Subject:- Representation of Dr. Suraya Ismail Paray, with regard to non-application of standing rule to MBBS medical graduates of foreign universities, in the selection of Lecture Ophthalmology in Government Medical College Srinagar, in terms of J&K Public Service Commission Notification No. 07-PSC(DR-S) of 2022 dated 30.05.2022- Consideration thereof.

Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission, vide notification dated 14.12.2021, advertised, among others, a post of Lecturer in Ophthalmology in open merit category for Government Medical College Srinagar; and,

Whereas, on the basis of academic record and performance in interview, a provisional select list was drawn and published in the media vide Notification No. 07-PSC(DR-S) of 2022 dated 30.05.2022, for inviting objections, if any, within a stipulated period of 05 days; and,

Whereas, Dr. Suraya Ismail Paray, who was second in the provisional merit list, objected to merit obtained by serial no.1 i.e Dr. Syed Sadaf Altaf on the basis that the result has been declared without adhering to the following rule of the J&K Public Service Commission (Business & Procedure) Rules, 2021:

"The aggregate marks in MBBS of foreign medical graduates are to be calculated/ recalculated after excluding marks obtained in all subjects/papers not related to the medical field and after bringing the marks/ aggregate marks given by the foreign university at par with the marking scheme approved by Medical Council of India/ National Medical Commission (MCI/ NMC)."

Whereas, she further stated that non-adherence, having direct bearing on the result in her case, be corrected before finalization of the recommendations; and,

Whereas, through another representation dated 20.06.2022, she referred to the following formula as claimed to have been laid-down by the Public Service Commission, where-under the classification of candidates from foreign universities has been made under four categories with reference to the Indian Standards:

Grade

Satisfactory/ pass
Good
Very good
Excellent

Weightage (Indian Standard)

50%
55%
60%
65%

Whereas, she further stated that the Notification dated 30.05.2022 clearly reveals that the above-referred rule has not been applied to the foreign

medical graduates which has put her to a disadvantageous position and is detrimental to her service career; and,

Whereas, she also claims that grading and percentage systems being interchangeable and corollary of each other, hence, no foreign university can be given the benefit of following the percentage system as has been done in the instant case; and,

Whereas, the matter was examined in the backdrop of the averments and it was found the scheme of conversion quoted by the applicant allowing conversion of grade points into percentage is not part of the J&K Public Service Commission (Business & Procedure) Rules, 2021, under which the instant provisional selection has been made; and,

Whereas, otherwise also, in the present case, the marks have not been given in grading system where there could be any need of conversion into percentage system; and,

Whereas, no instance was found where marks allotted by foreign universities have been moderated on the basis of averment that the grading and percentage systems are interchangeable; and,

Whereas, the Commission decided that a reference be made to the National Medical Commission/MCI seeking there guidance in comparing the marks of the foreign universities with those of Indian universities; and,

Whereas, accordingly, the NMC/MCI vide communication date 05.07.2022 was, inter alia, requested to clarify whether there is any scheme/guideline issued by the NMC/MCI on comparing percentages given by foreign universities with those given by Indian Universities. However, no response was received from the National Medical Commission till date; and,

Whereas, the rule quoted by the applicant envisages that the marks obtained in the subjects/papers not related to the medical field be excluded from the aggregate marks; and,

Whereas, in the instant case, all subjects evaluated and calculated are medical subjects and no subject not related to medical subjects is part of evaluation, as such, the rule is not attracted; and,

Whereas, no scheme was found in place, allowing the marks percentages given by the foreign universities to be moderated and brought at par with those given by the Indian Universities.

Now, therefore, in view of the circumstances and facts explained hereinabove, the representation filed by Dr. Suraya Ismail Paray is devoid of any merit and is hereby considered and rejected.
