CRIME REPORT

Narco-smuggler arrested with heroin

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, police on Monday arrested a narco smuggler at Bahu plaza and recovered 14 gm heroin from his possession.

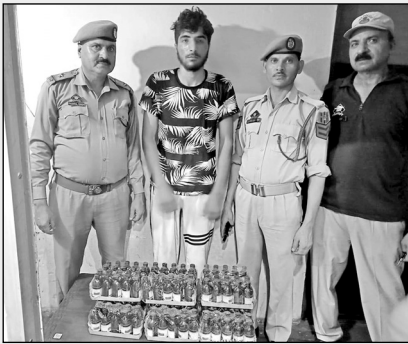
As per details, a team of Police Station Bahu Fort led by SHO Inspr Nayat Ali while on Naka duty rounded up a suspect. On search, 14 gm heroin was recovered from his possession. The accused, later identified as Faryad Ali, son of Ab Hamid, resident of Palperd Raghooda, was arrested and FIR No 191/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Bahu Fort. The whole operation was done under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari.

Man arrested with 100 intoxicating capsules, 160 bottles of banned syrup

JAMMU: Police on Monday nabbed a man and recovered 100 intoxicating capsules and 160 bottles of banned syrup from his possession.

As per details, acting tough on menace of drug trafficking and substance abuse, a team of Police Station Bus Stand led by SHO Bus Stand Inspr Vishal Shoor while on Naka duty at BC road, rounded up a suspect namely Hashim Iqbal, son of Mohd Iqbal Sofi, resident of Saloor, near Jamia Masjid, Ganderbal. During search, 100



Tramadol Hydrochloride capsules and 160 bottles of Codeine Phosphate (100 ml each) were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 31/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Bus Stand. Intensive questioning is going on to know about his other accomplices in crime. The overall arrest and recovery was made under supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kalu.

Missing woman among three traced, reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Monday traced three missing persons including a woman and reunited them with their families.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Bagh-e-Bahu, by legal heirs of a woman, stating that she went missing from her house. In this regard, a missing report was registered and investigation started. On this, a team under supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari, led by SHO Bagh-e-Bahu Insp Sikander Singh, after putting in hectic efforts, successfully traced out missing woman. Similarly another missing report of a person namely Manoj Kumar, son of Mool Raj, resident of Doda, at present Swarn Vihar, Police Colony, Muthi was lodged at Police Post Chinore. After this, a team from Police Post Chinore under supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh led by SHO Domana Insp Tilak Raj assisted by Incharge Police Post Chinore PSI Amit Singh, after putting in strenuous efforts, traced the missing person.

Also another complaint regarding missing of a boy namely Vishal Sharma, son of Satpal Sharma, resident of lower Gadigarh was lodged at Police Post Gadigarh, after which a police team under the supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Satwari Inspr Sameer Jeelani assisted by Incharge Police Post Gadigarh SI Ravinder Singh, with help of CCTV footages of the area, traced out the boy. Subsequently families of missing persons were informed and they were handed over to their respective family members after completing all legal formalities.

8 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police teams from Police Stations Akhnor, Jhajjar Kotli, Arnia, Police Posts Phallain Mandal, Sainik Colony, Pounichak and

Chatha acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 8 different vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles included a tractor trolley without registration number seized by Akhnor police; a Tipper (JK11A-3851) seized by Jhajjar Kotli police; a tractor-trolley without registration number seized by Arnia police; 2 tractors without registration numbers seized by Phallain Mandal police; a Dumper (JK02CV9503) seized by Sainik Colony police; a tractor trolley bearing Chassis no. MBNAAALXBK-TF03932 seized by Pounichak police and a dumper (JK01AN- 5414) seized by Chatha police. The recoveries were made by SHO Akhnor Inspr Hilal Azar, SHO Jhajjar Kotli Insp Vikram Sharma, SHO Arnia Insp Devinder Singh, Incharge Police Posts Phallain Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal, Sainik Colony-PSI Bawani Singh, Pounichak-PSI Nitish Khajuria and Chatha-SI Ranjit Singh in their respective jurisdictions.

Two bootleggers arrested, 58 bottles of illicit liquor recovered

JAMMU: In an act of alertness and prompt action, police on Monday nabbed two bootleggers and recovered of 58 bottles of illicit liquor from their possession.

As per details, a Naka was laid at Abdullian Bidhipur road by a team of Border Police Post Baspur, constituted under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO R S Pura Insp Rajesh Sharma assisted by Incharge Border Police Post Baspur ASI Mohinder Singh. The police team rounded up a suspect namely Sunil Kumar alias Shinda, son of Nager Mal, resident of Abdullian and during search, recovered 52 bottles of illicit liquor from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 140/22 under sections 48 (A) Ex. Act was registered against him at Border Police Post Baspur.

Similarly, information was received at Police Station Kahnachak regarding one Santu Ram, son of Nanki Dhau, resident of Chhattisgarh, presently staying near JK Bank Bawa Talab, Jammu, indulged in sale of illicit liquor. On this police team constituted under supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh led by SHO Kahnachak Insp Kunal Singh Jamwal, rushed to the spot and rounded up accused person. During search, 6 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from his possession. A motorcycle (JK02CA 3694), which was used for selling illicit liquor, was also seized. He was arrested and FIR No. 84/2022 under section 48(F) of Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station Kanachak.
