

DC Jammu finalises arrangements for I-Day celebrations

JAMMU: Deputy Commissioner Avny Lavasa on Thursday convened a meeting of officers from different departments to finalise arrangements for smooth Independence Day celebrations in the district.

Commissioner JMC Rahul Yadav; ADC L&O Minga Sherpa; ADC ADM Satish Sharma; CPO Yoginder Katoch; ACG Rakesh Dubey; Deputy Director Information Jammu Vikas Sharma; besides senior officers from Security, Police, Traffic, Jal Shakti, PDD, Hospitality and Protocol, Health, Education, Sports and Youth Affairs, JKSRMTC and other officers of concerned departments were present in the meeting.

The meeting held threadbare discussions on

arrangements to be put in place at the venue for the National function, including security, seating, transportation, parking, electricity, refreshment, medicare, availability of ambulance, deployment of fire tenders and sanitation measures.

The meeting was informed that the main function of the celebrations would be held in the M.A Stadium, where the Chief Guest will unfurl the National Flag followed by inspection of parade and taking of the salute.

It was decided that the march-past will be presented by contingents of JKP, CRPF, Fire and Emergency, Forest Protection Force, Police Band which would be followed by a colorful cultural programme by students.

The celebration of the day would begin with the

playing of Shahnaai Vadan and patriotic songs by the Information Department in the wee hours. The Deputy Director Information was asked to arrange Public Address System (PAS) and Media for the smooth coverage of the nation event.

The meeting was informed that the main function of the celebrations would be held in the M.A Stadium, where the Chief Guest will unfurl the National Flag followed by inspection of parade and taking of the salute.

Officers from Municipal Corporation were directed by the Deputy Commissioner to ensure proper sanitation and cleanliness of the main venue and the city as a whole.

The DC also instructed the Chief Education Officer to select the contingents and students for the national anthem and cultural programme.

Officials from JKSRMTC were asked to make arrangements for transportation for children participating in cultural items during rehearsals and the day of the main event. Concerned departments were also instructed to arrange the refreshment for the students during rehearsals.

The concerned departments were asked to ensure proper arrangements related to security, sanitation, seating arrangements, barricading, water supply, power supply, issuance of invitation cards, fire tenders and illumination of important buildings etc on the Independence Day.

The DC also instructed the Chief Education Officer to select the contingents and students for the national anthem and cultural programme.

Preparedness of JKERA on projects proposed under ADB, JICA funding reviewed

JAMMU: Secretary, Planning, Development and Monitoring Department (PDMD), Dr. Raghav Langer on Thursday chaired a meeting to review the preparedness of J&K ERA on the projects proposed to be funded with the financial assistance of ADB (Asian Development Bank) and JICA (Japan International Cooperation Agency) at Civil Secretariat here.

The meeting was attended by Director Planning and Coordination, JTFPR; Iftikhar Hakim; Director Technical, JTFPR; Iftikhar Wani; Director Kashmir, JKERA; Javaid Bukhari; Director Jammu JKERA; Ajay Kumar Raju; Director Finance JKERA; Tasawif Amin; Project Manager, JKERA; Ishtiyaq Malik; Project Manager Transport JKERA; Jammal Ashok Khokar; Project Manager Urban, Jammu, Nand Kishore and other concerned officials of the allied

departments.

Speaking during the meeting, Secretary, PDMD directed the officers of JKERA to be ready with the lists and Preliminary Projects Reports of tentative projects to be taken up under the proposed ADB Loan-III and JICA after due consultations with the line departments especially PW(R&B), Jal Shakti and Housing and Urban Development Department. He highlighted that the proper consultations with all the line departments associated with these projects will pave way for successful execution of these prestigious projects. Director Planning & Coordination, JTFPR

informed the meeting that under these mega infrastructure projects proposed to be financed by ADB and JICA, JTFPR intends to undertake the projects for the Construction of integrated sewerage, water supply & storm water drainage schemes for the Greater Srinagar and Greater Jammu cities to provide the people living in these rapidly expanding cities with basic urban facilities; besides Urban Transport, Solid Waste Management as well as Capacity Building.

The Secretary was also informed that projects worth Rs 1100 Crore and Rs 4600 Crore were originally proposed

to be taken up under these expected MFP through ADB-III & JICA; which would pave way for further strengthening and expansion of urban infrastructure in the UT.

Peripherally, the ADB mission had previously apprised the JKERA to propose sub-projects that are outcome oriented, provide comprehensive end-to-end solutions to the entire city/town, like 24*7 water supply with at least 5 years O&M, sewerage interventions from house connections-network-sewage treatment plant-reuse of treated waste water; integrated municipal solid waste management from source segregation-collection-transportation-reuse/recycling and disposal; urban road improvement works with O&M component and Part of the integrated plan of the subsector. The major project conceived earlier under JICA funding, was 3-stage lift bulk water supply scheme for Jammu City from river Chenab.


