Giving more powers to LG necessary for momentum of development in J&K: Chugh

'People sick of partisan politics of Abdullahs, Muftis'

JAMMU: BJP National General Secretary Tarun Chugh on Sunday said vesting more powers in the hands of Jammu and Kashmir Lt Governor was necessary to sustain the momentum of development and ensure good gov ernance in the Union territory.

Chugh, who also serves as the party's in-charge for J&K, also came down heavily on National Conference Vice President and former Chief Minister Omar Abdullah for "misleading" people on the recent amendments to the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act.

"Abdullahs are unable to see the ground realities," the senior BJP leader said.

In a statement, Chugh defended the amendments to the Act, describing them as a measure to strengthen democratic governance in the Union Territory, combat corruption and ensure equitable development.

CHICAGO/WASHING-TON: Former US president Donald Trump survived an attempt on his life on Saturday when a young shooter fired multiple shots at him at a campaign rally in Pennsylvania, injuring his right ear, days before he was to accept the Republican Party's nomination for the presidential election in November.

Trump, 78, was speaking at the packed outdoor election rally in Butler town when bullets started flying. Video footage showed him grabbing his ear as shots were fired. The crowd started screaming behind him and then someone yelled "Get down, get
