JAMMU: Dushyant Singh's led India volleyball team left for the FISU World University Games 2023 to be organised in Chengdu, China from July 28 to August 8, 2023 by the Federation of University Sports of China (FUSC) under the auspices of the International University Sports Federation (FISU).

To select the Indian players, Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi has entrusted KIIT-Deemed to be University to

conduct the selection trials of the Indian Universities Archery, Athletics, Badminton and Volleyball Men & Women Teams for participation in World University Games 2023.

The selection trials were successfully conducted on June 14 and 15, 2023 at KIIT University premises.

A total of 600 approx students from over 150 universities participated in the aforesaid selection trials.

The Indian volleyball team under the captaincy of Dushyant Singh, an inter-

national player from Rajasthan University was flagged off today by Prof. (Dr.) Achyuta Samanta, Member of Parliament & President, Volleyball Federation of India and Founder KIIT & KISS University.

It is pertinent mention here that Dushyant Singh Jakhar was the first volleyball player from Rajasthan who will lead the Indian volleyball team, which is participating after 38 years in the World University Games. Under the captain-

cy of Dushyant Singh, India won silver medal at the Asian Men's U20 Volleyball Championship in Riffa, Bahrain and qualified for the FIVB Volleyball Men's U21 World Championships. In addition to the silver medal, Indian captain Dushyant Singh was also felicitated with the 'best blocker' award during the Championship.

Though it is recommended for first-time climbers to stay and rest at in between stations overnight before climbing down next day but she left the summit at 03:00PM and reached 5th Station by 06:00PM, thereby a distance of 15.1 km (7.5 km up and 7.6 km down) was covered in a day. This is famously known as "bullet hiking".

Rihanna turns out to be a natural born trekker; being a kid climber from India she was quite popular along the trail among other grown-up hikers. Moreover; she was a source of encouragement to fellow hikers. The whole trail, up and down, was covered within 9:50hours.
