JAMMU: President Dogra Sadar Sabha (DSS), Th Gulchain Singh Charak, while addressing a session with its senior members, amplified the prevailing countrywide unrest with special reference to Kashmir, Kolkata and Rajasthan. There have been numerous threats to life elsewhere and the nation is undergoing a tense, disturbed state of life detrimental to the path of peace, progress and development, he said. He admired the role of security forces in successfully containing terror in Kashmir reducing it to barely surviving on Pakistani support system for its last breaths.

The former minister pointed out that the UT placed great hopes and trust into the happenings of post abrogation of Articles 370 & 35A. "We understand that the whole machinery needed an overhaul and that process is taking time. At the same time there are wide gaps between what is planned, declared, announced, notified and its ground delivery. Corruption only seems to have changed hands. What is not 'greased', does not move. There is a total disconnect between the people and the ruling 'lords', obviously, in absence of a popular government. The gap can be bridged if the bureaucracy comes out of the confines of their cozy chambers and for once go to public and behave like 'public servants'. 'Back to Village' programme has been archived with many such progressive plans and schemes launched from time to time. Bureaucrats are still used to their old 'dynastic rulers' practices. Many have dynastic fiefdoms within the chambers and corridors of power down to Babus & Daftars.

Pre-Matric Scholarships Scheme for Scheduled Castes & Others

Pre-Matric Scholarships Scheme for Scheduled Castes & Others Run by the Ministry Of Social Justice & Justice & Empowerment is a scholarship scheme implemented through State Governments and UT administrations. It aims to provide Scholarships to SC and other disadvantaged category students. Students studing in India are eligible for the scheme, which will be awarded by the Government of the State/ Union Territory to which the applicant belongs i.e where he is domiciled.

Objectives:-

To help parents of children belonging to Scheduled Castes and other disadvantaged categories for education of their wards who are in the pre-Matric stage to increase their participation. The Scheme is Targeted to Prevent incidence of drop-out especially during the transition from the elementary to the secondary stage so that. Students Perform better and stand a better chance of progressing to the post-Matric stage of education.

Eligibility:-

Component 1:

Pre-Matric Scholarship for SC Students

- The Students should be Studying full-time in classes IX and X.
- Students must belong to scheduled Caste,
- Their parent/ Guardian's annual income should not exceed Rs. 2.50 Lakh.

Component 2:

Pre-Matric Scholarship for children of parents/ guardians engaged in Unclean and Hazardous Occupation

- The Students Should be studing full-time in classes I-X.
- Children/Wards of Parents/ Guardians Who belong to Categories like Tanners & Flayers; Waste Pickers; Persons engaged in hazardous cleaning, and Persons who are Manual Scavengers.
- There is no family income ceiling under this component.

Components of the Scholarship:

With effect from 2022-23, The Students will get following combined academic allowance:

Day Scholar Rs. 3500 Per annum

Component 1- Rs. 7000 Per annum

Component 2- Rs. 8000 Per annum (For Classes 3rd-10th)


