CRIME REPORT

2 drug peddlers arrested; contraband recovered

BUDGAM: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Wednesday arrested two drug peddlers and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

As per details, a party of Police Station Chadoora at a checkpoint established at Hussipora crossing intercepted two suspects riding on a motorcycle (JK04G-8113). When police party signalled them to stop, they tried to flee but were tactfully apprehended by alert police party. During search of suspects, identified as Asif Shafi Bhat, son of Mohammad Shafi Bhat, resident of Gund, Maqsood Chadoora & Rayees Mushtaq Sofi, son of Mushtaq Ahmad Sofi, resident of Chrawani Chrar-e-Sharif, 4 gm Heroin like substance and 298 tablets of controlled drug Alprazolam were recovered from their possession. The accused were arrested and shifted to police station, where they remained in custody. The motorcycle used in commission of crime was also seized. Accordingly, FIR No. 124/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Chadoora and further investigation started.

Bootlegger nabbed with 50 bottles of illicit liquor

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday nabbed a bootlegger and recovered 50 bottles of illicit liquor from his possession.

As per details, a party from Police Station Miran Sahib led by SHO Insp Zaheer Mushtaq under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh and overall supervision of SP Hqrs Rammish Gupta established a Naka at Kotli Miyan Fateh for checking of vehicles. During checking, a suspect, who on seeing police tried to escape, was nabbed. During questioning, he disclosed his name as Ranjit Kumar, son of Harbans Lal, resident of Jindlar, Tehsil R S Pura. During checking, 50 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 70/2022 under section 48(A) of Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station Miran Sahib.

Five narco smugglers nabbed; 32 gm heroin recovered

JAMMU: Continuing drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Wednesday nabbed five narco smugglers and recovered 32 gm heroin i.e., 18 gm and 14 gm separately at two different Nakas under jurisdiction of Police Station Gandhi Nagar Jammu.

As per details, a team of Police Station Gandhi Nagar led by SHO Inspector Pankaj Sharma assisted by PSI Majid Shafi while on Naka duty rounded up three suspects in a vehicle (JK21B-2666).

On search, 18 gm heroin was recovered from accused, who were identified as Nikhil alias Abhi, son of Avtar Singh, resident of Gurah Slatia; Arif Hussain, son of Sher Mohd, resident of Beli Charana and Mohinder Lal, son of Tarsem Lal, resident of Miran Sahib. They were arrested on the spot and FIR No 162/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Gandhi Nagar.

Similarly, at another Naka laid by a team of Police Station Gandhi Nagar led by SHO Gandhi Nagar Insp Pankaj Sharma assisted by PSI Sonu Choudhary, police teams rounded up two suspects riding a motorcycle. On search 14 gm heroin was recovered from their possession.

The suspects, identified as Manpreet Singh, son of Gureharan Singh, resident of Channi Rama and Narinder Singh, son of Daler Singh, resident of Ward- 10, H.No 49 Jawahar Nagar, Rajouri at present Bakshi Nagar, Jammu were arrested and FIR No. 163/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Gandhi Nagar. The overall arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma and SP South Mamta Sharma.

Two theft cases solved; 2 arrested, 7 stolen two-wheelers recovered

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday solved two theft cases by arresting two thieves and recovered 7 stolen two-wheelers.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Miran Sahib by one Chandan Dogra, resident of Krishna Nagar Basti, R S Pura regarding theft of his scooty. After this, a team from Police Station Miran Sahib under the supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO Miran Sahib Insp Zaheer Mushtaq, after putting in strenuous efforts and by connecting various leads, rounded up a suspect identified as Sunny Bali, son of Madan Lal Bali, resident of Jagti, at present Kotli Charkar for cross examination.

On his disclosure, stolen scooty (JK02BF1044) was recovered. Moreover, 3 more stolen scooties (JK02BD2763, JK02BS1519) and one without number plate were also recovered from different places of Jammu district. The overall arrest and recovery was made under supervision of SP Rural Ramesh Gupta.

