CRIME REPORT

Two absconders nabbed

REASI/RAJOURI: Police on Saturday nabbed two absconders who were evading their arrest since long. As per details, intensifying its drive against absconders, District Police Reasi on directions of SSP Amit Gupta arrested an absconder from Khawas area of Budhal, Rajouri. A team of Police Station Pooni led by Insp Vijay Sharma, under supervision of DySP Headquarters Iftkhar Ahmed arrested an absconder namely Mohd Shakeel, son of Bagh Hussain, resident of Keri Tehsil Khawas, who was involved in a theft case registered vide FIR No 48/2018 under section 379 of RPC and 49/2018 under section 379 of RPC at Police Station Pooni. The cases were proved during investigation and charge-sheet was presented but to avoid conviction, accused evaded trial proceedings and couldn't be apprehended. In both cases, two general warrants of arrest under section 512 of CrPC were issued against accused, by Court of JMIC Reasi. After developing specific information about presence of accused in Khawas, a Police team was sent to the area which, arrested absconder with help of local Police. Accused was produced in the Court of JMIC Reasi and both the warrants were executed.

Meanwhile, an absconder namely Mohd Younis, son of Talib Hussain, resident of Mulhut Teh Darhal, who was evading arrest since last 8 years, was arrested after strenuous efforts of Police teams led by SHO Darhal Insp Ashiq. The person was wanted in FIR No 01/2014 at Police Station Darhal registered under sections 451/147/323 of RPC. The absconder shall be produced before JMIC Thannamandi for further proceedings.

Photographer arrested for using drone in violation of Govt order

RAJOURI: Police on Saturday arrested a photographer for using drone in violation of Government order besides creating a security concern in the area.

As per details, on July 8, a reliable information was received at Police Station Kalakote that a drone - like object was found flying at Potha near Kesar Gaala, Kalakote, towards forest area. Due to this, a panic like situation emerged in the area and people in close vicinity of Potha got scared. Keeping present security scenario into consideration, teams from Police Station Kalakote led by SHO Deepak Pathania and assisted by PSI Amit Radhay and PSI Anis Choudhry, acted swiftly and started search at different locations. It was established that a Barat of one Kulwant Singh, son of Babu Ram, resident of village Swari Koteranka was moving from Swari to Daali. On reaching Potha, a videographer namely Rahul Sharma, son of Sudesh Sharma resident of Lower Paloura, Jammu, who was also accompanying barat, flew drone for taking some shots and then moved on.



A police team, after hectic efforts, arrested the erring videographer and seized drone as DM Rajouri had already banned flying of drones in district Rajouri through an order issued in June 2021. In this connection, FIR 61/22 under section 188 of IPC was registered at Police Station Kalakote.

Two narco-smugglers nabbed with 3 Kg opium, 994 gm Ganja

JAMMU: Police on Saturday nabbed two narco smugglers and recovered 3 Kg opium and 994 gm Ganja from their possession.

As per details, a team from Police Station Gangyal led by SHO Gangyal Inspector Joginder Singh Chib, while on Naka duty near Kunjwani area, rounded up a suspect with a vehicle (JK02AV 8157) when he was on his way from Kathua towards Gangyal. On search 3 Kg opium was recovered from the possession of accused, who was identified as Ramandeep Singh, son of Chanchal Singh, resident of Ward- 1 Simbal Camp, Jammu. He was arrested on the spot and FIR No 77/22 under sections 8/18 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Gangyal. The overall arrest and recovery in the case was made under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma. Similarly, during Naka by Police Station Kanachak, a team under the supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh led by SHO Kanachak Insp Kunal Singh Janwal rounded up a suspect identified as Sanjay Singh, son of Jagan Nath Singh, resident of Fatehpur, Uttar Pradesh. During search, 994 gm Ganja was recovered from his possession. The accused was arrested and a case under relevant sections was registered at Police Station Kanachak.

Two theft cases solved; two arrested, 20 stolen vehicles, items recovered

JAMMU: Police on Saturday solved two theft cases by arresting two thieves and recovered stolen items along with 20 stolen vehicles from their possession.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Satwari by one Ramesh Kumar, son of Late Banarasi Lal, resident of Mohalla Reyana, Hakkal, Chatha stating that someone, in night hours, broke into his locked house and decamped with stole household items. On this, FIR No 119/2022 under sections 457/380 of IPC was lodged and investigation started.

