Samba Admn convenes public outreach camp

SAMBA: The District Administration Samba on Wednesday convened a Block Divas public outreach camp at Panchayat Bagla Jakh to assess the local issues and listen to the grievances of the people and resolve the same with the intervention of the concerned officers and the representatives of Panchayati Raj institutions.

Director Horticulture launches fruit plantation drive

SAMBA: To promote the plantation of fruit plants amid Rainy season, especially in the sub-tropical areas of Jammu Division, Director Horticulture Jammu Ram Sevak on Wednesday launched plantation process in District Samba by planting a sapling of Lime plant for compact plantation over an area of 20 kanal of a farmer at village Jatwal of Horticulture zone Gagwal.

Chief Horticulture Officer Samba, Mukesh Sharma, Horticulture Development Officer Gagwal, PRI members and farmers

were also present. Interacting with the farmers, the Director stressed the need to encourage High Density Plantation in the area. He said that the rainy season is most suitable for new plantations, especially in the Kandi area and the farmers should adopt a cluster approach to establish new orchards.

The department is providing all assistance to the farmers on different components viz: Protected cultivation, Water harvesting tanks, Bore wells, Drip irrigation system, Vermicompost units, Strawberry

plantation, Mechanized farming, Tools / implements etc. and they should take all the benefits for upliftment of their socio- economic status.

He also briefed the farmers about the newly launched Holistic Agriculture Development Programme (HADP) providing incentives / assistance for the welfare of the farming community. He said that keeping in view the suitable agro-climatic conditions, there is immense potential for horticulture crops in the area which must be tapped.

Woman among 4 arrested with 28 litres & 52 bottles of illicit liquor; 200 litres of lahan

JAMMU: In an act of alertness and prompt action, dedicated teams of Police Stations Pura, Arnia and Akhnoor recovered 52 bottles of illicit liquor, 28 litres of lahan in the areas under their respective jurisdictions.

As per details, a team of Police Station Arnia led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Arnia Inspr Deepak Katoch while on patrolling duty received the information regarding making and sale of illicit liquor. On this, a police team raided at the suspected place and rounded up two suspected persons namely Bitu Ram, son of Kounsul, resident of Kothey Salehar Tehsil Bishnah and another person namely Lakhvinder Kumar alias Ladu, son of Prem Chand, resident of Biaspur who were involved in making illicit liquor and selling the same in nearby areas. During search 15 litres of illicit liquor along with Stove, Gas cylinder, drum, plastic gallons and other materials used for making liquor were recovered from his possession.

Duo was arrested and FIR No. 44 & 45/2023 under section 48 (a) Excise Act was registered against them at Police Station Arnia.

Similarly another team of Police Station RS Pura led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO RS Pura Inspr Pawan Kumar and In-Charge Border Police Post Baspur PSI Amit Singh while on Naka duty near rice mill Darein, Baspur rounded up a suspected woman later identified as Raj Kumari, wife of Darshan Lal, resident of Abdullian Tehsil Suchetgarh District Jammu. During search 52 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from her possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 100/2023 under section 48 (a) Excise Act was registered against her at Police Station R.S Pura.

Also another police team of Police Station Akhnoor led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Lal Sharma assisted by SHO Akhnoor Inspr Zaheer Mushtaq while on patrolling duty at village Nardiwala received the information regarding making and sale of illicit liquor in the area. On this, a team raided at the suspected place and rounded up a suspected person namely Balkar Singh, son of Ram Singh, resident of Tacharwan Nardiwala Tehsil Maira Mandrian District Jammu who was

involved in making illicit liquor and selling the same in nearby areas. During search 13 litres of illicit liquor and 200 litres of lahan was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No.195/2023 under sections 48-a, 48-e, 48-f Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station Akhnoor.

5 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized
