Congress expresses shock over loss of lives due to heavy rains/floods

JAMMU: Jammu and Kashmir Pradesh Congress Committee has expressed shock over loss of lives and property besides crops due to heavy rains & floods.

In a statement J&K PCC has expressed deep shock over loss of five precious lives including three children in flash floods and rains and expressed sympathies with the bereaved family members. The party also expressed concern over the loss of property, infrastructure and crops etc. in different parts of Jammu province and demanded immediate relief, rehabilitation and restoration work.

JKPCC Chief spokesperson Ravinder Sharma demanded assessment of damage to the private and public properties for relief, rehabilitation and restoration work immediately. The Party also asked the LG administration to assess the damage to the crops in different areas and also loss of maze crops allegedly due to a defective seed carrying some infections as a result the crops has got a major disease.

Congress demanded adequate compensation and relief to the farmers after assessment of the damage to the crops. The party also demands special funds for restoration works of urgent nature on all fronts in all areas.

Centres / Farm Machinery Banks wherein the department is providing 40% to 80% subsidy which will ultimately generate employment opportunities for the youth. Parminder Singh, HDO briefed the farmers about the technical aspects of fruit plantation and importance of Horticulture sector in employment generation.

SRINAGAR: Jammu & Kashmir State Rural Livelihood Mission (JKRLM) on Monday conducted a two day workshop on homestay management for homestay owners in collaboration with the global travel technology company, OYO at Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology (SKUAST) Shalimar here.

The workshop aims to enable SHG members to learn about the processes involved in setting up home stays and to impart the skills to SHG members related to homestay management.

A total of 200 Homestay owners would be trained in the mega workshop by the Senior Trainers from OYO, Delhi. The trainee homestay owners will be trained in different spheres of Hospitality like Behavioural Skills, Marketing & Sales, Potential responsibilities, and Destination Promotion Skills. The training programme was attended by Mission Director JKRLM, Indu Kanwal Chib, Additional Mission Director, JKRLM, Riyaz Ahmad Beigh, Senior project Managers, District

Programme Managers, Block programme Mangers and SHG members of Umeed. It will also open up several new avenues of employment for people with different skill sets".

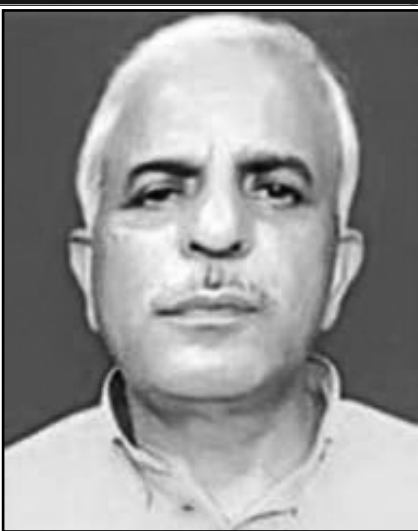

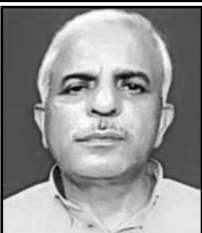
