Whereas, pursuant to the selection made by the Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board vide No. JKSSB/Secy/Sel/Class-IV/2021/7103-11 dated 18-10-2021, Mr. Gourav Sharma S/o Yash Paul R/o 82, War No. 1, Platan Tehsil Khour District Jammu was appointed as MTS by the Administrative Department of Animal/Sheep Husbandry & Fisheries J&K vide Govt. Order No. 146-JK(ASH) of 2021 dated 22-10-2021 and he joined this office on 03-11-2021. He was further adjusted as Skirting Boy in Shearing Section Kartholi under the control of Joint Director (Farms), Sheep Husbandry Jammu vide this office Order No. 196-SHDJ of 2021 dated 30-11-2021; and

Whereas, Joint Director (Farms), Sheep Husbandry Department, Jammu vide his No.JDEJ/Esstt/2024-25/976-77 dated 18-10-2024 intimated that Mr. Gourav Sharma, Skirting Boy has tendered his resignation in his office on 17-10-2024, in view of his selection as Veterinary Pharmacists in Animal Husbandry Department Jammu and accordingly requested for acceptance of the same. He has also furnished an Affidavit duly attested by the Special Municipal Mobile Magistrate Jammu to the effect that there is nothing adverse/outstanding against him in the department; and

Whereas, this Directorate vide letter No. DSHJ-ESTT/28/2021/10017 dated 24-10-2024 directed Joint Director (Farms), Sheep Husbandry Department, Jammu to furnish the status of compliant/RDA/outstanding, if any, along with Last Pay Certificate in favour of the official; and

Whereas, Joint Director (Farms), Sheep Husbandry Department, Jammu vide his letter No. JDFJ/Esstt/2024-25/1172 dated 09-11-2024 followed by letter No. JDFJ/Esstt/2024-25/1941 dated 20-01-2025 intimated that there is nocompliant/RDA case/Vigilance case/outstanding against the official and also furnished Last Pay Certificate wherein salary has been paid up to 17-10-2024; and

Whereas, as reported by Vigilance Section of General Administration Department vide Form No. 337848 dated 05-06-2025, there is nothing adverse against Mr. Gourav Sharma; and

Whereas,the matter has been considered with reference to the rules governing the subject and it has been found that the above-said official has completed his probation and has qualified for the prescribed service for confirmation of probation on 21-10-2023. On account of this, his resignation is liable to be accepted in terms of Rule 200 of J&K Civil Services Regulations, 1956, on his own request.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Article 200 of Jammu & Kashmir Civil Service Regulations, 1956 Volume-I, the resignation of Mr. Gourav Sharma S/o Yash Paul R/o 82, War No. 1, Platan Tehsil Khour District Jammu from the post of Skirting Boy is hereby accepted, on his own request, he is discharged from the J&K Sheep Husbandry (Subordinate) Service with effect from 17-10-2024.
