4 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

JAMMU: In a cycle to stem the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams of Police Posts Talab Tillo, Manwal and Pounichak acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles two tractor trollies (JK02CF- 7393 and JK02DB-7893), by Talab Tillo police; one tipper (JK14C-5990) by Manwal Police and One JCB (JK21E-5006) by Pounichak Police.

The recoveries were made by In-Charge Police Posts Talab Tillo PSI Sonu Choudhary, Manwal-PSI Sanjeev Sharma and Pounichak-PSI Nitish Khajuria in their respective jurisdictions.

Narco smuggler nabbed with heroin

KATHUA : Intensifying its action against drug dealings and to neutralise the activities of drug peddlers within the district, Police on Friday nabbed a narco smuggler and recovered approx. 7.35 grams of Heroin (Chitta) like narcotics from his possession.

As per details, an information received through the reliable sources at Police Post Hatli that one person namely Javed Akhter, son of Mohd. Ramzan, resident of Ward No. 6 Chalag Tehsil Bani District Kathua doing illegal trade of selling Narcotics Contrband and kept huge quantity of narcotics substance in his possession. Acting swiftly, a police team led by PSI Swaran Singh Manhas In-Charge Police Post Hatli during Naka/ checking at Ward No. 13 Kathua apprehended said person Javed who was roaming under suspicious circumstances. While frisking approx. 7.35 grams of Heroin(Chitta) narcotics was recovered from illegal possession. FIR No. 311/2023 under section 8/21/22/ NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Kathua.

District, Police on Friday achieved another success by apprehending 1 thief and recovered stolen vehicles i.e. 01 Motorcycle and 01 Activa Scooty without any Registration Number from the offender who was involved in the offence.

As per details, on the complaint of the complainant namely Aswani Kumar, son of Ram Murti, resident of Ward No. 01 Kathua lodged a complaint at Police Station Kathua stating therein that some unknown thieves stole away his Splendor Plus Motorcycle (PB35V-3867). In this regard, FIR No. 305/2023 under section 379/IPC was registered at Police Station athua. During the course of investigation one person namely Rohit Singh, son of Parladh Singh, resident of Khokhyal Tehsil Nagri Parole was arrested on a suspect basis and during questioning he disclosed that he had stolen said motorcycle Splendor Plus bearing Reg. No. PB35V-3867. On further questioning, 01 more stolen vehicle (Activa Scooty) without any Registration Number was also recovered from his illegal possession. In this way the theft case of Police Station Kathua solved whereas Kathua Police has launched a manhunt for other persons involved. The recovery of the vehicles (01 motorcycle alongwith 01 Activa Scooty) made by SHO Kathua Insp. Sudhir Sadhotra.



One dead, another injured after tractor fell into gorge

KISHTWAR: In another tragic incident, one person got killed while another injured after a Tractor Trolley in which they were travelling in skidded off the road and fell into gorge near Kiru Project site in District Kishtwar on Friday Afternoon.

According to police, a tractor trolley with Water Tank was on way to Project site of Kiru Hydro Power Project in Kishtwar, when reached 200 mt ahead of the site, Driver lost control over the steering wheel due to rain and bad road condition, resulting the vehicle skidded off the road and fell into gorge.

Police, Red Cross Society Kishtwar, Ababeel and locals immediately rushed to the spot and shifted both to nearby hospital, where doctors declared one of them as brought dead.

The deceased has been identified as Mohd Younis (30), son of Gh Mohd, resident of Sowa Dunadi Doda, while injured has been identified as Nazir Ahmed s/O mohd Shafi R/O Dunadi Doda.

2 perpetrators of crime against women apprehended

Theft case solved; accused arrested, stolen cash Rs 2.4 lakh recovered

JAMMU: Police on Friday solved a theft case solved by recovering stolen cash Rs 2,40,000 and arrested the accused.

As per details, a written complaint was received at Police Station Bahu Fort by one person stating that some unknown thieves have stolen cash Rs 2,40,000 along with DVR from his shop at Sec 1A South Ext. Trikuta Nagar, Jammu in the area.

On this, a team of Police Station Bahu Fort led by SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari assisted by SHO Bahu Fort Insp Shiv Dev Singh and PSI Adarsh Kant rounded up the suspected person namely Ajay Singh, son of Bharat Singh, resident of Village Kotia Madara Tehsil Karmail District Gonda Uttar Pradesh at present Sec 1A South Extension Trikuta Nagar, Jammu. During questioning accused confessed his involvement in the above case and on his disclosure stolen cash Rs 2,40,000 along with DVR was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 207/2023 under section 457/380 IPC was registered against him at Police Station Bahu Fort. The overall arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SP South



Woman arrested with illicit liquor

KATHUA : In an another breakthrough in its drive against the trade of illicit liquor, police on Friday nabbed a woman and seized approx. 10 Litres of illicit liquor (Desi) from her possession.
