JAMMU: Keeping in pace with increasing number of patients requiring heart lung transplant in the country, first of its kind live hands-on workshop Thohart 2022 was organized at PSG Institute of Medical Sciences (PSGIMS), Coimbatore.

College Jammu was one of the ten participants in this workshop.

Dr Arvind chaired the session dedicated to installation of mechanical circulatory support like peripheral and central ECMO, which is frequently required in pre and post-cardiac transplant patients and the New Impella device and HeartMate.

The institute has a state of art skill lab and animal lab

facility within house cardiopulmonary infrastructure. Dr K.R. Balakrishnan, a leading Cardiac Transplant Surgeon of the country who along with his team has conducted 500 cardiac transplants, was the course director and Dr PR Murugesan, HOD CTVS PSGIMS, was the course coordinator.

Ten CTV surgeons from all over India were registered for this workshop. Apart from thorough under-

standing of preparation of a donor and recipient for heart and lung transplant, the workshop focussed on hands-on live surgical Donor heart and lung harvesting, preparing the recipient heart for taking up the transplant and finally the transplant on cardiopulmonary bypass.

All the participants got suitable skill enhancement for crucial heart lung transplant program.

Fencing work:- The key materials, like, Black Annealed Barbed wire, paint, brush, nails, ladder & Sign board etc. will be procured by contractor itself. JAMMU: Jammu and Kashmir Amateur Kabaddi Association shall hold selection trials for the 48th Junior National (girls) Kabaddi Championship to be held at Patna in Bihar from September 1 to 4. "The three-day selection process shall take place at Green Fields ground, Gandhi Nagar from August 6 to 8. Those eligible players have been advised to report the venue at 4 pm on the given date," informed General Secretary of the Association, Surinder Mohan Gupta. The eligibility shall be 65 kg and below body weight and below or 20 years of age as on September 4, 2022. Players reporting for the trials need to bring along two passport size photographs, photocopies of their Aadhar Card, Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India registration Card, domicile certificate of J&K, Medical Fitness Certificate and negative report of Covid Test. "Those who have not registered with the AKFI will not be eligible to participate in the said trials," general secretary further said.
