125 J&K Police officers, personnel awarded; highest in State & UT Police forces

JAMMU: The Ministry of Home Affairs on Sunday announced 125 President's medals for Jammu and Kashmir Police personnel for gallantry, distinguished and meritorious services.

As per the list released by MHA, Jammu and Kashmir Police have been honoured with two President's Police Medal for Distinguished service, 15 Police Medal for meritorious service, 108 Police Medals for Gallantry. This is highest among State and UT Police forces.

ADGP Rajesh Kumar 1995 IPS officer of AGMUT cadre presently on deputation to CRPF; SSP Mohan Lal Kaith and DySP Janardhan Singh have been awarded the President's Police Medal for Distinguished Service, while police medal for meritorious service has been awarded to 15 Officers and officials.

Addl DGP Rajesh Kumar, an IPS officer of J&K cadre has also served as IG CRPF (Operations) Kashmir. Kumar is an IPS officer of 1995 batch and has held various postings in Jammu and Kashmir including IGP Jammu. Presently Rajesh Kumar is head of Northern sector of CRPF.

Mohan Lal Kaith, SSP Traffic Rural Jammu, was appointed as Sub Inspector in Jammu and Kashmir Police and worked in different capacities in Jammu District, as I/C PP Sarval, Palanwala, Addl SHO Samba, I/C PP Talab Tillo and Sarval respectively. The officer had also worked in the Kashmir Valley and after promotion to the rank of DySP, he remained posted as SDPO Bakshi Nagar, DySP Hops. Jammu, SDPO South Jammu, SDPO Border

Chadwal Jammu. After promotion to the rank of SP, the officer remained posted as Addl SP Rural Jammu. Refugees from Pakistan contributed in making of New India: Dr Jitendra

JAMMU: Union Minister, Dr Jitendra Singh said here on Saturday that refugees from Pakistan have immensely contributed in the making of New India. He said that while two of the refugees from West Pakistan, namely Dr Mamnoon Singh and Inder Kumar Gujral, went on to become Prime Minister of India, the contradiction was that those of the refugees from the same category who chose to settle down in Jammu & Kashmir were not even granted the right to vote in the State Assembly election or to contest for the State Legislative Assembly election.

However, he said, after Prime Minister Narendra Modi corrected this anomaly on 5 August 2019 by abrogating Article 370, now even a refugee from Pakistan settled in Jammu & Kashmir can contest the election and aspire to become an MLA or Minister or also Chief Minister of Jammu & Kashmir. Dr Jitendra was addressing a largely attended rally of West Pakistani refugees, held close to the International Border (IB) here. Earlier, he went to Bagh, the native village of Brig. Rajinder Singh, who had attained martyrdom during the Pakistan attack in 1947. Dr Jitendra said, refugees who were uprooted from Pakistan and had to

leave their homes and hearths at short notice to take shelter on the Indian side after partition, have an exemplary history of struggle and resurgence after going through the trauma of partition and also losing many of their near and dear ones in the riots that followed. After independence, he said, they contributed in every sphere of life and brought

pride to the nation. Not only this, two of India's Prime Ministers, namely Dr Mamnoon Singh and Inder Kumar Gujral are the erstwhile residents of West Pakistan, while former Deputy Prime Minister L K Advani hailed from Karachi, he added.

Unfortunately, however, Dr Jitendra Singh lamented that

because of the political interests of certain narrow minded elements and mechanisms in the name of Article 370, those of the refugees from Pakistan, who chose to settle in Jammu & Kashmir were deprived of their basic rights of citizenship as well as other opportunities available to their counterparts who had chosen to settle in other parts of India after independence in 1947.

Giving full credit to the courage of conviction and determination of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Dr Jitendra Singh said, West Pakistani refugees settled in and around Jammu had to wait for 72 years for Modi to take over as Prime Minister

and correct this anomaly. Referring to the completion of 75 years of India's independence, Dr Jitendra Singh said, India has proved to the rest of the world its capacity and inherent strength to thrive as a democratic independent nation and is now entering into the most critical phase of 25 years, which Prime Minister Narendra Modi has described as 'Amrit Mahakal'.

Dr Jitendra Singh expressed the hope that the next quarter century would mark the golden chapter in the growth story of India and Jammu & Kashmir will have a major role to play.
