

Two-day training and management session on Autism Spectrum Disorder concludes

JAMMU: Bhupinder Kumar, Secretary to the Health and Medical Education Department, inaugurated a two-day training and management session on Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) at SMGS Hospital, Shalamar, Jammu.

The event, organized to raise awareness about autism and enhance management practices, marked a significant step toward ensuring the well-being of children with ASD in the region.

During his opening remarks, Bhupinder Kumar emphasized the importance of preventing autism and highlighted the need for concerted efforts to address this issue. He acknowledged that while this training session marked a humble beginning, there is still a long way to go in terms of detection and intervention for children with autism.

Stressing the significance of collaboration, Bhupinder Kumar emphasized the government's commitment to form meaningful partnerships with organizations like Children in India to ensure that no child

with a disability is left behind. Principal, GMC Jammu, Dr. Shashi Sudhan Sharma gave the opening remarks highlighting the need to work more vigorously for Children with Autism.

R. Britikah, Program Manager introduced the Children in India initiative to the gathering.

The two-day training and management session, organized by Children in India in partnership with NHM, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir, and the Child Development Centre, Kerala, witnessed the participation of esteemed guests and dignitaries from various medical institutions, the Rotary Club, Jammu and the Inner Wheel Club of Jammu.

The event aimed to equip medical practitioners with essential knowledge and skills for identifying, intervening, and effectively managing autism.

A consortium of medical professionals from multiple DEICs, the northern army command, NHM, SMGS, and GMC Jammu actively participated in the workshop, which

was led by a renowned faculty from the Child Development Centre (CDC), Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.

The CDC faculty curated a comprehensive curriculum designed to streamline the understanding and practice of autism management.

Dr. Santhosh George, Founder Trustee, Children in India encouraged the participants to pose relevant queries, proposing an empathetic pathway of care for children with ASD. Dr. Ghanshyam Saini, H.O.D Pediatrics, Dr. Ashu Jamwal, H.O.D Neonatology, and Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Digra, Professor of Pediatrics at the Government Medical College

and Hospital, Jammu, congratulated the faculty from the Child Development Centre and the enthusiastic participants for their commitment to learning about autism management.

The two-day training and management session concluded on Saturday, with a hands-on training module on group therapy, led by the expert team from the Child Development Centre, Kerala, providing participants with practical skills to further enhance autism management practices. State Disability Program Coordinator for Children in India, Jammu, Ms. Vidushi Sharma provided the closing remarks for the session.

During the meeting, the District Development Commissioner took detailed sector wise review & progress under District Capex Budget including UT Capex, Area Development Fund, Aspirational Block Development Programme & Aspirational Panchayat Development Programme in education, RDD, PDD, PHHE, Health and other sectors.

She also reviewed the estimation of proposed works, Administrative Approvals, number of works tendered, allotment of works, works initiated and completed and other related issues. The meeting was informed that a total of 3036 works which includes 2599 new works and 437 ongoing works have been taken up under District Capex 2023-24 including ADF, ABDP and APDP.

The concerned officers were asked to expedite the estimation and tendering process and complete the entire process by the end of this month. The DC also directed them to personally monitor the quality and progress of all ongoing works and make maximum use of the working season to complete all the works.
