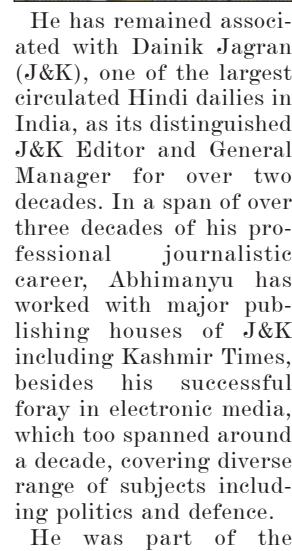
A circular issued by General Administration Department in this regard reads "In connection with Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav and commemoration of 75 years of India's Independence it has been
