Court restrains respondents from taking over affairs of Gurdwara Chatti Patshahi Tali Sahib

JAMMU: In a suit filed by Balvinder Singh and Surjeet Singh Vice President and Secretary District Gurudwara Prabandhak Committee for declaration to the effect that the, letter bearing No. DGPCJ/077/2025 dt. May 3, 2025 issued by the defendant No.1 authorizing the defendant No.2 to appoint and announce a local committee of Gurdwara Chatti Patshai, Talab Tillo, Jammu be declared as void ab-initio, null and void and also the suit for declaration to the effect declaring the Letter with Ref. No. 22/2025 dt. May 5, 2025 issued by the defendant No. 2 to appoint Harpreet Kour, daughter of Janak Singh, resident of Bhagwati Nagar, Jammu (Defendant no.3) and Manmohan Singh, son of Manohar Singh, C/O Gurdwara Chand Kour, Chand Nagar, Jammu (Defendant no.4) as President and Secretary of

Gurdwara Chatti Patshai Talab Tillo, Jammu be declared as null and void with a consequential relief of permanent prohibitory injunction restraining the defenda No. 3 and 4 from acting as President and Secretary. Sub-Judge Jammu Sunil Koul after hearing both the sides restrained the respondents from taking over the affairs of Gurdwara Chatti Patshahi Tali Sahib.

Sub-Judge Jammu Sunil Koul after hearing both the sides observed that from the plain reading of J&K Sikh Gurdwaras & Religious Endowment Act read with relevant rules i. 11, 13, 14 of the Act read with Rule 49 and 50 framed under the act it is clear that no individual power has been vested in any member of the committee i.e. District Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee constituted for any district or one or more district jointly to do any act which the committee m

empowered. From the facts and circumstances of the present easels clear that plaintiffs at this stage have been able to raise tribal issue which requires to be determined in trial i.e. issue with respect to power of the members of the Committee of the DGPC Jammu i.e. whether such power referred under the act have been conferred upon the members If the Committee in their individual capacity of being the elected members of a particular area or such powers is to be exercised by the members of the Committee jointly.

Further issue raised is that whether the defendant no. 2 Karan Singh Bali could have recommended pendant no. 3 Harpreet Singh as president of Gurdwara when same issue is raised in previous suit instituted by him and pending before Court of Sub-Judge-City Judge Jammu.

Sub-Judge Jammu observed that so balance of

convenience in the present case also lies with the plaintiffs being the Vice-President and secretary of the Gurudwara Prabhanbdak Committee Jammu.

It is pertinent to mention here that the plaintiffs have not filed the suit in their personal capacity by have filed the suit to preserve the interests of the Gurudwara Prabhanbdak Committee Jammu.

Besides the nature of the suit is that if interim relief of preserving the rights of the plaintiffs with respect to Gurudwara Prabhanbdak Committee Jammu is not granted then plaintiffs definitely will suffer irreparable loss which later on can't be compensated in terms of money.

The plaintiffs have been able to satisfy all the three conditions i.e. prima facie case, balance of convenience and irreparable loss for the grant of relief under Order 39 read with Rule 1 and 2. As such ad-interim order of this court dated 06.05.2025 by virtue of which the operation of impugned letter dated 03.05.2025 and 05.05.2025 had been stayed and defendants had been restrained.

DB set-aside life-imprisonment of husband for wife's murder

JAMMU: A Division Bench of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court Comprising Justice Sindhu Sharma and Justice Shahzad Azeem set-aside life-imprisonment of one Maan Chand who was convicted by the Trial Court for murdering his wife Kanta Devi on suspicious that in his absence, deceased had developed extra-marital relations. The accused alleged to have also warned and counselled the deceased, but the deceased did not mend her ways. Division Bench after hearing both the sides observed that In the wake of above discussed contradictions, improbabilities, discrepancies, improvements, conflicting opinion of the experts, etc, the justification of the trial Court that the testimony of PW-1 Des Raj is of sterling

nature do not inspire confidence, as it loses sheen and withers away and is overshadowed by doubt and consequently, also renders the prosecution case unworthy of reliance. DB arrived at the conclusion that the prosecution story is not free from reasonable doubt, in that event, as per the settled proposition of law the benefit of doubt belonged to the accused, which should have been granted by the trial Court. For the foregoing reasons, Division Bench is unable to concur with the findings of the trial Court, particularly when on every point under consideration we have noted deficiencies and flaws, which are staring at the heavy burden cast on the prosecution to prove the guilt beyond all shadow of doubt so as to rebut the presumption of innocence, which is a cornerstone of

criminal jurisprudence, therefore, accused cannot be sent behind the bars by curtailing his liberty on the basis of such fragile prosecution evidence. While giving benefit of doubt, Division Bench allowed the appeal and set aside the judgment of the trial Court order dated, December 17, 2015, passed by the Principal Sessions Judge, Udhampur, whereby the accused has been convicted for commission of offence under Section 302 RPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life and a fine of Rs. 6,000 for committing murder of his wife, namely, Kanta Devi (hereinafter referred to as "deceased") and in default of payment of fine, the accused shall undergo imprisonment for six months. DB further ordered that the appellant is acquitted of the charge.


