Missing boy traced, reunited with family

JAMMU: In a commendable display of prompt action and dedicated police work, Police Station Gandhi Nagar has successfully traced a missing person reported earlier this week and ensured his safe return to his family.

Vishal Bhagat, S/o Yash Lal Bhagat, a resident of House No. 517, Nai Basti, Jammu, was reported missing on 27/07/2025, and a missing report was registered at PS Gandhi Nagar vide DDR No. 17.

Upon receiving the report, the police team at Gandhi Nagar immediately swung into action. Under the close supervision of SDPO South and SP South, search efforts were initiated which included the collection of information from family members and acquaintances, scanning of CCTV footage from surrounding areas and outreach to local networks.

Due to the persistent and professional efforts of the officers, Vishal Bhagat was successfully located and traced today, i.e., 30/07/2025. After due verification, he has been safely handed over to his family. Necessary legal formalities and documentation have been completed at the police station.

Narco smuggler nabbed with heroin

DODA: In a significant operation today during routine Naka checking at Nalthi Naka, Bhaderwah, Doda Police apprehended an individual suspected of carrying illegal drugs. While monitoring a queue of vehicles, officers noticed a pedestrian disembark from an unidentified vehicle and head towards Bhaderwah town. The individual exhibited signs of nervousness upon spotting police and attempted to flee.

Police personnel swiftly intercepted the individual for questioning. A thorough search revealed a brownish substance, suspected to be heroin, weighing approximately 5-6 grams, concealed in transparent polythene, in his possession.

The suspect has been identified as Farooq Ali, son of Teg Ali, a resident of Nagri, Kathua. A case has been registered at Police Station Bhaderwah under FIR No. 109/2025, citing Sections 8/21/22 of the NDPS Act. The contraband has been confiscated, adhering to all legal protocols. The accused is currently in custody, and a detailed investigation is underway, focusing on establishing both forward and backward linkages in the drug trade.

Man nabbed with 140 rolls of banned Gattu Thread

JAMMU: In a significant crackdown on the illegal sale of hazardous kite-flying materials, the IC BPP Sandhwan, ASI Raj Singh Bhau and his team have arrested one person and recovered a large quantity of banned gattu thread.

A case FIR No. 171/2025 U/S 223 stands registered in police station, Domana. The accused, identified as Labbu Ram, son of the late Bodh Raj and a resident of Ward No. 3, Ghou Manhasan, was apprehended with 140 rolls of gattu thread a material known for its dangerous properties and marking a major recovery in the area.

Preliminary investigations indicate that Labbu Ram was distributing the banned thread through discreet mobile-based orders, attempting to evade law enforcement and public scrutiny.

Chain snatching case solved; 2 nabbed

JAMMU: In a swift and effective operation, Jammu Police have successfully solved a recent case of chain snatching reported in the Chinore area.

On 22/07/2025, a complaint was received at Police Post Chinore from a woman who reported that two unidentified individuals, with their faces covered, snatched her gold chain while she was returning home from duty. The culprits fled the scene on a scooter.

Acting promptly, police registered FIR No. 167/2025 U/S 307 BNS.

The investigation team lead by IC PP PSI Arjun Singh, Incharge Police Post Chinore assisted by PSI Tahir Shahir, conducted a thorough investigation under the close supervision of SHO Domana and SDPO Domana.

With the help of CCTV footage and technical analysis, the team identified and apprehended the accused: Sanjeev Kumar alias Lucky, S/o Mohinder Lal, R/o Janipur, Age 47 and Amit Kumar, S/o Late Ram Krishan, R/o Janipur Colony, Age 43.

Upon their disclosure, the snatched gold chain was recovered, and the scooter used

in the crime (JK02DB3187) was seized. The arrests and recovery were made in connection with FIR No. 167/2025 U/S 307 BNS.

The investigation is ongoing, with further developments anticipated.

The entire operation was conducted under the direct supervision of SSP Jammu Joginder Singh (JKPS) and SP Rural Jammu Brijesh Sharma (JKPS).

Police carry out proclamation proceedings against 3 accused persons

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday carried out proclamation proceedings against three accused persons here involved in a murder case through drum beating, pasting of notices on their homes and directing them to appear before the court and join the investigation, an official said.

The absconding trio are involved in the murder of Gataru gang leader Sumit Jandiwal in broad daylight at Jewel Chowk in the heart of the city on January 21 this year.

Ten accused were earlier arrested during subsequent investigations by police and four pistols, among other items, were recovered.

"Police have completed proclamation proceedings under Section 84 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita against three absconding accused involved in the murder case registered at Police Station Nowabad," said a police spokesperson.

The accused, who are evading arrest, have been identified as Khauff gang kingpin Vikas Slathia alias Vicky alias Vicky Khauff, shooter Vikramjeet Singh and Bodh Raj alias Guggi, he added.

The spokesperson said that "notices have been pasted at their respective residences" as part of the legal process.

"Public proclamation was also carried out by way of drum beating and announcements in their native localities, directing the accused to appear before the court and join the investigation," he added.

Police have also appealed to the general public to share any information regarding the whereabouts of these absconders with the nearest police station.

"Strict action as per law will be taken against anyone found harbouring or assisting them," the spokesperson said.

Jandiwal alias Gataru, reported to be the kingpin of the Gataru gang, was detained under the Public Safety Act (PSA) last year. He had survived an assassination attempt in 2017.

Jammu Police is committed to bringing all those involved to justice and ensuring safety and security of the citizens, he added.

Terror associate held at Nagrota; 3 pistols, ammunition recovered

JAMMU: In a significant arms recovery operation, Jammu Police apprehended one person at TCP Naka on Bypass Nagrota on monday, 29.07.2025.

The accused, identified as Azan Hameed Gazi S/o. Abdul Hameed Gazi R/o Hilalabad, Qamarwari, Srinagar, was intercepted while travelling from Jammu towards Srinagar in a Toyota Etios (registration number HR38Z/2066).

During the search of the vehicle, police personnel recovered three pistols, three empty magazines, eight live cartridges and two empty cartridges from a handbag concealed under the co-driver's seat. The accused failed to produce any valid documents or licenses for the recovered arms and ammunition.

Acting swiftly, police registered a case, FIR No. 170/2025, Section 3/25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Nagrota.

The accused has been taken into custody and further investigation is underway to trace the origin and intended use of the weapons.

Property worth Rs 10 lakh belonging to notorious drug peddler attached

UDHAMPUR: In a significant action against drug trafficking, Udhampur Police has attached moveable property valued at approximately Rs. 10 Lakhs under Section 68(F) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act.

The accused Ashraf S/O Abdul Rashid R/O Tankipura, Tehsil Devsar, District Kulgam is involved in FIR No. 163/2024 under Sections 8/21/22/29 of the NDPS

Act registered at Police Station Chenani. He is currently lodged in District Jail Udhampur and has a history of involvement in multiple NDPS-related cases.

The attached properties include Car bearing Reg. No. JK13B-1343; Tata Magic bearing Reg. No. JK18-5075.

The attachment order was issued by the investigating officer as part of ongoing legal proceedings against the accused.

Samba police traces out missing person, reunites with family

SAMBA: Samba Police has traced out a missing person and reunited him with family whose missing report was lodged at Police Post Utterbehani of Police Station Purmandal.
