

### Human Trafficking case: 2 more accused persons arrested; 3 more minor girls rescued

BARAMULLA: Police rescued 3 more minor girls and arrested 2 persons involved in case FIR No. 173/2024 of PS



Baramulla. During the course of investigation of case FIR No. 173/2024 of PS Baramulla, it surfaced that two (02) more persons identified as Ghulam Mohammad Khan son of Ab Rehman resident of Narbal & Manzoor Ahmad Shah son of Gh Mohammad resident of Janbazpora, were also involved in the trafficking and exploitation of minor girls from outside

Subsequently, a police party of Police Station Baramulla headed by SHO PS Baramulla, arrested both the accused persons and were shifted to Police Station Baramulla, besides, recovered three minor victim girls of Rohingya, Burma.

Pertinent to mention here that two (02) accused persons from Baramulla were arrested and 4 minor girls were rescued during the initial investigation of the case.

This operation demonstrates the commitment of the J&K Police to combating human trafficking and ensuring the safety and dignity of vulnerable individuals.

## 7 vehicles involved in illegal extraction & transportation of minerals seized

KULGAM: To curb the menace of illegal mining and to foil the degradation of the river Veshaw and other Nallahs of the district, Police in Kulgam along with officers of geology and mining department, arrested 7 persons and seized 7 vehicles including (02 JCBs & 05 Tractors) involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals from Vishaw river at Chahlan and other areas

## Saroori demands key reforms in upcoming Union Budget 2024-25



KISHTWAR: As the Union Budget 2024-2025 is set to be presented on 23rd July, Vice President of the Democratic Progressive Azad Party and former Minister, Ghulam Mohammad Saroori, conducted a visit to various areas of the sub-division Chatroo in Kishtwar district. During his visit, he listened to public grievances and highlighted several critical issues that need to be addressed in the upcoming budget. Saroori emphasized the urgent need for the government to increase the salaries of daily rated wagers and casual laborers working in departments such as Jal Shakti, R&B, JKPCC RDD and others. from the current Rs 9.000 to Rs 30,000. He argued that this increase is essential to ensure a decent standard of living for these workers. Highlighting the lack of rural infrastructure development, Saroori called for the government to sanction roads with special provisions for land and structure compensations in villages with populations exceeding 250. He alleged that since 2014, the government has failed to construct even a single inch of rural roads, leaving many areas isolated and underdeveloped. Saroori also urged the govern-

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schools in remote areas that lack private educational institutions. He pointed out that while cities have numerous private schools; rural areas often rely solely on government schools, which need significant improvements to provide quality education. In addition, Saroori demanded that the government allocate funds in the budget to extend the Jal Jeevan scheme to all remaining areas, ensuring that every household has access to drinking water. He also called for the abolition of the New Pension Scheme (NPS) and the reinstatement of the old pension scheme for all employees who joined after 2011. Reflecting on the previous budget, Saroori reminded the government of its promise to make Jammu and Kashmir a model of development. However, he expressed disappointment that many people feel betrayed by the lack of progress and tangible results. He urged the government to clear all outstanding liabilities, amounting to approximately ?300 crores, for completed proj-

ment's city and town scheme. Saroori concluded by stating that the upcoming budget should be public-friendly and address these critical issues to provide relief to the people. He emphasized that the focus should be on effective and impactful allocations rather than the rumored Rs 1.18 lakh crores budget, with major attention on employment and rural development.

According to reliable sources once again Chlorine gas got leaked from MES water filtration plant at Sangoor area of Udhampur. However no casualities reported so far filing last report police said." As the gas spread in the area its smell caused unrest among the residents but so far no report of anyone falling sick because of leakage was reported from the area, the police said, adding the situation is under control. Police and fire services reached on spot immediately and started rescue and evacuated school children and local residents. 
