Pensionary benefits to retired SRTC employees: 'Last & final' opportunity granted to Govt for complying Court's decision within 6 weeks

JAMMU: High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh granted 'last and final' opportunity of six weeks to the government to comply with the judgment and ensure pensionary benefits to 389 retired employees of J&K State Road Transport Corporation (SRTC). Justice Sanjeev Kumar while hearing contempt petition, further ordered that failure to submit compliance

report, ACS Finance, MD SRTC and Transport commission will appear in person.

The court was hearing a contempt plea filed by All J&K Workers Union SRTC seeking implementation of judgment passed by single-bench of the court whereby it had directed the Finance Department to consider the request of 389 retired employees of J&KSRTC regarding pensionary benefits within four

months. Allowing the plea, the court had held the petitioners entitled to all the retirement benefits, including pension and gratuity on the analogy of the employees of the corporation who were employees of the erstwhile Government Undertaking (GTU) and had opted for service of the corporation and also on analogy of their counterparts in the JKI and other corporations.

JAMMU: Justice Sindhu Sharma of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court upheld detention under PSA of two accused Faheem Sultan Gojree and Hamid Farooq Bhat, Over Ground Workers of TRF, passed by District Magistrate Srinagar and District Magistrate Kulgam respectively. The detenu have assailed the detention order No. 10/DIMK/PSA/2021 dated 18.10.2021 passed by District Magistrate Kulgam, vide which detenu namely Hamid Farooq Bhat has been detained under Section 8(a) of J&K Public Safety Act, 1978 to prevent him from acting in any manner prejudicial to security, sovereignty and integrity of the State. The detenu has assailed the order of detention through his brother namely Amir Ahmad Bhat.

SRINAGAR: Recently J&K became the first Union Territory to launch its own Unified Citizen Services Portal (https://eUnnat.jk.gov.in) incorporating 'Meri Pehehaan' (National Single Sign-on) to make available Citizen Centric Services to the common man under a single portal.

Furthering this mission the Chief Secretary, Dr Arun Kumar Mehta on Friday inaugurated integration of e-UNNAT with the national TEJAS Dashboard and the 'My Scheme' Portal.

Chief Secretary J&K directed the IT Department to take necessary steps for integrating the auto appeal and auto escalation mechanism with online services in accordance with amended

PSGA rules.

In this direction the Government here had even amended the PSGA (J&K Public Service Guarantee Act, 2011) with the aim to reach out to the common public and make available the G2C services in a timely manner. It is the endeavour of the Government to facilitate dissemination of e-Services to the public on one hand and to monitor; analyse and - if necessary - penalize the defaulters in service delivery, as per the service delivery time-lines defined in this Act.

The TEJAS Dashboard on e-UNNAT Portal would show, at a glance, the online e-service applications received, services delivered, applications pending, applications rejected et al, with the delayed services delivery

break-up further displayed on the basis of time delay periods, i.e., less than one week, one to two weeks, more than two weeks and so on. At the same time, eUNNAT Portal now also provides a glimpse into the My Scheme Portal of the Government of India by mapping, initially, six schemes of the Government of J&K and providing access to information on those by re-directing through a single URL. These six schemes are State Marriage Assistance Scheme for Poor Girls, Credit Card Scheme for Artisans, Revised Educations Scheme for Children of Weavers, Karkhadar Scheme and Grid Connecting Rooftop Solar Plant, Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evan Utthaan Mahabhilyaan(PM-KUSUM).
