

**CRIME REPORT**

**2 notorious drug peddlers booked under PIT-NDPS Act**

**PULWAMA:** Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police on Tuesday booked 02 notorious drug peddlers under PIT-NDPS Act in Pulwama.

The 02 notorious drug peddlers identified as Mukhtar Ahmad Wani son of Gh Mohammad Wani, Javaid Ahmad Sofi son of Abdul Rehman Sofi, both residents of Gusoo Pulwama have been booked under PIT-NDPS Act after obtaining formal detention orders from the competent authority and subsequently lodged in Central Jail Kot-Balwal Jammu.

Its pertinent to mention here that they were involved in promoting drug trade by supplying drugs to local youth of Pulwama and other areas of the district. Despite their involvement in several FIRs, they did not mend their activities and were again involved in promoting drug abuse trade by supplying drugs to local youth.

**Police carries bung destruction drive**

**BARAMULLA:** Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Tuesday destroyed wild bung at Bijhama & Ghat Palhallan.

A police party of Police Station Bijhama along with officials of Revenue department carried a special drive against wild bung at Bijhama. During the drive, huge quantity of wild bung spread over 01 Kanal of land was destroyed.

Similarly, a Police party of PP Palhallan alongwith local volunteers destroyed wild bung spread over 1.5 Kanals at Ghat Palhallan.

**Three theft cases worked out, notorious thieves arrested**

**SAMBA/REASI:** Police on Tuesday worked out two theft cases, arrested two notorious thieves and recovered stolen items worth rupees 1.50 lakh approximately.

The arrested thieves have been identified as Rameez Ahmed, son of Asgar Ali, resident of Semna, district Kishtwar and Gara Ram, son of Ashok Kumar, resident of BadyalQazmi Tehsil RS Pura district Jammu.

Two theft cases -- FIR No. 168/2023 under section 457/380 IPC registered at Police Station Samba through Police Post Rakh AmbTalli and FIR No.156/2023 under section 379/ IPC registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana have been solved by Police and some more thieves have been identified to be arrested soon.

One theft case has been worked out by Police team headed by Incharge Police Post RakhAmbTalli PSI Devinder Singh whereas another theft case has been solved by a team comprising of SHO Police Station Bari Brahmana Sunil Sharma and ASI Surinder Singh.

Reasi police also solved a theft case solved by arresting a thief. On the written complaint of one person namely Balbir Kumar, son of Rati Ram, resident of Sirhindi Bazar, Patiala Punjab reported at Police Station Bhawan that he along with his family members reached near durga Bhawan and decided to take rest after a while, he found that some unknown person has stolen one bag containing 2 Android mobiles having cost Rs 25500. On this a case FIR no. 10/2023 under section 379 IPC got registered and investigation started.

Investigation of the case was entrusted to ASI Jatinder Singh of Police Station Bhawan who after strenuous efforts and using human and technical assistance apprehended the accused person namely Sonu, son of Bhajan Lal, Bulandshahr UP from Bhawan area within few hours of registration of FIR and after sustained interrogation of suspected person he confessed that he has stolen the bag of complainant. On this, stolen bag recovered on the disclosure of suspected person. The whole operation has been lead by SHO Bhawan Khyatimaan Khajuria.

**Excise Department destroys 600 Kg Lahan**

**NEWSHERA:** Excise Department destroyed 600kg Lahan in Forest areas of Nowshera Tehsil during different raids carried out to arrest the menace of illicit liquor in Excise Subrange Rajouri.

On the directions of Excise Commissioner, Pankaj Kumar Sharma, and supervision of Deputy Excise Commissioner (Executive) Kusum Sharma and under the direct supervision of Narinder Singh Excise and Taxation officer Excise range Rajouri - Poonch, a team of Excise Sub Range Rajouri led by ETO and along with Inspector Mohd. Parvez, Sub Inspector Parvez and Excise Guard Mohd. Bashir Mirza Gulam Hussain conducted series of raids at Chowki Handan Nonyal Gohra, Androth and Forest areas of Tain Mahal and adjoining areas of Tehsil Nowshera. In the process 600 Kg of Lahan raw material was recovered from state land and later destroyed on spot.



**Two found hanging**

Meanwhile, 19 years old Danish Singh, son of Suram Singh, resident of Sarore Adda Bari Brahmana in District Samba was also found hanging in his house. Police have taken cognizance of both the matters and started further investigations.

**Elderly man killed in land dispute**

In attack Captain Ram Singh was killed. Police rushed on the spot and immediately arrested to Shamsheer Ahmed. FIR no. 50/2023 under section 302 IPC was registered against him.

**Narco smuggler nabbed with heroin**

**AKHNOOR:** Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Tuesday nabbed a narco smuggler and recovered 4 grams of heroin from his possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station Akhnoor led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Lal assisted by SHO Akhnoor Inspr Zaheer Mushtaq while on Naka duty at TRC Akhnoor rounded up a suspect who was coming from old bridge Akhnoor towards TRC Chandian. On search, 04 grams of heroin was recovered from him.

The accused identified as Jaspal Singh, son of Delair Singh, resident of Chatha Jammu was arrested and FIR No.194/2023 under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Akhnoor.



**Man arrested with 60 ampoules of psychotropic substance**

**JAMMU:** Police on Tuesday nabbed a man with 60 ampoules of psychotropic substance at Pounichak.

As per details, a team of Police Post Pounichak led by SDPO Domana Vishal Shoor assisted by SHO Domana Inspr Kunal Singh Jamwal and In-Charge Police Post Pounichak PSI Nitish Khajuria while on Naka duty rounded up a suspected person later identified as Suraj Kumar, son of Mangal Dass, resident of Dogra hall, Parade, Jammu. During search, 60 ampoules of psychotropic substance i.e 30 ampoules of diazepam of 2ml each and 30 ampoules of Phenargan of 2ml each were recovered from his possession.

He was arrested and FIR under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Domana.

**Snatching case solved; 3 arrested, cash recovered**

**JAMMU:** Police on Tuesday solved a snatching case by arresting three accused and recovered snatched cash Rs 65,400.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Post Narwal by one pilgrim of SANJY namely Udit Kumar, son of Suresh Chandra, resident of Dev Chara 52 Tehsil Aolla Brelli stating that when he was on his way towards tea stall Rajiv nagar Narwal, some unknown persons stopped the way of complainant and snatched cash RS 65400.

In this regard case FIR u/s 341/382 IPC was registered at Police Station Bahu Fort and investigation started. On this, a team of Police Post Narwal led by SDPO East Syd Zaheer Abbas Jafari assisted by SHO Bahu Fort Inspr Shiv Dev Singh and In-Charge Police Post Narwal SI Lalit Sharma with the help of CCTV footages of the area finally traced the four suspects namely Pooja, wife of Sonu; Poonam, wife of Sakinder, resident of Rajiv Nagar Narwal and Totu. During questioning accused confessed their involvement in the above case and on their disclosure snatched cash Rs 65400 was recovered from their possession.

The overall arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SP South Shaheen Wahid.

**4 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized**

**JAMMU:** In a quest to stem the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams of Police Station Domana, Police Post Phallian Mandal and Border Police Post Gajansoo acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining.

**Dowry harassment case registered**
