Former Legislator informed pilgrims including women and children that the administration has put in place elaborate security arrange-

Aspirants, while addressing the media said, that from the first year we are saying that this scam is believed to be done by an inter-state racket hence needs to be handed over to CBI so that all those involved in this multi-crore scam should be
