He criticized the BJP for misleading the people with emotional sloganeering while saying that "They have played with the emotions of people and destroyed the splendid Raghunath Bazaar, Jammu's business and its tourism sector."

Whether the Jammu people had given mandate to them to end the 100 years old Darbar Move or to end the business of Jammu?, said Bukhari in his address expressing serious concern over the plight of Jammu people with poor business, infrastructure, scattered garbage, poor drainage system and other basic amenities.

He said that the Apni Party wants to keep people of both the Regions united and give them representation as per their wishes.

"The people of Jammu want development, protection of employment and their identity and the same is the demand of the people of Kashmir. The time has gone when traditional political parties would give slogans of self rule or autonomy. Such politicians are sitting in their homes. They have misled the people of J&K for the last 70 years. However, the Apni Party will fight back the divisive elements," he added.

"BJP and Congress Party both were involved in creating division and mistrust among the people of two regions i.e., Jammu and Kashmir," he said.

He said that both these political parties were in the

Govt for the last 70 years. However, they did not develop. Instead, they were involved in the transfer industry, he added.

He said that Apni Party will do justice with the people of Jammu as well as Kashmir by providing employment opportunities in Govt and in industrial sector with protection to their jobs, protection of natural resources from outsiders, the outsiders involved in exploiting natural resources would be through out of Lakhanpur if Apni Party comes to Power.

Traders stage protest demanding withdrawal of GST on food-grains

JAMMU: Expressing resentment over GST Council's decision to levy 5 per cent GST on pre-packed and pre-labeled food grains, curd, butter-milk etc, different trade bodies under the banner of Traders Federation Ware House Nehru Market, Jammu on Saturday held a protest demonstration and raised slogans against the Council's decision. Traders assembled near Police Post Ware House under leadership of Deepak Gupta and held protest demonstration.

While speaking on the occasion, Deepak said that decision to levy 5 per cent GST on pre-packed and labeled food items will cause loss of business to traders, increase compliance burden besides raising prices of unbranded essentials which will be another burden on common man. Earlier, only branded versions of these items used to attract 5 percent GST. "Only 15 per cent of the

population in the country uses branded goods while 85 per cent of population uses things without a brand. Now these 85 per cent people will also have to bear tax burden. On one hand Prime Minister Narendra Modi is distributing free ration among poor and on the other hand GST Council is levying 5 per cent tax on food of common man, which is sheer injustice," Gupta said.

He said there is a lot of anger and outrage among the food-grain traders for bringing all types of pre-packed and pre-labeled food grains and

other items under the GST tax slab of 5 per cent. "This decision will empower big brands to capture the market at the cost of small manufacturers and traders. Special food items, cereals, etc, which were not branded till now, were exempted from GST," he added. Yash Pal Gupta, President Retailers Federation said that according

to this decision, now if a grocery shopkeeper also sells food items packed with any mark, then he will have to pay GST on that item.
