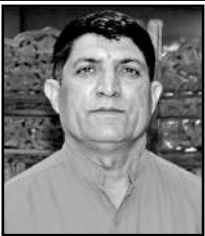

CRIME REPORT

Hit & run case solved; 4 arrested

BUDGAM: Police on Sunday solved a hit and run case by arresting accused driver along with three conspirators besides seizing the vehicle used in commission of crime.

As per details, on July 15, 2022, Police Station Khansahib received information that a motorcycle (PB09M-2124) rider namely Mohammad Ismail Lone, son of Irshad Ahmed Lone, along with 2 pillion-riders namely Mohammad Yousuf Lone, son of Manzoor Ahmed Lone; Mushtaq Ahmed Lone, son of Ghulam Qadir Lone, all residents of Sitharan Khag got hit by an unknown vehicle near Jamia Masjid Arizal while driver along with vehicle has fled away from the spot.

Meanwhile, injured persons were shifted to SMHS Hospital Srinagar for further treatment. However, 2 injured Mohammad Yousuf and Mohammad Ismail succumbed to their injuries at SMHS Hospital Srinagar. Accordingly, FIR No. 119/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Khansahib and investigation started. The investigation team, after putting in strenuous efforts, identified and arrested accused driver and summoned various other suspects for questioning. The team also recovered vehicle bearing registration number JK04A-0678 from an agricultural field in village Arizal. It is pertinent to mention that, earlier at time of incident, President Sumo Stand Arizal namely Fayaz Ahmad War and brother of vehicle owner namely Mehranj Ahmad Khan produced one Irshad Ahmad Khan, son of Abdul Rashid Khan, resident of Checkmarg Hardpanzoo before Police Station Khan Sahib, claiming him as driver of vehicle. However, during questioning, it came to fore that one Shakeel Ahmad Khan, son of Abdul Rashid Khan, resident of Checkmarg Hardpanzoo (who doesn't possess a driving license) was driving vehicle at the time of incident. He was brother of the impersonating driver produced by President Sumo Stand. The trio had hatched a conspiracy to save actual driver from legal action owing to his non-possession of driving license. The driver, two cheaters and impersonating driver were booked and arrested in instant hit and run case under sections 304-A, 229, 337, 205, 417, 177 of IPC and 3/181, 190(2), 146, 196 of MV Act.

Theft case solved; 1 arrested, stolen gold ornaments, bike recovered

MIRAN SAHIB: Police on Sunday solved a theft case by arresting an accused and recovered stolen gold ornaments along with a bike on his disclosure.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Bishnah by one Neelam Kumari, wife of Pawan Kumar, resident of Bakshi Colony, Tehsil R S Pura District Jammu regarding theft at her house. On this, FIR No. 107/2022 under section 382 of IPC was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Bishnah under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO Bishnah Insp Pawan Dogra, after putting in strenuous efforts, rounded up a suspect, identified as Anil Singh alias Dana, son of Balvinder Singh, resident of Moghlan, Tehsil Taryath, District Rajouri. On questioning, he confessed his crime and on his disclosure, 5 gold rings; a woman purse/artificial jewellery and a motor-cycle Pulsar (JK02AT-6425) was recovered from his possession. The overall recoveries were made under supervision of SP Hqrs Rammish Gupta.



Narco smuggler nabbed with 3 Kg Ganja

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Bishnah Police achieved major success by arresting a narco-smuggler at Deoli road Bishnah and recovered 3 Kg Ganja.

As per details, a team from Police Station Bishnah led by SHO Bishnah Insp Pawan Kumar while on Naka duty, rounded up a suspect and recovered 3 Kg Ganja from his possession. The suspect was later identified as Govinda, son of Balak Ram, resident of village Doorman, district Jangir Champa Chattisgarh, presently staying at Bishnah. He was arrested and FIR No. 123/2022 under sections 8/20 of NDPS Act was registered against him in Police Station Bishnah. The entire operation was done under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh and SP Hqrs Rammish Gupta.

5 vehicles seized for illegal mining

The seized vehicles includes a tractor trolley (JK20-3848) seized by Jhajiarkotli Police; a tipper (JK02BK 3511) seized by Talab Tillo police; a tractor trolley bearing Chassis No 43677 and one tractor without registration number seized by Sidhra Police, and a tractor trolley without registration number seized by Chatha Police. The recoveries were made by SHO Jhajiarkotli Insp Vikram Sharma, Incharge Police Posts Chatha SI Ranjit Singh Chib, Talab Tillo-PSI Rajesh Kumar, Sidhra-SI Majid Hussain in their respective jurisdictions.

Rafait, son of Faqural-ul-Din, resident of Ghuraka Bhadarwah and Parveez Ahmed, son of Ghulam Mustfa, resident of Ghuraka Bhadarwah were also arrested along with accused drivers, as 13 bovines were recovered from the vehicles, which were rescued on the spot. FIR No 115/2022 under the relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Bhadarwah and investigation started.

Man attacked, Rs 3 lakh snatched
