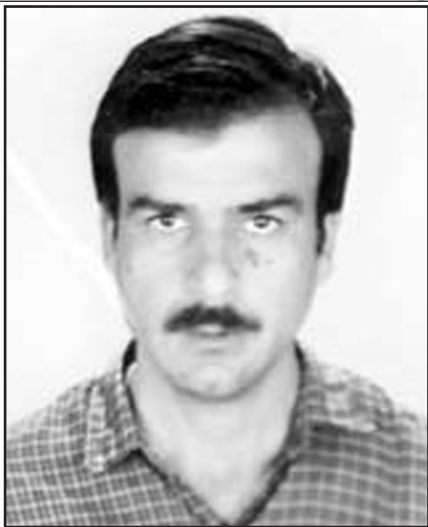

CRIME REPORT

Terror recruitment module busted in Kulgam, PhD scholar arrested

SRINAGAR: With the arrest of a PhD scholar of Central University of Kashmir, police on Wednesday said to have busted a terrorist recruitment module in Kulgam district of Jammu and Kashmir.

Two terrorist associates linked with Hizbul Mujahideen (HM)/Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) were also arrested in the case, police said.

"Acting on specific information generated by Kulgam police, a search was launched for a code-named person @Dr Sabeel who was motivating, funding and providing logistic support to the gullible youth of District Kulgam and adjoining areas to recruit them into terrorist ranks," a police spokesman said.

He said special teams were constituted to track and search for the suspected person.

"After systemic efforts, one suspected vehicle was zeroed in. When the credentials of the vehicle were sought, it came to fore that the vehicle was being used by Dr Rubani Bashir, a resident of Ashmuji, Kulgam," the spokesman said.

He said a checkpoint was established at Ashmuji and Bashir was apprehended.

"During questioning, he disclosed his code name as Dr Sabeel, a PhD scholar from Central University of Kashmir, and has also applied for job as assistant professor there.

"Dr Rubani Bashir @ Dr Sabeel also disclosed that he has been associated with Jamat-e-Islami (JeI) from his student days and he has been its member in student wing Islamic Jamat-ul-Tulbha (IJT) for 14 years and later on has been a full-fledged member of JeI. His basic modus operandi was to work for proscribed terrorist organizations HM/JeM behind the curtain. He used to identify the youngsters, motivate them, fund them and then make them ready to join terrorist organizations," the spokesman said.

It was also revealed that Bashir motivated two youngsters and made them to join the terrorist ranks.

"On the disclosure of Dr Rubani Bashir, two terrorist associates linked with HM/JeM were arrested. They have been identified as Fazil Ahmed Parrey and Tariq Ahmed Naikoo alias Chawla," he added.

On their disclosure, one Chinese pistol, one pistol magazine and nine 9mm rounds were recovered from Bashir while one AK-47 magazine and 19 AK-47 rounds were recovered from Fazil Ahmed Parrey.

One Chinese grenade, 10 AK-47 rounds and a car used for ferrying the terrorists have been seized, police said.

Meanwhile, in Bandipora district, security forces arrested one terrorist associate of Lashkar-e-Taiba at Turkpora junction.

He was identified as Javed Ahmad Malla and two hand grenades were recovered from his possession.

OGW for terrorists detained under Public Safety Act in Rajouri

RAJOURI: An Overground Worker (OGW) for terror outfits has been detained under the stringent Public Safety Act in Rajouri district, police said on Wednesday.

Akbar Hussain, a resident of Marutha-Kanthol village in the Kotranka tehsil, has been detained under the Public Safety Act on orders issued by the Rajouri district magistrate, the police said in a statement.

A police team executed the detention order and lodged him in jail.

"No one will be allowed to disturb the peaceful order in the society and whoever will be found involved in any kind of unlawful activity will have to face action as per law of land," Senior Superintendent of Police (Rajouri) Amritpal Singh said.

