The Yatra shall commence from Lal Chowk, Srinagar and culminate at Lal Chowk, Kargil. On July 26, the BJYM will celebrate Vijay Diwas at Kargil War Memorial.

Tejasvi Surya has instructed all the attendees to bring soil from the front yard of the martyrs' homes in their respective states, which shall be dedicated at the war memorial as a symbolic gesture of the immortality of the fallen and to honour their families.
