULTRY

Poultry Development Scheme 2020-21

AIM: To cut down imports & bridge the demand & supply gap.

- ◆ **50% FINANCIAL SUPPORT** for insurance of poultry birds, purchase of farm equipment/machinery.
- ◆ Support for establishment of **POULTRY FARMS, HATCHERIES PROCESSING UNITS.**



FISHERIES

- ◆ Coverage of **KISSAN CREDIT CARD SCHEME** to fisheries sector for the first time.
- ◆ More than **15,000 FISHERMEN** Benefitted.
- ◆ Capital support to
 - ◆ **1838 FISHERMEN** for **INDIVIDUAL HOUSES**
 - ◆ **184 FISHERMEN** for **'TROUT FISH UNIT'**
 - ◆ **37 FISHERMEN** for **'CARP FISH UNIT'**
- ◆ Support for biofloc Tanks at **3 LAC PER FISHERMEN** provided for the first time.



MAKING J&K SELF-SUFFICIENT IN FODDER

◆ Integrated Fodder Development Scheme 2020-21

AIM: To make Jammu & Kashmir self-sufficient both in green & dry fodder.

Incentives for establishment of CATTLE FEED PLANTS, FODDER CULTIVATION & OTHER SUCH ACTIVITIES.

- ◆ **11 FEED PLANTS ESTABLISHED**
- ◆ Hydroponic fodder plants, silage making plants, harvesters, bore wells, mini tractors, chaff cutters given to around **500 BENEFICIARIES**
