He maintained that the satisfaction of public with respect

to service delivery should be the yardstick for measuring our achievements.

Regarding the services under PSGA, he passed on directions to the DCs to ensure all services are made available to the citizens within the stipulated time frame. He said PSGA timelines of these services should be synchronized with the online portal and any default on providing services within notified timelines should

be monitored by departments for taking action against the commission of willful derelictions.
