


SHRADHANJALI

CRIME REPORT

Five narco smugglers nabbed with heroin

JAMMU/POONCH: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Monday nabbed five narco smugglers and recovered heroin their possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station Satwari led by SDPO South Sachit Sharma assisted by SHO Satwari Inspr Sumeet Sharma while on Naka duty at Babliana rounded up a suspected person who was coming from Dharp to Satwari. On search, 05 grams of heroin was recovered from him. The accused identified as Mohd. Usman Mir, son of Mohd. Sherief Mir, resident of Chakka Bhaderwah Doda A/P Gujjar Nagar Jammu was arrested and cognizance has been taken at Police Station Satwari and.

Similarly another Naka was laid in the jurisdiction of Police Post Phallain Mandal where police teams led by SDPO South Sachit Sharma assisted by SHO Satwari Inspr Sumeet Sharma and In-Charge Police Post Phallain Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal rounded up a suspected person namely Yasir Ali, son of Mohd Latief, resident of Ragoora, Jammu. During search 06 grams of heroin was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and cognizance was taken by Police Post Phallain Mandal. Also another team of Police Station Bishnah led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Bishnah Inspr Vikram Sharma while on Naka duty at Sikanderpur Bishnah rounded up a suspected person namely Naresh Kumar, son of Vijay Kumar, resident of Mehmodpur, Bishnah Distt. Jammu who was coming from Miran Sahib towards Bishnah. During search, 03 grams of heroin was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No 170/2023 under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Bishnah.

Meanwhile, team of Police Post Bathindi led by SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari assisted by SHO Bahu Fort Inspr Shiv Dev Singh and In-Charge Police Post Bathindi SI Shakil Ahmed while on Naka duty rounded up a suspected person namely Rohit Kumar, son of Lt. Suraj Parkash, resident of Rajivnagar. During search, 06 grams of heroin was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and cognizance was taken by Police Post Bathindi. Poonch Police also arrested narcotic smuggler namely Rasyat Khan, son of Mohd Zaman, resident of Pamrote Tehsil Surankote and heroin contraband like substance have been recovered from his custody. The Police team headed by SHO Police Station Surankote Rajveer Singh, under the supervision of DYSP Surankote Hamid Ali Bandy on the direction of SSP Poonch Vinay Kumar Sharma was on routine patrolling at Sanai area. During patrolling aforementioned quantity of narcotics recovered from the accused person. In this regard Case Viz FIR No. 207/2023 under section 8/20/21/22 NDPS Act registered at Police Station Surankote and investigation taken up.

Warrant of drug peddler booked under PIT NDPS Case executed

JAMMU: Police on Monday executed warrant of a drug peddler booked under PIT NDPS Case. As per details, an information was received through reliable sources at Police Station Gharota regarding a notorious drug peddler namely Gulshan Kumar, son of Ashok Kumar, resident of IL.No 101, Janipur, at present Kot teh Bhalwal Distt Jammu. Finally today in compliance to the directions by Divisional Commissioner Jammu under Prevention of Illicit Traffic of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act of 1988 (PITNDPS) order No. 20 of 2023 dated 12.07.23 the detention warrant was executed and the said accused was shifted to District Jail Amphalla Jammu after completion of all legal formalities.

5 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

Bootlegger arrested, 60 bottles of illicit liquor recovered
