

## DM Reasi suggests measures to curb illegal production, distribution of drugs

REASI: District Magistrate, Babila Rakwal on Thursday convened a meeting of the District Level Committee for Narcotic & Psychotropic substances. After threadbare discussion it was directed that concerned Tehsildar would collect reports from Lamberdars, Chowkidars and Patwaris about illicit cultivation and processing of poppy and wild hemp, as well about the manufacturing of lahan in their respective jurisdictions. The report would later be submitted with the concerned Sub Divisional Police Officers. Further, Drug Inspector

Reasi was directed to check and proceed for sealing of unregistered chemist shops in the district under Drug & Cosmetics Act in coordination with concerned Tehsildar and SHO. He was told to ensure that no chemist shop sells medicines without a doctor's prescription. It was decided that Anti Drug Abuse awareness programmes would be organised in Degree Colleges, Polytechnic College and Higher Secondary Schools. Counselling centres would be established in all Colleges and Higher Secondary Schools. Additional Superintendent of Police Reasi provided details of

the cases registered under NDPS Act over the past five years for possession and use of psychotropic substances and for illegal cultivation of poppy and hemp in the district.

It was informed that 340 cases have been registered in the district during the period, out of which 40 cases pertain to this year upto June, 2022. Under the NDPS Act, 440 persons have been arrested, he informed. Tehsildar Reasi was directed to immediately identify state land measuring 5 kanal as requested by the Senior Superintendent of Police Reasi for establishment of Drug De-addiction centre. The meeting was attended by Additional District Magistrate, Abdul Star; Additional SP Reasi, Surjit Kumar; Sub Divisional Magistrate Mahore, SDM Dharmari, Chief Medical Officer; Chief Education Officer; tehsildars, Drug Inspector among other members of the committee.

# DC Udhampur reviews implementation of PC & PNDT Act

UDHAMPUR: To review implementation of the Pre-conception & Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (PC & PNDT) Act and the Clinical Establishment Registration & Regulation Act, 2010 in the district, Deputy Commissioner, Krittika Jyotsna chaired a meeting of District Advisory Committee (DAC) at the district headquarters on Thursday. Threadbare discussions were held on issues including registration and renewal of ultrasound cen-

tres, regulation of labs and clinics, inspections and mechanisms for monitoring and implementation of PCP-NDT Act among many others. The CMO was asked to grant provisional registration to clinical establish-

ments after fulfilling the requisite formalities. The DC asked the CMO to carry out inspections of clinical establishments and impose penalties upon the defaulters as prescribed in the Clinical Establishment Act.

The Chief Medical Officer was instructed to withhold renewal of registration and directed for closure of Nav Jeevan Neuropsychiatric and De-addiction Centre Gole Mela Udhampur till enquiry is completed. The District Social Welfare Officer was asked to submit a proposal for establishment of a De-addiction centre in the district. Other concerned officers were directed to conduct frequent inspections and to take strict action against defaulters. For approval of registration of

the Ultrasound centres, the DC directed that photographs and videography of the premises of the centres and their surroundings be presented before the members of the Advisory Committee. The DC also directed for proper record maintenance of antenatal cases at all the ultrasound centres in the district. ## Samba Admn acts sternly against power-theft; multiple flying squads conduct raids

SAMBA: District Administration Samba under the supervision of Deputy Commissioner, Anuradha Gupta on Thursday conducted multiple raids at houses, shops, business establishments, factories and other places to remove illegal electricity connections.

During the raids, houses of some prominent individuals were also inspected in which irregularities were discovered and appropriate action was taken.

The officials informed that six flying squads were constituted and raids were conducted across the district simultaneously.

It was informed that following the complaints against illegal use of electricity the raids were conducted at Keli Mandi, Chak Ram Chand, Tanda

Burj, Sujwana, ward number 7 and 8 of Vijaypur; Rama Shop Area, Rahya etc.

During the inspection it was revealed that around 250 KW load would be revised in the district with the disconnection of 87 illegal connections, 43 heaters, removal of energy meter-bypass and plugging of illegal power taps. Additionally surprise inspections on illegal water connections were also conducted wherein a number of illegal connections found out were disconnected on spot.

An illegal bore-well was also found in Vijaypur town which was also removed.

Samba Administration has issued an appeal to the

general public to desist from power theft and has warned that such drives against power theft would be intensified in the coming days. Names of offenders indulged in power theft would also be released publicly, it was informed.

The inspection was carried under the supervision of ADDC, Rajinder Singh; ADC, Suram Chand Sharma; ACR Samba, Ravinder Singh; SDM Vijaypur, Vinay Sharma; Tehsildar Samba, Rampal; Executive Engineer Electric Division Vijaypur, Bhola Bhandari; Executive Engineer Jal Shakti, Sunil Sharma among other officers of JPDCL and Vijaypur-Samba Jal Shakti Divisions.
