10 gamblers arrested, stake money seized

SRINAGAR: Acting tough against social crimes, police on Thursday arrested 10 gamblers in Baramulla & Budgam and seized stake money from their possession. In Budgam, acting on specific information about gambling activities near Graveyard in Ompora area of Budgam, a party from Police Station Budgam raided specific site and arrested five gamblers on the spot, who were identified as Bashir Ahmed Shah, son of Sonaullah Shah, resident of Gousia Mohalla Ompora; Ab Rashid Hajam, son of Gh Mohammad Hajam, resident of Ompora; Mohammad Younis Dar, son of Ab Rashid Dar, resident of Chinari colony Ompora; Mohammad Ashraf Sheikh, son of Abdul Rehman Sheikh, resident of Choon Budgam and Bashir Ahmed Teli, son of Ghulam Ahmed Teli, resident of Ompora Budgam. Officers also seized stake money amounting to Rs 8,467 and playing cards from gamblers, who were shifted to police station where they remained in custody.

Similarly, Police in Baramulla received specific information about gambling activities at Alambal Mirgund Pattan, a party from Police Post Mirgund raided the specific spot and arrested five gamblers. Officers also seized stake money amounting to Rs 18,300 and playing cards from the gamblers, who were shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective Police Stations and investigation started.

Abducted minor girl recovered within hours, accused arrested

PULWAMA: Police on Thursday recovered an abducted minor girl within hours by arresting accused person involved in crime.

As per details, on July 13, 2022, Police Station Kakapora received an application from a man, resident of Naman Kakapora alleging therein that his minor daughter has been abducted by one Nadeem Nabi Wagay, son of Gh Nabi Wagay, resident of Kandajan Budgam.

In this regard, FIR No. 56/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Kakapora and investigation started. On receipt of information, a special Police team was constituted to trace out abducted girl, which after raiding various suspected locations and putting in strenuous efforts, traced out the abducted girl and recovered her from village Watkaloo in Chrar-e-Sharief, Budgam. The accused was also been arrested. After fulfilling all medico legal formalities, the girl was handed over to her legal heirs.

Woman drug peddler arrested, contraband recovered

Three found dead under mysterious circumstances

JAMMU: Three persons were found dead under mysterious circumstances on Thursday. As per details, some passersby on seeing body of a man lying near Salani Bridge in Rajouri, informed police which rushed to the spot and shifted it to morgue. The deceased was identified as Harish Chander, son of Late Bhola Ram, resident of Ward No 4, Rajouri.

Meanwhile, another body was found near Dudhar Nallah near Rehambal, Udhampur and was shifted to morgue. The deceased was identified as Ramesh, alias Lundi, son of Kasho, resident of Katra. Similarly, Ranjeet Barman, son of Bindu Barman, resident of West Bengal presently staying at Gangyal was also found dead in his house under mysterious circumstances. Police has registered all the cases and started investigations.

Two killed in road mishaps

Girl among two found hanging

Sarwal weapon recovery case: Hunt for absconding accused on

JAMMU: Police has now launched a massive manhunt to nab absconding person in connection with arms recovery from Sarwal area. After his arrest, police will get to know the actual plan behind hiding weapons.

He is currently hiding somewhere in Kashmir and Jammu Police has contacted Kashmir Police for nabbing him at the earliest. As per case, Bakshi Nagar police recovered two country-made pistols, one other pistol from motor-room of quarters, after they got input about some weapons hidden in Government quarters at Sarwal area on Tuesday night. Police has also detained a person from there who disclosed name of a gangster, presently lodged in jail.

GREF dumper fell into gorge; 3 killed, 3 injured

LADAKH: Three persons died while 3 other got injured after a GREF dumper fell into a gorge near Baralacha La pass in Ladakh.

As per details, a dumper carrying construction material for the ongoing construction work in the area slipped from road and fell into a deep gorge in Petsio area, near Baralacha La Pass. Locals informed the company of Indo Tibetan Border Police located nearby after which Jawans of 5th battalion ITBP rushed to the spot and started rescue operation. Jawans rescued all six persons from the vehicle and shifted them to nearest hospital, where doctors declared three of them as brought dead.

Woman nabbed heroin

KATHUA: Police on Thursday nabbed a woman drug peddler and recovered 8.50 gm heroin from her possession. As per details, a team of Women Police Station Kathua headed by PSI Anu Radha, Incharge Women Police Station Kathua under supervision of DySP Headquarters Shammi Kumar during patrolling/checking duty near Chak Drab khan noticed a suspicious woman and asked her to stop for checking. On thorough checking, approximately 8.50 gm Heroin (Chitta) like narcotics was recovered from her possession. Identified as Jyoti Devi, wife of Rahul Kumar, resident of Chak Drab Khan Tehsil & District Kathua, the accused woman was arrested and FIR No. 276/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against her at Police Station Kathua.
