

Jammu Admn establishes C-DYTE Centre at Chowki Choura

JAMMU: District Administration Jammu, under the guidance of District Development Commissioner, Avny Lavasa, on Wednesday established a C-DYTE Centre in far flung Sub Division Chowki Choura.

In view of hilly terrain and unfavorable geographic conditions of the area, the Centre would cover all the Panchayats of the Sub-Division on a rotational basis. The C-DYTE is a skill development initia-

tive of the District Administration, Jammu. It is functioning in 13 Blocks of Jammu District to equip the youth with necessary physical and mental skills and facilitate their recruitment in Defence Forces and other Competitive Exams. The local people, PRI Members, especially the youth hailed the Deputy Commissioner and District Administration Jammu for providing them an open platform to prepare for competitions. It is informed that the undersigned has announced the Award in respect of the said land under Section 3G of the NH Act, 1956 vide order No. DCR/CALA/ NH-144A/2022-23/81 dated 26.04.2022.

The land acquiring agency i.e MoRTH has placed the requisite amount of compensation at the disposal of the undersigned. Notices have also been issued to the concerned land owners/ interested persons as required under Section 3 E of the NH Act, 1956.

Accordingly, all the concerned land owners/ interested persons are hereby informed/ notified through this additional public Notice that the compensation amount is hereby offered to all such land owners. Further, it may be noted that:

1. The compensation amount in respect of all such land owners, who have already submitted their Bank account details, is being credited to their respective Bank Accounts through RTGS.
2. The land owners, who have not submitted their Bank Accounts details, may do so immediately in the office of the undersigned and the amount shall be credited to their accounts within one week of the receipt of such Bank Account details.
3. All other claimants entitled to receive the compensation amount may collect their amount of compensation from the office of the undersigned on any working day between 10:00 am to 4:30 pm within a period of 60 days.

It may further be noted that since the amount of compensation has been determined and tendered to the concerned land owners/ persons interested therein through this additional public notice, any failure to collect the compensation amount would be to their account and the amount shall be deemed to have been paid on expiry of this period of sixty days from the date of publication of this notice.

The land owners/ persons interested therein are further called upon to surrender or deliver the possession of the subject land to the undersigned, failing which the possession of subject land will be taken with police assistance on expiry of the period of 60 days.

It is hereby notified for information of all the concerned candidates that in order to prepare and notify the Provisional Merit List without any further delay, the Board has felt it necessary to give last and final opportunity to all such applicants listed in Annexure "A" to this Notice to submit their deficient documents (mentioned against their names) physically at BOPEE office Jammu/Srinagar or before 30-08-2022 positively (upto 04:00 P.M.) only during working days failing which their names shall not be included in the Provisional Merit List on their own risk & responsibility and no claim of such applicants, whatsoever reason(s), shall be entertained later on by the Board under any circumstances.

1. Any candidate who fails to submit their deficient documents within the last date i.e. 30-08-2022 upto 04:00 P.M. fixed by Board, his/her "candidature shall be automatically cancelled and shall not be considered to participate in Counselling process / admission in any case
2. Candidates who have applied under Spots category but their names are not recommended by J&K Sports Council shall be converted into OM (Open Merit) category.
3. The candidate(s) who have uploaded their expired category certificates or more than one category certificates, are advised to submit their valid category certificate issued by the Competent Authority, physically at BOPEE office Jammu/ Srinagar upto the last date mentioned in this notice, subject to the condition that their Category certificate should have been issued by the competent authority by or before the last date i.e.21-04-2022, fixed by the Board for filling up of online application forms as mentioned in various Notification/ Notice/e-information brochure available on BOPEE website.
4. The candidature of few candidates who are not found eligible by the Board are rejected.
5. 
