

CRIME REPORT

4 arrested, 4 tractors seized for illegal extraction & transportation of minor minerals

BUDGAM: Acting tough against elements involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, Police on Sunday arrested 4 persons and seized 4 tractors involved in crime.

As per details, officers from Police Station Beerwah during patrolling near Nalla Sukhnag intercepted four tractors loaded with illegally extracted minor minerals. The tractors were seized and drivers identified as Nisar Ahmed Malik, son of Ali Mohammed Malik; Ajaz Ahmed Sheikh, son of Mushtaq Sheikh, both residents of Bhatipora Khag, Gulzar Ahmed Bhat, son of Ghulam Mohammad Bhat, resident of Sail Beerwah and Nazir Ahmed Mir, son of Ghulam Nabi Mir, resident of Kundora, Beerwah were arrested. They were shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 105/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Beerwah and investigation started.

2 notorious drug-peddlers booked under PIT NDPS Act

BUDGAM: Acting tough against drug peddlers and to eradicate menace of drugs from the society, two notorious drug peddlers were detained under PIT NDPS Act in Budgam.

Earlier two drug peddlers namely Javaid Ahmed Beigh, son of Abdul Rasheed Beigh, resident of Nasrullapora, Budgam and Mukhtar Ahmed Wani, son of Ghulam Mohammad Wani, resident of Bathar, Budgam were arrested for their involvement in drug peddling. Both drug peddlers were detained under PIT NDPS Act through orders issued by competent authority and were lodged in Central Jail Kot Bhalwal Jammu.

Bootlegger arrested with illicit liquor

HANDWARA: Acting tough against the social crimes, Police on Sunday arrested a bootlegger and recovered illicit liquor from his possession.

As per details, a party from Police Station Qalamabad at a checkpoint established at Yahama crossing intercepted one Gh Mohd Lone, son of Jabbar Lone, resident of Yahama. During checking, 20 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to police station where he remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 49/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Qalamabad and investigation started.

Three narco-smugglers nabbed with 20 gm heroin

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Jammu Police on Sunday nabbed three narco smugglers and recovered 20 gm heroin at three different Nakas in jurisdictions of Police Stations Bagh-e-Bahu, Akhnoor and Bakshi Nagar respectively.

As per details, a team from Police Station Bagh-e-Bahu led by SHO Bagh-e-Bahu Inspector Sakinder Singh while on Naka duty near Balidan Stamb, rounded up a suspect and on search, recovered 7 gm heroin from him. The suspect, identified as Arun Mehra, son of Madan Lal, resident of Ward-2, R S Pura, at present Sainik Colony near Jodhamal school, was arrested and FIR No.74/2022 under sec-

tions 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him in Police Station Bagh-e-Bahu. The whole operation was done under supervision of SDPO East Sayed



Abbas jafari.

Similarly, at another Naka point at Shunnu Chowk Jourian by a team of Police Station Akhnoor led by SHO Akhnoor Insp Hilal Azhar assisted by Incharge Police Post Jourian PSI Karnail Singh, rounded up a suspect later identified as Sharief Husain, son of Lal Hussain, resident of village Harakud, Tehsil Halqa Marah. On search, 8 gm heroin was recovered from his possession. The accused was arrested and FIR No. 223/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Akhnoor. The arrests and recoveries were made under supervision of SDPO Akhnoor Varun Jandial.

At another special Naka at Maheshpura Chowk led by a team from Police Station Bakshi Nagar led by SHO Insp Harjeet Singh, police rounded up a suspect later identified as Abhishek Khokhar, son of Sunil Khokhar, resident of Rajiv Basti, Bakshi Nagar. On search 5 gm heroin was recovered from his possession. The accused was arrested and his vehicle (JK02CH-6527) was seized. The overall arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SDPO West Rahul Nagar.

Shopkeeper arrested for selling banned Chinese Manja; 36 rolls seized

JAMMU: Police on Sunday nabbed a shopkeeper for selling banned synthetic thread and recovered 36 rolls of Chinese Manja (Gattu) from his shop.

As per the details, information was received at Police Post Talab Tillo regarding sale of banned synthetic thread, after which a team of Police Post Talab Tillo under supervision of DySP Hqrs Swati Sharma led by SHO Nowabad Insp Vijay Kumar assisted by Incharge Police Post Talab Tillo PSI Rajesh Kumar raided the place and rounded up a suspect, who was selling banned Chinese Manja. During search, 36 bundles of Chinese Manja (Gattu) were recovered. He was arrested and FIR under relevant sections was registered against him at Police Station Nowabad. The arrest was made in violation of DM order regarding ban on sale of plastic/synthetic threads



(Gattu). The arrested person was later identified as Gourav Gupta, son of Rakesh Gupta, resident of Talab Tillo.

Multiple bovine smuggling bids foiled; 31 animals rescued, 3 smugglers arrested

RAJOURI: Police on Sunday foiled multiple bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 31 animals from possession of three smugglers, who were arrested on the spot.

As per details, during a Naka checking at Thannamandi, police team from Thannamandi Police Station led by SHO Mohd Shoket Chowdhary intercepted a mini truck (JK11C 3972) driven by one Abdul Rashid, son of Abdul Rahim, resident of Dodasan Bala. During search, vehicle was found laden with 19 animals which were rescued. The driver of vehicle was arrested and a case under relevant sections of law was registered at police station.

Similarly, police foiled another bovine smuggling bid in which accused were transporting animals in a car. A team from Rajouri police station led by SHO Rajouri Fareed Ahmed during Naka checking intercepted an Alto car (JK11 3192) coming from Nowshera. The driver, on seeing Naka party at Kallar left vehicle at some distance and fled away. On checking, two animals were found loaded in vehicle, which were rescued and vehicle was seized. On the other hand, a team of police from Sunderbani police station headed by SHO S D Singh foiled two bovine smuggling bids by intercepting vehicles (JK02AP 1321 and JK11C 9677). Ten animals were found loaded in two vehicles. The animals were rescued, vehicles were seized and accused were arrested on the spot. Action against all those found involved in bovine smuggling is a priority of police and bovine smuggling bids are being foiled regularly.

CRPF Jawan dies of bullet injury

JAMMU: A CRPF Jawan posted with SoG camp died of bullet injury under mysterious circumstances on Sunday in Jammu.

As per details, a Jawan of 169 Bn, resident of Telangana received bullet injury accidentally by his INSAS rifle and died on the spot. On receiving information, police rushed to the spot and shifted body to morgue for autopsy. Further investigation is going on.

Maternal uncle rapes girl, arrested

JAMMU: A maternal uncle was arrested for raping a girl in Gharota area on Sunday.

As per details, parents of a girl lodged a complaint with police that the maternal uncle of the victim, who is a Govt teacher and posted in a school at Marjali, has raped their daughter. They further disclosed that their daughter used to stay at his uncle's home and he was repeatedly raping her for last one year, when she was a minor. Police, after getting conducted medical examination of girl, has registered case under POCSO Act and arrested accused. Further investigation is going on.

Mother-son booked for duping company of lakhs

As per details, Retd Colonel Pritam Chand, Director of the Company lodged a complaint with police that his showroom's accountant Shivraj Mir, resident of Janipur has misappropriated an amount of Rs 18 lakh as the amount has been deposited in his and his mother's joint account. Police has registered a case and started investigation.


