

DC Reasi reviews PMAY-U 1.0, directs timely project completion

REASI: Deputy Commissioner Reasi, Nidhi Malik (IAS) chaired a comprehensive review meeting to assess the progress of the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U) 1.0 in the district.

During the meeting, the DC conducted a detailed evaluation of the scheme's implementation, focusing on beneficiary-wise progress, the pace of housing construction, and the disbursement of financial assistance.

Taking serious note of 34 non-starter cases - including 20 in Reasi town, 3 under Katra Municipality, and 11 from the Katra Development Authority - Deputy Commissioner Nidhi Malik issued immediate directions to fast-track the recovery process.

Out of a total of 744 sanctioned works, only 418 have been completed, indicating substantial delays.



Particularly in the Katra Development Authority (KDA) area, only 182 out of 424 sanctioned houses have been completed, highlighting significant pendency.

The DC further directed officials to prioritize stalled projects at the plinth, lintel, and roof levels, which have been delayed due to issues in fund disbursement. She instructed that pending pay-

ment cases be taken up urgently with the Housing Board to ensure timely release of installments and accelerate construction progress.

DC Nidhi Malik emphasized that recovery proceedings against defaulters must be concluded within a week, in accordance with PMAY-U 1.0 guidelines. She noted that beneficiaries have already

been given ample time and instructed officials to now take strict action against those who have failed to initiate construction.

It was informed that recovery action has already begun in Reasi town, with three beneficiaries having refunded the sanctioned amount and three more cases currently under process.

Addressing cases involving deceased beneficiaries, the DC directed officials to identify legal heirs and instruct them either to commence construction or return the financial assistance to the government.

The Executive Officer, Municipal Committee Reasi, reported that 64 houses are currently at various stages of construction. Similarly, the Executive Officer, Municipal Committee Katra, confirmed that 74 houses have been completed under PMAY-U 1.0.

DC Reasi also underscored the importance of frequent

field visits by officers to regularly monitor on-ground progress, address bottlenecks, and provide necessary support to beneficiaries to ensure timely completion of all houses.

In addition to PMAY-U 1.0, the progress of PMAY-U 2.0 was also reviewed. The DC directed both Executive Officers to intensify Information, Education & Communication (IEC) activities to enhance awareness and boost beneficiary enrollment.

Reiterating the vision of the scheme, the Deputy Commissioner emphasized that the timely and effective implementation of PMAY is crucial to achieving the goal of 'Housing for All'.

The meeting was attended by ADDC Reasi, Sukhdev Singh Samyal; EO Municipal Committee Reasi, Suresh Singh; EO Municipal Committee Katra, Rajat Abrol; and other concerned officials.

Forest Deptt cracks down on timber mafia: 52 FIRs lodged, 22 mechanical cutters seized

BHADERWAH: In a major crackdown on forest-related crimes, the Forest Department in Bhaderwah has intensified its drive against timber smuggling and illegal logging. Over the last two months, officials have registered 52 Forest Offences Cases and seized 22 illegal mechanical cutters used for unauthorized tree felling.

In addition to the machinery, dozens of illegally smuggled Deodar wood scants were also recovered during multiple operations carried out across Neeru and Chiralla Range of Bhaderwah Forest Division. These high-value timber logs were reportedly being transported in violation of forest regulations, pointing to the continued activity of the so-called forest mafia in the region.

"We have launched sustained operations across vulnerable zones and forest compartments. These results are just the beginning. Anyone involved in the illegal felling, transport, or sale of forest produce will face strict legal consequences," said DFO Bhaderwah Devinder Kumar.

Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) Bhaderwah, Devinder Kumar said, "Our forest protection teams have remained on high alert not only during the day but also



throughout the night. Continuous day and night

patrolling is being carried out across sensitive forest areas to curb illegal activities. In addition, we have established temporary nakas (checkpoints) along known smuggling routes to intercept illegal timber movement."

"Earlier, smugglers used basic tools like axes, but now they have shifted to mechanical cutters, which can fell trees in a matter of minutes. This poses a serious threat to our forest cover. Recognizing

the gravity of the situation, the buying and selling of mechanical cutters has been completely banned in Doda district," DFO added.

Kumar informed that "In the last two months alone, 52 forest offence cases have been registered under various sections of the Forest Act. We have seized 22 illegally used mechanical cutters and dozens of Deodar wood scants that were being smuggled.
