# 4 soldiers martyred in 'fidayeen' attack at Rajouri; 2 terrorists eliminated

LG condemns attack; vows to deal with terrorists, their supporters

JAMMU: Terrorists attacked an Army camp in Rajouri district on Thursday martyring four soldiers and the two attackers were gunned down in the shootout after the pre-dawn suicide strike that marked the return of 'fidayeen' to Jammu and Kashmir after more than three years.

Both the terrorists, who are believed to be from the Pakistan-based Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM), were heavily armed with deadly 'steel core' bullets and were

shot down after an over four-hour gun battle which started at 2 AM and ended just before 6.30 AM, police said. The attack came four days

ahead of 75th Independence Day next Monday.

Director General of Police Dilbag Singh told PTI that the two 'fidayeen' (suicide

## J&K Govt constitutes panel to probe patients' referral to Pvt hospitals

### 5 doctors banned from private practice

JAMMU: The Government on Thursday constituted a committee to conduct an in-depth enquiry of referral of patients by accused doctors from Public Hospitals to Private Hospitals for availing treatment/benefits under AB-PMJAY, & SEHAT Schemes," reads an order issued by Principal Secretary, Health and Medical Education, Manoj Kumar Dwivedi.

"Sanction is accorded to the constitution of a Committee to conduct an in-depth

enquiry into the issue related to referral of patients by the accused doctors, from Public Hospitals to Private Hospitals for availing treatment/benefits under AB-PMJAY, & SEHAT Schemes," reads an order issued by Principal Secretary, Health and Medical Education, Manoj Kumar Dwivedi.

As per the order Choudhary Mohammad Yasin, Mission Director National Health Mission, J&K will be Chairman of the committee while Shakoor Ahmad Dar, Deputy Secretary H&ME Department and Farooq Ahmad Thoker, Assistant Accounts officer, H&ME Department will be members

of the committee.

"The Committee shall submit its report to the Administrative Department, with concrete recommendations/remedial measures to curb such type of incidents in future. The Committee shall also suggest measures for better implementation/monitoring of the Scheme (s) on monthly basis," the order reads. "The State
