
## SHRADHANJALI

## CRIME REPORT

### Woman consumes poisonous in matador, dies

JAMMU: A woman was found dead in a matador in Jewel area.

According to the information, police was informed the co-driver of a matador that a woman has become unconscious in their matador. She was taken to the hospital where she died. The police took her body into custody. During the investigation, it was found that the marriage of the woman had taken place some time back. She sat in the Matador from Ambphala as her maternal house is in Bhagwati Nagar area. Police registered a case and during investigation it was found that she consumed poisonous substance inside the Matador.

### Man dies after falling from height

JAMMU: A man died after falling from a height under City Police Station.

According to the information, Hukam Singh, son of Bir Bahadur, resident of Nepal who was living in Purani Mandi area these days fell from a height in the morning. He was taken to the hospital but he died during treatment. Police took his body into custody. A case has been registered in this context.

### Man dies under suspicious circumstances

He was taken to the hospital but during investigation doctors declared him brought dead. After getting information, police reached the spot and took his body into custody. In this context, further action has been started by registering a case.

### Man dies, five injured in accidents

According to information, Vishal, son of Sanjay Kumar, resident of Jindad Melu area, was injured in an accident on July 18. He was admitted to GMC for treatment, but he has today. Police took his body and got the post-mortem done. In this context, further action has been started by registering a case.

### Two arrested with sharp edged weapon

According to the information, police received information that two youths are roaming in the area with the intention of attacking someone. Acting on this information, a naka was laid in the area and during checking, police caught two youths. During frisking, sharp weapons were recovered from them. Both were taken into custody and a case under relevant section of law was registered against them.

### Dumper vehicle fell into gorge, driver dies

MENDHAR: The driver of a dumper died after the vehicle skidded off the road and fell into a gorge in Mendhar area of Poonch district on Saturday. Dumper vehicle JK12B:7126 met with an accident in Naka village area of Mendhar. A rescue operation was launched by the local people and the police.

However, driver Yakub Azam son of Mohammad Hussain, resident of Bhata Dhariyan died on the spot.

### Theft case solved, stolen motorcycle recovered, lifter arrested

R S PURA: Police on Saturday solved a theft case by recovering stolen motorcycle and arrested the accused.

As per details, a written complaint was received at Police

Station R.S Pura by a person namely Ravinder Singh, son of Baichan Singh, resident of Old Agra Chal Tehsil R.S Pura District Jammu stating that his motorcycle (JK02CG-2791) was stolen from Village Agra Chak area.

As per details, a team of Police Station R.S Pura led by SDPO R.S Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO R.S Pura Insp. Pawan Kumar with the help of technical assistance finally rounded up the suspected person namely Narinder Singh alias Munna, son of Jagdish Singh, resident of Satrayan. During questioning accused confessed his involvement in the above case and on his disclosure stolen motorcycle bearing Registration No JK02CG-2791 was recovered from his possession.

He was arrested and case FIR No. 104/2023 U/S 379 IPC got registered at PS R.S Pura and accused got arrested.

### 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

JAMMU: In a quest to stem the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police teams of Police Station Bishnah, Police Posts Phallian Mandal, Sidhra and Border Police Post Gajansoo acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 04 vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles include one tractor trolley (JK21H-8556) by Bishnah Police; one dumper (JK02CN-3649) by Phallian Mandal Police; One Dumper (JK02CU-7653) by Sidhra Police and one tipper (JK02DD-4731), by Gajansoo Police.

The recoveries were made by SHO Bishnah Insp. Vikram Sharma, In-Charge Police Posts Phallian Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Janwal, Sidhra-PSI Arun Kumar and In-Charge Police Posts Gajansoo ASI Ravinder Bushan in their respective jurisdictions.

### Udhampur Police undertakes incineration of 771 Kgs & 934 grams of seized contraband substance

JAMMU: District Drug destruction committee headed by Dr. Vinod Kumar SSP Udhampur and comprising of Anwar Ul Haq Addl. SP Udhampur, Gurmeet Singh DySP Hqrs Udhampur and Darshan Singh Sr. PO Udhampur, conducted the destruction of contraband poppy straw seized in case FIR No. 481/2023 under section 8/15 NDPS Act of PS Udhampur through incineration in M/S Anmol Healthcare Rakh Rara, S w a n k h a M o r h , Vijaypur, Samba.

During incineration 07 Quintal 71 Kgs 934 grams of poppy straw, has been incinerated by following all the codal formalities. The destruction was carried out by incineration in a controlled manner as provided under rules to avoid any harm to the environment.

In the entire process, Executive Magistrate Mohd. Saleem (NT Roun) and Kuldeep Bhan Divisional Officer PCC Jammu also accompanied the drug destruction committee. Before this the seized contraband is checked, weighed and tallied with the record. The entire process, right from godown upto incinerator was duly videographed and kept under proper security.

