Earlier, Director, JKJA, Shahzad Azeem underscored the importance of Land Acquisition Laws in industrializing and urbanizing

economies where land has to be acquired by state agencies for the sake of development of infrastructure and expansion. He also underlined the pivotal role of the Judiciary while dealing with litigation on land acquisition matters for providing larger justice to the people and maintaining the correct social and economic equilibrium in society.

During the programme, an interactive session was also held where the participants discussed various aspects of the topic and raised queries which were satisfactorily settled by the resource person.

Participants and were sensitized about the significance of the scheme. They were made aware about the registration process, eligibility criteria, written test, physical examination and other salient features of the scheme.

Addressing the participants on the occasion, ADDC urged the youth to take part in the process of Agnipath scheme which would provide a good opportunity for the youth to become Agniveers to serve in the armed forces and to contribute in nation building and its protection. Officials of Zila Sainik Welfare Office, Srinagar and a large number of youth were also present in the awareness program.