He said a few overground workers have already been detained under the stringent law for their activities and Hussain's detention is part of efforts to tighten the noose around those supporting terrorism.

The act is an administrative law that allows detention without charge or trial for up to two years in some cases.

Two detained under PSA in Rajouri, Samba

JAMMU: Two alleged criminals were detained under the stringent Public safety Act in Rajouri and Samba districts, police said on Wednesday.

Mohammad Shakeel, a resident of Muradpur village in Rajouri, and Balwinder Singh alias "Goru Jatt" of Rahya Ranjari in Samba were detained under the PSA for their repeated involvement in criminal activities for the past several years, a police spokesman said.

The PSA is an administrative law that allows detention without charge or trial for up to two years in some cases.

The spokesman said the order for detention of the duo was issued by concerned deputy commissioners on the recommendations of the police.

"Shakeel was found involved in multiple cases of bovine smuggling, while Singh was accused in several cases related to attempt to murder, firing and heroin trafficking. They have been posing a grave threat to public peace and tranquility," he said.

Meanwhile, four drug peddlers, including a woman, were arrested along with suspected heroin from Kathua and Jammu districts.

Vishavdeep Singh and Ranjeet Singh were arrested along with 8.30 gram of heroin during vehicle checking at Hatli Morh in Kathua, while Arun Kumar of Qasim Nagar area was apprehended with about 20 gram of heroin in Jammu, the spokesman said.

He said a suspected woman was also arrested after six gram of heroin and 200 gram of ganja was recovered from her possession in Bahu Fort area of Jammu.

10 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

JAMMU/REASI/DODA: In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Police in which police teams of Police Station Jhagjar Kotli, Police Posts Pouni Chack and Chinore acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 5 vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles included One Tipper without Registration No seized by Jhagjar kotli Police; 2 vehicles i.e One Tractor Trolley without Registration No and One Tractor Trolley bearing Chassis No RJF2MBA3989 by Pouni Chack Police and Two Tractor Trolleys bearing Chassis No.s MBNGAALUPM-RA03593 and BZUD1004131F16, by Chinore Police.

The recoveries were made by SHO Jhagjar Kotli Inspr Azad Ahmed, In-Charge Police Posts Pouni Chack PSI Nitish Khajuria and Chinore-PSI Rajesh Kumar in their respective jurisdictions.

Reasi Police has initiated strict action against the criminals involved in illegal mining & minting money out of the public resources. An information was received through reliable sources at Police Station Mahore, person named Rayaz Ahmed, son of Hassan Din, resident of Sarh, Tehsil Mahore and Bilal Ahmed, son of Bhar Din, resident of Sarh Bagga of Tehsil Mahore who illegally extracted the minerals from

Badora Nallah with the help of heavy excavator driven by Mohd Tariq, son of Muhamdu, resident of Shibrass Tehsil Mahore and two dumpers bearing registration numbers JK20B-4106 and JK20A-7951 carries sand from one place to other place illegally. On this information, a team of Police Station Mahore seized dumpers and excavator involved in transportation of illegal mining material. In this regard, FIR No.87/2023 under section 379/IPC 3,PDPP Act, 4/21 MMDR Act at Police Station Mahore. The whole operation is led by SHO mahore Insp Karnail Singh under supervision of SDPO Mahore Chhabil singh- JKPS.

DODA: In a major crackdown, District Mineral Officer Doda, Sunil Manhas, leading a departmental team, thwarted an attempt of transportation of illegal minor minerals in Bhalla area of Bhaderwah Sub District. The team seized illegal crushed material at Diamond Stone Crusher Kahara. The team seized three dumpers laden with illegal minor minerals and 65 metric tons of crushed material (Bajri).

On a tip of information from reliable sources, a prompt action was taken, and vehicles carrying illegal mining activities were seized, preventing further environmental damage. Additionally, a substantial amount of raw and finished material, totalling 65 metric tons, was also confiscated at Diamond Stone Crusher Kahara.

