Minor girl abducted from Kathua rescued in UP, 1 held

JAMMU: A 15-year-old girl from Kathua, who was allegedly abducted by a youth, was recovered from Uttar Pradesh, police said on Saturday.
 Puneet Kumar (19), a resident of New Delhi's Sarai Rohilla area, was arrested during the rescue operation, a police spokesperson said.
 On July 4, the victim's father filed a missing complaint of his daughter at Rajbagh police station, he said.
 Accordingly, an FIR was registered and an investigation was set into motion, the spokesperson said, adding that after strenuous efforts, police managed to trace the accused and rescue the girl from Mathura in Uttar Pradesh.
 Kumar has been taken into custody and the victim has been handed over to her parents after completion of legal formalities, the spokesperson said.

Theft case solved; 2 arrested, stolen items recovered

JAMMU: Police on Saturday solved a theft by arresting two thieves and recovered stolen items.
 As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Post Belicharana by a person namely Mehmood Ahmed, son of Ghulam Qadir, resident of Belicharana regarding theft in his house in the area. FIR No. 132/2023 under section 457/380 IPC was registered at Police Station Satwari and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Post Belicharana led by SDPO South Sachit Sharma assisted by SHO Satwari Insp Sumeet Sharma and In-Charge Police Post Belicharana SI Suresh Kumar rounded up two accused persons namely Intiyaz Ahmed Khan, son of Lal Hussain and Sachin Kumar, son of Sham Lal, resident of Poonch Basti Belicharana.
 During sustained questioning the accused person confessed their involvement in the above said case and on their disclosure stolen items were recovered from their possession which include 2 gas Cylinders; 1 Motor Electric; 1 Gas Bhatti; 1.5 Kg Wire (Kabad); Iron (Kabad)- 10-12 Kg.
 The overall operation was done under the supervision of SP South Shaheen Wahid.

Eight narco-smugglers including most wanted woman heroin supplier arrested

JAMMU/KATHUA/SAMBA: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Saturday nabbed eight narco smugglers including most wanted woman heroin smuggler and recovered heroin from their possession.
 As per details, a team of Police Post Canal led by Dy. SP HQs Dr Sunmiya Wani assisted by SHO Nowabad Insp Surinder Raina and In-Charge Police Post Canal PSI Mohd Younis Khanday while on Naka duty near Bhagwati Nagar area rounded up a suspected person namely Sahil, son of Yashpaul, resident of Surya Vihar Near NMS Colfele Anand Nagar Bohri. During search, 3 grams of heroin was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 108/2023 under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Nowabad.
 Similarly another team of Police Post Sidhra led by SDPO Nagrota Akash Kohli assisted by SHO Nagrota Insp Vishav Partap Singh and In-Charge Police Post Sidhra PSI Arun Kumar while on Naka duty at Naka Point Tawi Bridge Sidhra rounded up two suspected persons coming on a vehicle (JK02AV 1071). During search 03 grams of heroin was recovered from their possession.
 Duo identified as Ankit Koul, son of Ashok Kumar Koul, resident of Lane No 09 Flat No 8 Block No 49 Jagi Colony and Sahil Ganjoo, son of Shubam Lal Ganjoo, resident of Flat No 08 lane No 16 Block No 79 Jagti Colony Tehsil Nagrota distt Jammu were arrested and FIR No 287/2023 under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Nagrota
 At Kathua, Police recovered approx. 8.98 grams of Heroin (Chitta) like narcotics from a narco smuggler from Chak Drab Khan area. An information was received through the reliable sources that one person Namely Makhan Singh, son of Bhajan Singh, resident of Gujrair Tehsil and District

Kathua doing illegal trade of selling Narcotics contraband and kept huge quantity of narcotics substance in his possession. Acting swiftly a police team led by PSI Rahul Prashar In-Charge Police Post Nagri Parole during Naka/ checking at Chak Drab Khan near Tube Well area apprehended said person namely Makhan Singh who was roaming under suspicious circumstances. While frisking approx. 8.98 grams of Heroin(Chitta) narcotics was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 293/2023 under section 8/21/22/ NDPS Act has been registered at Police Station Kathua.
 Samba Police also achieved a major success by arresting four female heroin suppliers including most wanted female heroin supplier Saleema code name "Bachi" of Balole, Bari Brahmana, district Samba.
 The arrested lady heroin suppliers have been identified as Saleema Bibi alias Bachi, wife of Murad Ali alias Chuhui, resident of Balole Nallah Bari Brahmana district Samba; Gunma Bibi, wife of Kaga Gujjar, resident of Sidhra district Jammu; Fullan Bibi, wife of Teg Ali, resident of Chak Baggian Vjajpur district Samba and Salima Bibi, wife of Mansha, resident of Rakh Barotian Vjajpur district Samba.
 On a specific tip off that the most wanted heroin supplier escorted by her accomplices was traveling from Kathua side to Samba by a vehicle, a joint Police party of District Anti NDPS team and Police Post Supwal headed by Incharge Police Post Supwal PSI Deepika Jolotra laid a naka near NIHSupwal, conducted checking of all passenger vehicles as well as private vehicles and interecepted four suspected ladies who turned out to be most wanted heroin supplier "Bachi" of Balole and three other female smugglers two of whom also involved in attack on Police near Rakh Barotian Vjajpur. Accordingly, they were handed over to the police parties of concerned Police Stations who immediately reached Police Post Supwal and arrested the accused under law.
 While two heroin suppliers namely Saleema code name Bachi & Gunma of Sidhra Jammu have been arrested by Bari Brahmana Police, two lady heroin smugglers namely Fullan & Salima of RakhBarotian, who were also involved in attack on Police near RakhBarotian, have been arrested by Vjajpur Police.
 "Bachi" of Balole was most wanted on account of her continuous involvement in heroin smuggling and supplying to the youth of Samba, Jammu, Kathua, Udhampur, Reasi, Rajouri, Poonch, Ramban, Doda&Kishtwar.Arrest of Bachi is a major success on the part of Police as she had been evading arrest for long and had been giving slip to police everyting during special nakas and raids organized to nab her. Off late, Bachi had changed her hideout from BaloleNallah to Sidhra Jammu due to geared up raids and intensified patrolling by Samba police around BaloleNallah& used to visit Samba to supply heroin to youth in the guise of some other innocent lady and used to introduce herself by different names.

Police cracks whip on stunt bikers; 17 bikers booked
