Whereas, the Provisional Select List was issued vide Notification No. 26- PSC (DR-S) of 2023 dated 03.07.2023 subject to objections, if any, which were to be submitted within 5 days; **and,**

Whereas, two representations one each from Mr. Vishal Singh Kotwal, R/o Chinta Bhadarwah and Mr. Khalid UI Islam Rather has been received in the Commission. Mr. Vishal Singh Kotwal has submitted that his name is not mentioned in Annexure-A of the Provisional Select List, which may be rectified and Khalid UI Islam Rather has alleged that the selected candidate does not possess the relevant experience; **and,**


Whereas, the representations have been examined. Upon further scrutiny of the documents of the candidates who were called for interview, it was found that Mr. Vishal Singh Kotwal does not possess the relevant experience, hence, is in-eligible for the post. The objection of Khalid UI Islam Rather against the selected candidate is vague and without any substance as the candidate has not substantiated his claim with any documentary evidence.

Now, therefore, the representations are disposed of being devoid of merit.

NOTIFICATION

i. Whereas, list of eligible or in-eligible candidates seeking grant of sports category weightage for admission in NEET-UG and B-Pharmacy Courses 2023 under Sports Quota was notified on 11.07.2023 for inviting objections / grievances if any upto 18.07.2023 including appearance for physical verification test on 17.07.2023; **and**

ii. Whereas, objections / grievances have been received from various quarters within the stipulated period; **and**

iii. Whereas, objection / grievances, Physical verification reports forwarded by respective Divisional Sports Officers and communications No.8-9/2023-SP-III dated 22-5-2023 from Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, F No. 9-A/2018-SP-1/SP-III dated 29-7-2022 including interim directions passed by the Hon'ble High Court of J&K in the petition No.WP(C)1815/2023(titled) Ananta Zahoor v/s J&K Sports Council and WP(C) No.1851/2023(Muzamil Nazir Khanday & others v/s UT of J&K & anr were placed before the committee for taking a view in the matter; **and**

iv. Whereas, the committee after due consideration and deliberations in the said matter recommended as under:-

a) The prayer/ grievances made by the Sqay Sports applicants including court directions were considered by the committee and found devoid of merit. The committee reiterated its stand in the matter already decided in the previous meeting.

b) The interim direction passed by the Hon'ble High Court of J&K in the petition No.1815/2023 titled Ananta Zahoor v/s J&K Sports Council was considered by the committee and found devoid of merit in view of the reason that recognition of All India Silambam Federation stands withdrawn by the Government of India on 29th July 2022 and as such the Sports certificates issued by the said federation after this date are invalid for any Government privileges.

c) The representations made by Mr. FaizanNisar, Ms. AnantaZahoor, Ms. Tehreem Qayoom Jan for entertaining the sports certificate in other sports discipline were considered by the committee and found devoid of merit in view of the reason that these certificate have not been deposited/appended by the applicants with the application forms before the cut off date of the receipt of applications.

d) The representation made by Ms. Harleen Kour with regard to considering her participation certificate in Women's Asia Cup 2023 was also considered and found devoid of merit due to the reason that this tournament is not covered under the extant rules.

e) The representation made by S. Shabeela Ashraf for consideration of her achievements in curling sports was examined by the committee and found devoid of merit due to the reason that General Body of Indian Olympic Association has not formally ratified the recognition of the Curling Federation of India and as such the candidates in this sports have not been found eligible.

f) The achievements of the applicants in the Tennis Volleyball Sports has also been considered and it was observed that Tennis Volleyball Federation of India does not fall in the list of recognized Sports Federations appended with the communication No.8-9/2023-SP-III dated 22-5-2023 from Under Secretary to the Government.

No.8-9/2023-SP-III dated 22-5-2023 from Under Secretary to the Government, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports Department of Sports. Accordingly the candidates in this sports have not been found eligible.

g) The committee also examined the physical verification reports of the applicants forwarded by the respective Divisional Sports Officers and decided that eligibility of the candidates who remained absent during physical test/viva be dropped.


h) The error pointed out by Shri Mohammad Zuhas in Bridge Sports was examined and rectified.

i) The committee further desired that reminders be issued to the concerned National Sports Federations/UT Associations / Divisional Sports Officer (J) for expediting the verification report of certificates in the disciplines of Ju-Jutsu, Shooting Ball and Bridge Federations, till then the eligibility of the candidates in such sports shall remained conditional. Screening of teams in respect of Sh. Sumit Singh and Ms. Harleen Kaur shall be conducted by the respective association as reported by the Divisional Sports Officer (J), J&K Sports Council, as such their eligibility dropped.