Bari Brahmana Police also solved a theft case with arrest of a bike-lifter and recovered 3 stolen bikes.

During investigation of FIR No. 127/2022 registered under section 379 of IPC at Police Station Bari Brahmana, a team headed of Insp Rakesh Sharma assisted by PSI Anjum Hussain Shah under supervision of SDPO Bari Brahmana, Shivali Kotwal arrested a suspect, identified as Anil Singh, son of Balvinder Singh, resident of Moghlan, Tehsil Taryhat, Rajouri. During sustained interrogation, the accused confessed that he had stolen a motorcycle (JK02BP / 9882) and two scooties (JK21B / 8756 & JK02CH / 7349). On his disclosure, all stolen two-wheelers were recovered. The whole operation was carried out under the overall supervision of SSP Samba, Dr Abishek Mahajan.

IED found on Srinagar-Baramulla highway, defused

BARAMULLA: An Improvised Explosive Device (IED) was found on Baramulla-Srinagar highway near Kutta Morh in Pattan area of Baramulla on Wednesday and was diffused successfully. As per details, security forces including Army's 29 RR detected an IED along roadside after which Bomb Disposal Squad (BDS) was called in, which destroyed it through a controlled mechanism. The traffic movement on highway, which was stopped as a precautionary measure, was also restored later.

3 vehicles seized for illegal transportation of minor minerals

UDHAMPUR: Police on Wednesday seized 3 vehicles involved in illegal transportation of construction material in Tikri area.

As per details, a police team headed by Incharge Police Post Tikri PSI Abdul Satar seized 3 tippers from Manthral area of Tikri bearing registration numbers JK02BJ 7986, JK14F 9075 and JK14B 9725 indulged in illegal extraction/transporting of construction material from river bed. All seized vehicles were immediately handed over to officials of Geological & Mining Department Udhampur for further legal pro-



ceedings. While giving the details SSP Udhampur Dr. Vinod Kumar conveyed that Udhampur Police is committed for protecting the public property and to eradicate the menace of illegal mining from the area.

Notorious drug-peddler arrested with banned capsules

UDHAMPUR: Police on Wednesday nabbed a notorious drug peddler and recovered 13,200 banned capsules from his possession.

As per details, a party from Police Post Roundmail led by PSI Akhilesh Khajuria under supervision of Dy.SP Hqrs Udhampur Sahil Mahajan while on patrolling duty, noticed a suspect who tried to flee on seeing police, but alert cops chased and overpowered him tactfully. During search, police recovered 13,200 psychotropic capsules from his possession. The accused, identified as Parshotam Singh, son of Karan Singh, resident of Jaganoo, Udhampur was arrested and FIR under relevant sections of law was registered against him at Police Station Udhampur.



Two houses burgled

Thieves decamped with 20 tollas gold & silver ornaments along with Rs 5000 from there. In another incident, thieves targeted another house at Ward No 12, Bari Brahmana when entire family was out and decamped with Rs 25,000 cash and some silver ornaments.

Gujjars attack BSF team, Jawan injured

7 injured as cab falls into gorge in Ramban

BANIHAL: Seven people, including four women, were injured when the vehicle in which they were travelling fell into a 150-feet deep gorge in Ramban district along the Jammu-Srinagar national highway on Wednesday, police said.

The car was on its way to Srinagar from Jammu when it met with the accident near Kharpora village of Banihal, a police official said.

The driver was overspeeding and lost control of the vehicle that skidded off the road and plunged into the gorge, he said. Cab driver Abid Ahmad Dar of Srinagar, Jehangir Ahmad and his brother Farooq Ahmad of Ramssoo, Hafiza Begum and her sister Aliza Bano of Sher-Bibi and Shakeela Bano and her sister Shazia Bano sustained injuries and were taken to a local hospital. Three of them -- Shakeela Bano, Shazia Bano and Aliza Bano -- were referred to the Government Medical College and Hospital in Anantnag for specialised treatment, the official said.

Two soldiers injured during firing practice in Poonch
