CRIME REPORT

Udhampur landslide incident: Inquiry Committee submits report; FIR being lodged against guilty persons

UDHAMPUR: The Inquiry Committee constituted by District Magistrate, Udhampur to inquire into the landslide incident at Kaller Himiti has submitted its report along with specific recommendations.

In response to the observations and recommendations, an FIR is being lodged against all guilty persons, while departmental action shall be initiated against the delinquent officials.

Inquiry was ordered following a landslide incident that occurred on 18th of July 2023 at an under construction building in W.No - 21, Kaller Himiti, Udhampur. Two labourers had died on the spot, while six others were seriously injured in the incident.

In addition, the District Magistrate, Udhampur has constituted a committee under the chairmanship of Additional District Magistrate, Udhampur to check the permissions of other ongoing constructions being carried out within the limits of the Municipal area.

Drug peddler arrested, 20 Kgs of poppy straw recovered

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Jammu Police on Friday nabbed a drug peddler and recovered 20 Kgs of poppy straw from his possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station Bakshi Nagar led by SDPO West Vikram Singh assisted by SHO Bakshi Nagar Inspr Rakesh Sharma while on patrolling duty near Resham Ghar rounded up a suspected person later identified as Davinder Kumar, son of Sain Dass, resident of F-520 Resham Ghar Jammu. During search, 20 Kgs of poppy straw was recovered from his possession.

He was arrested and FIR No. 110/2023 under section 8/15 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Bakshi Nagar.

Notorious criminal booked under PIT NDPS Act

MIRAN SAHIB: Police on Friday booked a notorious criminal under PIT NDPS Act.

As per details, an information was received at Police Station Miran Sahib through reliable sources regarding one notorious person namely Navjot Singh alias Bablu, son of Amar Singh, resident of Indira Nagar.

On this, a team of Police Station Miran Sahib led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Miran Sahib Inspr Bopinder Singh raided at the suspected place and arrested the

above said drug peddler.

It is pertinent to mention here that the accused person was a notorious and hardcore criminal and was involved in many cases of drug peddling and dealing in narcotics. Also a warrant of arrest was issued against the said accused by District Magistrate Jammu.

Finally today in compliance to the directions of District Magistrate Jammu, under Prevention of Illicit Traffic of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act of 1988 (PITNDPS) the detention warrant has been executed.

Three notorious criminals arrested under PSA

RS PURA/RAJOURI: Police on Friday arrested three notorious criminals under Public Safety Act.

As per details, an information was received through reliable sources regarding two notorious criminals namely Sandeep Kumar alias Shotu, son of Tarsem Lal, resident of Chak Aslam Tehsil R.S Pura District Jammu and Sunny Kumar, son of Yog Raj, resident of W No. 4 R.S Pura District Jammu who were evading their arrests in 17 heinous criminal cases, including attempt to murder, stabbing, snatching, Arms Act, Kidnapping etc.

On this, a team of Police Station R S Pura led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO PS RS Pura Inspr Pawan Kumar finally raided at the suspected place and rounded up the above mentioned persons.

It is pertinent to mention that a warrant of arrest was issued against the said accused. Finally today the warrant has been executed and both the accused got shifted to Central Jail Kot Bhalwal Jammu.

Rajouri police also booked another notorious criminal under Public Safety Act (PSA) which is third such detention in this week.

The notorious criminal namely Amjad Mehmood son of Mohd Zafar resident of Bada Kana, Tehsil Thanamandi, Rajouri has been booked under Public Safety Act for repeated criminal activities which are highly prejudicial and detrimental to the maintenance of public order.

The accused has not changed his behaviour inspite of lodging multiple FIRs against him and arrests by Police number of times.

He is hell bent upon carrying burglaries, thefts and extortion in different parts of J&K and such activities are likely to disturb public order particularly in Rajouri District.

Keeping in view the activities of said accused as his activities amounts to pose serious threat to public order and deserves to be taken into preventive custody, as such, the accused is ordered to be detained under section 8 (1) (a) (i) read with clause (ii) of sub-section (2) of section 8 of Jammu & Kashmir Public Safety Act.

Detention order of accused was issued by District Magistrate Rajouri who is the competent authority while this order has been executed by a team of police headed by SHO Thanamandi Hiral Azhar under the supervision of SDPO Thanamandi Dr. Intiaz Ahmed.

Missing girl traced, reunited with family

JAMMU: Police on Friday traced a missing girl and reunited her with her family.

As per details, an information was received through reliable sources regarding one girl wandering unnecessarily in the area under the jurisdiction of Police Station Miran Sahib.

On this, a team of Police Station Miran Sahib including lady constables brought the said girl to Police station and offered her meals. Woman killed, two others including BSF jawan injured in mishap

Jammu: A woman lost her life while two others were injured in a road accident in Jammu district.

According to information, an accident took place at BSF Camp Paloura in which a car hit the pole in which 3 people were injured and were taken to GMC Jammu for treatment where the doctors of GMC declared one as brought dead. He told that his body has been kept in the mortuary room for postmortem.

The injured were identified as SGCT Rakesh Verma posted Gulshan Ground, son of Devi Das Verma, resident of Patoli Mangotrian and Monika Gupta, wife of Romesh Gupta, resident of Talab Tillo while the deceased was identified as Bandana.

Bodies of missing minor sisters recovered from canal

JAMMU: The bodies of two minor sisters who went missing two days ago in Digiana area have been recovered from the canal as both died due to drowning.

According to the information, two sisters, in which five-year-old Shivani daughter Ram Das resident of Chhattisgarh, who

lived in Digiana these went out of the house with her three-year-old sister Aarushi but didn't come back. A complaint was given to police by their family members after which the police started the search. During scrutinizing CCTVs in was found that they were going towards the canal and after that police asked the people around Canal then a child told that she had fallen into a canal and other drowned trying to save her. Later the bodies of both were recovered on Friday.

Gas cylinder explodes while welding, 2 suffer burn injuries

2 fraudsters arrested with huge stolen cash

POONCH: Police on Friday arrested 2 fraudsters with huge stolen cash.

As per details, On July 28, 2023, one woman namely Diksha Sudan, wife of Abhishek Uttam, resident of Ward No 8 Poonch appeared in Police Station Poonch and gave a written complaint regarding ATM Swapping that happened on July 23, 2023 and cash Rs 40,000 was stolen fraudulently by the fraudsters. In this connection , FIR No.113/2023 U/S 420/379 IPC was registered at Police Station Poonch and investigation of the case entrusted to PSI Sushant Singh.

During the course of investigation hectic efforts were made to arrest the accused persons as they were absconding after the commission of the crime. With the help of some technical and human inputs accused persons were identified and a manhunt was launched to apprehend the thieves. After hectic efforts, the accused namely Mohd Shabir, son of Zakir Hussain, resident of Mangnar Poonch and Kiran Sharma, son of Joginder Sharma, resident of Talab Tillo, Jammu have been arrested and Rs 33,000 out of the stolen amount has been recovered from their possession. The arrest and recovery has been made by Inspr Javaid Manhas SHO PS City Poonch assisted by PSI Sushant Singh under the close supervision of DySP Hqrs Poonch Afrat Hussain and ASP Poonch Mushim Ahmed and under the overall supervision SSP Poonch Vinay Sharma.