Pertinently this huge quantity of the seized contraband substance has been destroyed under section 52-A of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

### 3 drug peddlers arrested; contraband recovered

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Saturday arrested 03 drug

peddlers in Kulgam, Handwara & Baramulla and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

In Kulgam, a police party headed by SHO Police station Behibagh at a checkpoint established at Alamgunj crossing, intercepted a suspicious person who tried to flee from the spot but was apprehended tactfully. During search, officers were able to recover 11Kgs of Poppy Straw like contraband substance concealed in a nylon bag from his possession. He has been identified as Arshid Ahmad Bhat son of Abdul Gani Bhat resident of Machewa. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

In Handwara, a police party of Police Station Qalamabad at a checkpoint established at Batagund crossing intercepted a suspicious person who tried to flee from the spot but was apprehended tactfully. During search, 50gms of Charas like substance was recovered from his possession. He has been identified as Aquib Nazir Bhat son of Nazir Ahmad Bhat resident of Kargam Handwara. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

In Baramulla, a police party led by SHO Police Station Chandoosa arrested a drug smuggler during naka checking at Daru Chandoosa. During search, 400grams of charas like contraband substance was recovered from his possession. He has been identified as Bilal Ahmad Rather son of Gh Mohiuddin Rather resident of Bandi Payeen Chandoosa. He has been shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Regarding the incidents, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective police stations and investigations have been initiated.

### Abducted girl recovered within hours, accused arrested

BARAMULLA: Police on Saturday recovered an abducted girl within hours and arrested the accused person involved in the commission of crime.

As per details, On July 21, 2023, Police Post Palhallan received a written complaint from a one person that his daughter (name withheld) aged about 16 years has been kidnapped by Gowhar Abbas son of Mohd Abbas Wani Resident of Kralwari Chadoora. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Pattan and investigation was set into motion.

Acting swiftly, a police team of Police Post Palhallan swung into action and recovered the abducted girl within 6 hours from Gamanar Chadoora Budgam and arrested the accused kidnapper on the spot. The accused person has been shifted to Police Station where he remains in custody.

After completion of all medico-legal norms, the girl was handed over to her legal heirs. Further investigation into the matter is going on.

### Theft case solved, accused arrested

BARAMULLA: Police on Saturday solved a theft case by arresting an accused person involved in the commission of crime.

As per details, on July 20, 2023, Police Station Pattan received a written application from one person namely Khurshed Ahmad Zaz son of Ab Gani Zaz (Contractor by profession) stating therein that some thieves have stolen his mixer (Cement mixer) from Shirpora Pattan near PHE water filtration plant. Accordingly, a case FIR No. 239/2023 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Pattan and investigation was initiated.

During the course of investigation, some suspects were called to the Police Station for questioning, technical tools were also used to trace out the culprits. After strenuous efforts, one suspect namely Irshad Majeed Wani son of Ab Majeed Wani resident of Chandraseer confessed his involvement in commission of crime. On his disclosure, stolen property was recovered from his residence at Chandraseer. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody. Further investigation of the case is going on.

**Snatching case solved; accused arrested, snatched items recovered**

KATHUA: In continuation to a drive launched by District Police Kathua against Thief/Snatching cases in this District, Kathua Police arrested a thief and recovered snatching items including 01 Motorola Android Phone, 01 ATM Card, 01 Adhar Card, 01 PAN Card and Cash Amount of Rs. 2000/- and seized 01 Motorcycle from the offender.

As per details, On July 21, 2023 on the complaint of the complainant namely Suman Sharma, wife of P a n k a j Sharma, resident of Shiva Nagar Ward No. 19 Kathua lodged a complaint at Police Station Kathua stating therein that one unknown person snatched her purse which includes 01 Motorola Android Phone, 01 ATM Card, 01 PAN Card, 01 Adhaar Card and Cash Amount of Rs. 2000/- and fled away. In this regard, FIR No. 314/2023 under section 382/IPC was registered at Police Station Kathua. During the course of investigation one person namely Pankaj Verma, son of Som Raj, resident of Ward No. 14 Kathua got arrested on a suspect basis and during questioning he disclosed that he had snatched said items and on his disclosure all the snatched items recovered from his possession and 1 motorcycle (JK08L-9799) used in commission of crime was also seized. In this way the snatching case of Police Station Kathua was solved. The recovery of all the snatched items made by SHO Kathua Insp. Sudhir Sadhotra.

### Two theft cases solved, stolen property worth lakhs recovered, 2 arrested

RAJOURI: Working out two cases of thefts, police on Saturday recovered stolen property worth over one lakh rupees arresting two accused. The recovered stolen property include garments, clothings, cosmetics and cash.

In an official statement, police said that in the intervening night of 4th and 5th of July, two incidents of theft were reported at police station Kandi in which one theft occurred at Shiv Mandir Kotranka and other at shop of Mohd Shafiq at Kallar Gala.

In these incidents, two separate cases in FIR No 71/2023 U/Ss 457/380 IPC and FIR No 72/2023 U/Ss 457/380 IPC were registered and investigation was taken up by a team headed by PSI PSI Rohit Sharma under the supervision of SHO Kandi Shakil Manhas.

During investigation CCTV footage of area was thoroughly analysed and over suspicion three suspects were detained who include Khushfat Hussain son of Hassan Din resident of Naika Manjakote, Khadam Hussain son of Mohd Rashid resident of Kotedhara and Kabir Hussain son of Noor Hussain resident of Manokote Thandikassi.

The arrested suspects during sustained questioning confessed for their involvement and on their disclosure recovered clothes, garments and manyri items amounting to rupees 1,10,000 and 4800 rupees cash has been recovered.

A vehicle JK11G 1834 involved in the crime has also been seized.
