

DC Rajouri holds public outreach camp, resolves issues

RAJOURI: To redress the public grievances at their doorsteps, Deputy Commissioner Rajouri, Vikas Kundal on Wednesday presided over a public outreach camp in the Khabber panchayat of block Mougla.

During the event, PRIs and locals projected a wide range of demands seeking macadamization of roads, up-gradation and adequate staff in Government institutions, augmentation of water, augmentation of health infrastructure etc.

Specific Issues raised during the program were upgrading of power transformers, Kabbar road blacktopping, renovation of Devak-kabbar road, posting of doctor at PHC Taryath, provision of civic amenities in Teryath, construction of Harichumma road, requirement of bridge in Sonchal, requirement of 3-4 teachers in GHS Sarooti, revision of BPL list in Panchayat Khabbar, and adjoining area, posting of veterinary staff in Taryath and adjoining area etc.

At the outset, the CMO took review of the block wise performance and Dental care services provided by the Surgeons and discussed the deficiencies with the participants. The Chief Medical Officer directed the Dental Surgeons to put in extra efforts to promote oral hygiene and treatment among the public. Special emphasis was laid on effective implementation of the school health programme and generation of awareness about oral health and hygiene among students and communities. He asked for focusing on efficient delivery of health services in all health institutions to facilitate the public. The CMO also enjoined upon all the BMOs to see implementation of all health programmes on the ground and ensure that the benefits reach the end user without any difficulty.

To boost the local milk production of their animals, the farmers were given free of cost medicines, mineral mixtures, calcium supplements, Dewormers in addition to vaccination and the general treatment.

They were also educated about different beneficial schemes of the Department like KCC, Livestock Insurance etc.

The people were asked to co-operate & get themselves benefitted by various schemes of the Department.

The public Representative of the village appreciated the efforts put forth by the Department in uplifting the socio-economic status of the public and further asked the Department that full co-operation shall be extended for achieving the benefits extended under different schemes by the Department & requested to conduct such camps in future as well.
