Whereas, as per the Indent/Advertisement Notification, the requisite qualification for selection against these posts is (was) "Matric with Science"; and

Whereas, the Jammu & Kashmir Services Selection Board (JKSSB), advertised the said 116 posts as per the category wise breakup given herein above, vide Advertisement Notification No. 04 of 2021 dated 17-07-2021 under various Items, for seeking applications for the eligible candidates. The cut off date for the receipt of Online Application Forms was 06-09-2021, which was later extended till 17-09-2021; and

Whereas, the Jammu & Kashmir Services Selection Board (JKSSB) conducted written examination for the post of Veterinary Pharmacist, Animal/Sheep Husbandry & Fisheries Department, on 11-02-2024; and

Whereas, the JKSSB, vide Notification No. JKSSB-COE/EXAM(UT)/104/2023-03 (7368111) dated 19-02-2024, issued the result/Score Sheet of the candidates who appeared in the OMR Based written Examination held on 11-02-2024 for the said post. Thereafter, schedule of Documents Verification (D.V) of the Candidates falling under the consideration zone were notified vide Notification No. JKSSB-COE/EXAM(UT)/104/2023-03(7368111) dated 12-03-2024 and Supplementary Document Verification (D.V) vide No. JKSSB-COE/EXAM(UT)/104/2023-03(7368111) dated 22-03-2024; and

Whereas, the JKSSB vide Office Order No.187-SSB of 2024 dated 14-05-2024, constituted Selection Committee for preparing the Selection list for the post of Veterinary Pharmacist, Animal/Sheep Husbandry and Fisheries Department, Divisional/District Cadre, advertised vide Advertisement Notification No. 04 of 2021 dated 17-07-2021; and

Whereas, the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu Bench while vacating the Stay in Original Application No. 61/1239/2021, titled Deepak Kumar & Ors. V/s UT of J&K and Ors., in its order dated; 29-05-2024, directed that :

"...15. The case of the applicants is that they are better suited candidates for selection to the post of Stock Assistant and Assistant Stock Man in the Animal/Sheep Husbandry Department, as they possess one year diploma in Paravet Training Course and Stock Assistant Training Course from Govt. Institutions, in comparison to candidates possessing qualification of matric with Science, prescribed in Advertisement Notification No. 04 of 2021 dated; 17.07.2021. The Applicants seek weightage and preferential marks for possessing diploma. In our considered opinion, weightage or preferential marks can only be granted, if the same has been prescribed in the Advertisement and recruitment rules. In the case in hand, from perusal of record, we find that the prescribed qualification for the post of Stock Assistant and Veterinary Pharmacist is Matric with Science only and there is no provision for granting weightage or preferential marks for possessing diploma in the subject concerned.

16. Since, there is no such provision in the Advertisement Notice or recruitment rules granting weightage or preferential marks for possessing diploma in the subject concerned, the applicants cannot demand weightage or preferential marks. The applicants are basically trying to prescribe qualification for the post of Stock Assistant and Veterinary Pharmacist, which is sole domain of the employer only.

17. In this regard, reliance is placed on the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Maharashtra Public Service Commission V/S Sandeep Sharma & Ors. (2019) 6 SCC 362, in which it was held as under:

"9. The essential qualifications for appointment to a post are for the employer to decide. The employer may prescribe additional or desirable qualifications, including any grant of preference. It is the employer who is best suited to decide the requirement a candidate must possess according to the needs of the employer and the nature of work. The court can't lay down the conditions of eligibility, must less can it delve into the issue with regard to desirable qualification being on a par with essential eligibility by an interpretive re-writing of the Advertisement. Questions of equivalence will also fall outside the domain of judicial review. If the language of the advertisement and the rules are clear, the court cannot sit in judgement over the same. If there is an ambiguity in the advertisement or it is contrary to any rules or law, the matter has to go back to the appointing authority after appropriate orders, to proceed in accordance with law. In no case can the court, in the grab of judicial review, sit in the chair of the appointing authority to decide what is best for the employer and interpret the conditions of the advertisement contrary to the plain language of the same."

18. It also appears from the record that many of the applicants had participated in the Selection process for the post of Stock Assistant and Veterinary Pharmacist, however, they could not succeed in the same and, thereafter, they have challenged the selection process. It is also a settled law an unsuccessful participant cannot turn around and challenge the selection process, after participating in it without any challenge.

19. In case of Tajvir Singh Sodhi and Ors Vs. The State of Jammu and Kashmir and Others 2023 Livelaw (SC) 253, it was held that:

"13.1 It is, therefore, trite that candidates, having taken part in the selection process without any demur or protest, cannot challenge the same after having been declared successful. The candidates cannot approbate and reprobate at the same time. In other words, simply because the result of the selection process is not palatable to a candidate, he cannot allege that the process of interview was unfair or that there was some lucana in the process. Therefore, we find that writ petitioners in these cases, could not have questioned before a Court of Law, the rationale behind recasting the selection criteria, as they willingly took part in the selection process even after the criteria had been so recast. Their candidature was not withdrawn in light of the amended criteria. A challenge was thrown against the same only after they had been declared unsuccessful in the selection process, at which stage, the challenge ought not have been entertained in light of the principle of waiver and acquiescence."

20. In view of the aforesaid judicial pronouncements and discussions made herein above, the O.A. being devoid of any merit is dismissed.

21. The interim order dated 17.08.2021 passed by this Tribunal restraining the respondents from declaring the result of the selection stands vacated. The respondents are at liberty to declare the result and take further action, as per rules.

22. No order as to costs."

Whereas, upon the receipt of the aforesaid directions from the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal, Jammu Branch, the provisional selection list for the aforementioned posts prepared as per the merit/eligibility of the candidates and having regard to the extant rules /regulations was placed before the Board at its 276<sup>th</sup> Board meeting held on 25.06.2024, which, after due consideration and deliberation on various aspects attendant to the selection, approved its notification.

Whereas, the above Provisional Selection List inter-alia provided that any candidate aggrieved with it or who intends to furnish any document/clarification regarding his/her withheld candidature shall represent with objections, if any, after due examination and scrutiny of the representations received in response to the notification of the Provisional Selection List, the Selection Committee framed the Final Selection List for these posts of Veterinary Pharmacist, Animal/Sheep Husbandry and Fisheries Department, which was subsequently approved in the 279<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting held on 25.07.2024.

Now, therefore, the Final selection list of the candidates for the above mentioned 116 posts of Veterinary Pharmacist, Animal/Sheep Husbandry and Fisheries Department advertised vide Notification No. 04 of 2021 dated 17.07.2021 under various items is hereby notified as Annexure-A to this notification. It is further notified that:

- The above Final Selection List shall be subject to outcome of the OAs/Writ Petition(s), if any, pending adjudication before any Competent Court of law.
- The List shall also be subject to the outcome of such enquiry, involving any candidate(s), as figuring in this List.
- The formal recommendations to the concerned Indenting Department shall be forwarded separately.
- The candidates whose recommendations are kept withheld shall submit the requisite documents/certificates within a period of one month.
- The Selection of the candidates has been made on the basis of Self-declaration/Certificates submitted by them and if at any stage, it comes to the light that any candidate(s) has submitted false information or has secured selection on the basis of fake documents/certificates, the selection shall be liable to cancellation at any stage.
