## Cash, bag stolen from car

## 2 notorious drug peddlers booked under PSA

BUDGAM: Acting tough against drug dealings, Police in Budgam booked 2 notorious drug peddlers under PSA. Earlier, in a series of actions, Police seized huge quantity of contraband substances from possession of 2 drug peddlers identified as Shabir Ahmed Sofi, son of Abdul Khaliq Sofi, resident of Mazhama Magam and Asif Nazir Rather, son of Nazir Ahmed Rather, resident of Archanderhama, Budgam. The duo was involved in several FIRs and promoting drug abuse by supplying drugs to local youth of district Budgam. Subsequently, the cases were duly processed and

after obtaining sanctions from concerned authorities, both drug peddlers were detained under Public Safety Act (PSA).

## 7 gamblers arrested; stake money seized

BARAMULLA: Acting tough against social crimes, Police on Thursday arrested 7 gamblers and seized stake money from their possession.

Acting on specific information, a party from Police Station Tangmarg raided a gambling site at Drung Park and apprehended 7 gamblers, who were identified as Amir Hayat Khan, resident of Tang Bagh, Nawakadal; Sajad Ahmad Wani, resident of Wanganpora Eidgah, Lateef Ahmad Bhat, resident of Zoonimar and Mohd Younis Malik, resident of Main Chowk Eidgah, Mushtaq Ahmed Baba, resident of Chadihar Wanganpora Eidgah, Mohd Ismail Bangru, resident of Tanga Bagh Eidgah and Mohd Maqbool Wani, resident of Wanganpora Eidgah.

Officers also seized stake money amounting to Rs 1,32,000 and playing cards from gamblers. They were shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Besides, 2 vehicles (Alto and Santro cars) bearing registration numbers JK01AH-1415 & JK01S-2079 were also seized from gambling spot. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Tangmarg and further investigation started.

## 4 arrested, 4 vehicles seized for illegal mining

BUDGAM: Acting tough against elements involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, Police in Budgam has arrested 4 persons and seized 4 vehicles involved in commission of crime.

As per details, officers from Police Station Khansahab arrested 4 persons and seized 4 vehicles (a JCB and 3 tippers) for their involvement in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals from Govt land at Khatresh Wadur, Khansahab. The accused were identified as Mushtaq Ahmad Kuchay, son of Abdul Raheem Kuchay, resident of Branwar; Zahoor Ahmad Ganie, son of Abdul Gani Ganie, resident of Gurwaith Khan Sahab; Mohd Iqbal Ganie, son of Abdul Samad Ganie, resident of Dabipora Yarikha and Abdul Qayoom Mir, son of Ali Mohd Mir, resident of Yarikha. They were shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 125/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Khan Sahab and further investigation started.

## Two booked under Arms Act

JAMMU: Police on Thursday booked two persons under Arms Act.

As per details, a team of Police Station Satwari constituted under the supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma and led by SHO Satwari Inspr Sameer Jeelani assisted by PSI Darshan Singh, while on Naka duty near Jeevan Nagar Bhablana, rounded up two suspects later identified as Gaganpreet, son of Gurdev Singh, resident of Upper Gadigarh and Sandeep Singh Nagra, son of Surjeet Singh, resident of Narwal Pain, Satwari.

During search, a Toka was recovered from the possession of Gaganpreet while a country-made pistol along with 2 live cartridges (8 mm) were recovered from possession of Sandeep Singh Nagra. FIR No.124/2022 under sections of 3/25 & 4/25 Arms Act was registered at Police Station Satwari in this regard.

## Missing minor boy reunited with family

## 3 vehicles seized for illegal mining

## Crime Branch Jammu arrests Ex-MLA & Apni Party leader Shoaib Lone

JAMMU: The Crime Brach Wing on J&K Police has arrested Ex-MLA and Apni Party leader Shoaib Lone in forgery case.

On complaint of one Harmeet Singh Sasan, who is resident of Jammu, an FIR (39/2019) was registered by Crime Branch pertaining to a partnership dispute between Shoaib Lone and his three partners namely Harmeet Singh Sasan, Abdul Rashid Banday and Nazrul Islam Baba.

Shoaib lone illegally reduced share holding of Harmeet Singh from 46.5 per cent to zero and removed all three partners from board of directors with illegal support from few company secretaries and chartered accountants who are also accused in the said case, informed CB sleuths. Soon after his arrest, Lone was produce before the court. The court has granted 10-day police remand.

## Man found dead under mysterious circumstances

JAMMU: A man was found dead under mysterious circumstances in his house at Beli Charana area on Thursday.

As per details, Paramjeet Singh, son of Sukhan Singh, resident of Punjab, presently staying at Raipur area, was found unconscious in his house and shifted to hospital, where he was declared brought dead by doctors.

## Three narco-smugglers nabbed; 300 gm heroin, over Rs 3 lakh cash recovered

JAMMU: Police on Thursday arrested three narco-smugglers and recovered 300 grams heroin and Rs 3,06,000 cash from them.

As per details, a team of Police Station Gandhi Nagar led by SHO Inspector Pankaj Sharma assisted by PSI Sonu Choudhary and PSI Basharat Hussain, while on patrolling duty near Ghoda Chowk, Nanak Nagar rounded up three suspects who were on their vehicles (JK02CH-3911 and JK12A-1158). They tried to flee but were intercepted by alert cops. On search, 300 gm heroin and Rs 3,06,000 cash was recovered from their possession. The accused identified as Mukhtayar Ahmed, son of Faiz Akbar, resident of Phaglia, Surankote, Poonch (with 25 gm heroin and Rs 38,000 cash); Zafar Iqbal, son of Munshi Khan, resident of Harni Tehsil Mehndar (with 260 gm Heroin and Rs 2,60,000 cash) and Tariq Mohd, son of Ghulam Nabi, resident of Mankot, Mehndar, at present Chhani Rama Jammu (with 15 gm Heroin and cash Rs 8000) were arrested on the spot and FIR No. 175/2022 under sections 8/21/22/25/27a/29 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Gandhi Nagar. The whole operation was done under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma and SP South Mamta Sharma.