After this, a team of Police Station Satwari under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Satwari Insp Sameer Jeelani assisted by Incharge Police Post Chatha SI Ranjit Singh Chib, after putting in hectic efforts, rounded up two suspects namely Satish Nargotra, son of Jeet Raj, resident of Old Satwari and Happy Kumar, son of Babu Ram, resident of Prabhat colony near Peer Baba. During thorough questioning, accused confessed their involvement in crime and on their disclosure stolen items were recovered which included an Automatic Voltage Stabilizer; Servo Stabilizer; LPG cylinder of HP; Luminous Inverter; Samsung LED 32 inches and Pedestal Fan.

It is pertinent to mention that accused are notorious thieves and were also involved in various vehicle theft cases. Furthermore, 20 stolen vehicles were recovered from their possession.

HA10ERFHM13475. The overall arrests and recov-

eries were made under the supervision of SP South Mamta Sharma.

Shops, eateries booked during market inspection

SAMBA: A joint team of departments of Legal Metrology and Food Safety headed by Assistant Controller and Assistant Commissioner Food Safety inspected different establishments in district and lifted samples besides booking erring traders and imposing penalties.

The inspections were done in view of upcoming festival of Eid-ul-Adha, Baba Sidh Gouria Mela and ongoing Amarnath Yatra. During the inspection, markets of Swankha, Bari Brahmana, Vijaypur, Samba and adjoining areas were inspected by LMD teams, which visited meat markets, food stalls and other eateries, departmental stores, fruit and vegetable vendors and sweet shops. During inspection drive, 24 traders and Rs 72,500 penalty was realized.

Meanwhile, Food Safety Department Samba lifted 7 samples of different commodities and issued two Challans for unhygienic conditions. Pertinently, a mobile testing van has also been deployed by the Food Safety Department in the district. The district administration has appealed to traders to follow norms, guidelines and laws besides refraining from overcharging, selling substandard and adulterated food items.

31 bovines rescued, 6 smugglers arrested

POONCH: In its drive to tighten noose over bovine smugglers, Police on Saturday rescued 31 bovines from clutches of smugglers while foiling a smuggling bid in Surankote area. As per details, on directions of SSP Poonch Rohit Baskotra, teams led by DySP Surankote, SHO Surankote, Incharge Police Post Behramgalla, Incharge Police Post Poshana established Nakas at Behramgalla, Poshana and Surankote areas. During checking, police apprehended 6 bovine smugglers and seized 6 vehicles (JK11B 4762, JK17 4102, JK11F3412, JK12A 4198, JK02B 5525 & JK12A 3723) which were on the way towards Kashmir. FIRs No 193, 195, 196, 198, 199 & 202 under section 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act was registered at Police Station Surankote and investigation taken up.

Suspended cop among two arrested with heroin

JAMMU: Police on Saturday arrested two persons including a suspended cop and recovered heroin from their possession. As per details, a team from Police Station Jhajjar Kotli laid a Naka at Suketar and intercepted an Indica car, which was on its way to Jammu.

During checking, police recovered 2 gm heroin from the vehicle and arrested two persons, including a suspended police cop posted at District Police Lines (DPL) Jammu. The arrested persons were identified as Mohd Majeed (suspended police cop), resident of Kansai Pata District Reasi and Baldev Singh, resident of Samba. FIR No 176/2022 under relevant section of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Jhajjar Kotli and investigation started.

Bootlegger nabbed with 85 bottles of illicit liquor

SAMBA: Police on Saturday arrested a bootlegger and recovered 85 bottles of illicit liquor from his possession. As per details, acting on information received from reliable sources regarding sale of illicit liquor at village Swankha in Ramgarh, a party from Police Station Ramgarh led by SHO Insp Asha Nand, under supervision of SDPO Vijaypur, Priyanka Kumari apprehended one Khem Singh, son of Raghubir Singh, resident of Swankha, who was selling illicit liquor to general public at exorbitant rates to gain illegitimate profit.

During checking, a total of 85 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 59/2022 under section 48(a) Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station Ramgarh.