6 drug peddlers arrested; 320 Kgs poppy straw, contraband seized

SRINAGAR: Continuing its drive "War against drugs" to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police have arrested six drug peddlers in Anantnag & Baramulla districts. Huge quantity of contraband substances including 320 kilograms of poppy straw was recovered from their possession.

In Anantnag, acting on specific input regarding drug peddling in the jurisdiction of Police Station Dooru, a police party of PS Dooru intercepted a vehicle (Truck) bearing registration number JK18A-5471 with two persons on board at a special checkpoint established at Mandipora crossing. During checking, 320Kgs of Poppy Straw like substance was recovered from the said vehicle. The two accused persons have been identified as Balvinder Kumar son of Santok Ram resident of Pakadeem Jalender Punjab and Boshan Das son of Sangra Ram resident of Ward No 2 Mohalla Chodyan Jalender Punjab. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody. Vehicle used in the commission of crime has also been seized.

Moreover, another police party at a checking established at Mehmood Abad, Dooru crossing intercepted two persons riding a motorcycle bearing registration number JK03K-4240. During search, 4 grams of Heroin like substance was recovered from their possession. They have been identified as Malik Anzar son of Gh Nabi Malik resident of Nathipora Dooru and Nakeeb Yousuf Thakroo son of Mohd Yousuf resident of Gori Bijbehara. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody. Motorcycle used in the commission of crime has also been seized.

In Baramulla, a police party of Police Station Tangmarg under the supervision of SDPO Tangmarg Shri Intiyaz Ahmad-JKPS during naka checking at a checkpoint established at Drang Crossing Tangmarg intercepted two suspicious persons who tried to flee but were apprehended tactfully. During search, 70 grams of Charas like substance was recovered from their possession. They have been identified as Ishfaq Ahmad Khan son of Ab Rashid Khan resident of Harashnag & Lateef Ahmad Khan son of Gh Ahmad Khan resident of Khamindarpora. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective Police Stations and investigation has been initiated.

Illicit timber seized, 2 arrested

BARAMULLA: Police on Wednesday seized illicit timber and arrested two accused persons involved in the commission of crime.

Abducted girl recovered, accused arrested

BARAMULLA: Police on Wednesday recovered an abducted minor girl by arresting an accused person involved in the commission of crime.

As per details, On July 24, 2023, Police Post Palhallan received a written complaint from one person stating therein that his minor daughter is missing from home since 23-07-2023. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Pattan and investigation was initiated. During the course of investigation, with the help of technical evidences, it came fore that the missing girl has been abducted by one person identified as Nazim Ahmad Kumar son of Abdul Razak resident of Mulgam Kunzer. Consequently, police team swung into action and proceeded towards Kunzer where the accused was arrested and the abducted girl was recovered.

After completing all medico-legal formalities, the girl was handed over to her legal heirs. Further investigation into the matter is going on.

Police destroys Cannabis cultivation

Bovine smuggling bid foiled, 2 smugglers arrested

AKHNOOR: Police on Wednesday foiled a bovines smuggling bid by arresting two smugglers.

As per details, a party of Police Station Akhnoor led by SHO Akhnoor Inspr Zaheer Mushtaq under the supervision of SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Lal Sharma signaled one Mahindra bolero pickup (JK11B-5165) which was coming from Jammu side towards Chowki Chora at Khugga Naka to stop but driver of vehicle tried to escape but Naka party apprehended him.

During questioning, driver disclosed his name as Mian Lal, son of Mohd Hussain, resident of Androla Chingas Rajouri and co-passenger disclosed his name as Mohd Azam, son of Abdul Majid, resident of Androth Rajouri. During checking of the vehicle, police found bovine animals loaded mercilessly in cruel manner without fodder and water in above said vehicle. Duo was arrested and FIR No. 214/2023 under section 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act was registered.
