



Two narco-smugglers nabbed with heroin

JAMMU/KATHUA/SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of narcotic crop cultivation and drug abuse from society, the Excise enforcement teams led by Excise & Taxation Officers, South, North and Central Excise Ranges destroyed illicit Bhang spread over 64 Kanals of land. Meanwhile, till date total illicit Bhang, spread over on a total area of 1684 Kanals 15 marlas has been destroyed in Kashmir valley by Excise Department. Along with destruction drives, the Department also carried out interactive sessions regarding illicit cultivation of cannabis at Gousia Public school Kakapora, Pulwama, Rayji Memorial Higher Secondary School Anantnag etc. Besides, carrying out mass awareness campaign involving PRIs and Municipal Councilors, awareness camps were also conducted in Kralwari areas of Tehsil Chadoora, Budgam. The eradication drives and mass awareness campaigns shall continue till illicit Bhang (cannabis) in Valley is destroyed completely.

As per details, a team of Police Station Peer Mitha led by SHO Peer Mitha Insp. Mohd Rashid assisted by ASI Mohd Iqbal while on Naka duty at Circular road, rounded up a suspect. During search, 21 gm heroin was recovered from accused identified as Amu, son of Sher Ali, resident of Darala Tehsil Nagri, District Kathua, at present Barri Brahmana. He was arrested and FIR No. 48/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Peer Mitha. The arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kali. Similarly, at another Naka established by a team from Police Post Chinoor led by SHO Domana Insp. Tilak Raj assisted by Incharge Police Post Chinoor PSI Amit Singh and ASI Gurdev Raj, team rounded up a suspect, who

was moving towards Raipur chowk on motorcycle (Jk02CV-7265) and tried to flee on seeing police. He chased by police party and apprehended. Identified as Karan Kumar alias Goldi, son of Kaku Ram, resident of Nardani, Malpur Jammu, police recovered 5 gm heroin from possession of accused. He was arrested and FIR No. 307/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Domana. The arrests and recoveries in case were made under the supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh.

Drug-peddlers attack police party, 2 cops injured

MIRAN SAHIB: Intensifying drive against drug-menace and active drug-peddlers in area, a team from Police Station R S Pura raided a suspected location, but on seeing cops, peddlers attacked the team and managed to flee. Two policemen also got injured in the incident, who were shifted to hospital for treatment. According to reports, police on receiving information that some drug-smugglers are present in area, conducted a series of raids at several places. During such a raid in Kotli area, on seeing police, smugglers tried to flee. When cops chased them, they attacked police team, due to which two policemen got injured. The injured cops were immediately shifted to hospital for treatment. Police has registered a case and started investigation.

MVD seizes 24 vehicles, Challans 68, realises Rs 1.4 Lakh as fine from offenders

JAMMU: The teams of Motor Vehicles Department conducted enforcement drive at different places in Districts Jammu, Udhampur, Reasi, Doda, Poonch and Rajouri for checking plying of vehicles without High Security Registration Plates (HSRP), overloading, rash and negligent driving as also menace of private vehicles carrying school children unauthorisedly. During the drive, 24 vehicles i.e. Jammu = 9, Udhampur = 6, Reasi = 4 Poonch = 3 and Doda = 2 were seized for plying without HSRP and 68 vehicles were challaned for other violations under the Motor Vehicles Act and Central Motor Vehicle Rules. During the drive 10 vehicles which were found carrying school children by making commercial use of the vehicles un-authorisedly were also Challaned. An amount of Rs. 1,43,000 was realised on spot after compounding the offences and about Rs. 75,000 is also expected from the other Challans.

Excavator, 14 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU/KATHUA/SRINAGAR: An excavator and 14 more vehicles were seized for illegal mining. In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police team of Police Stations R S Pura, Bishnah, Police Posts Phallian Mandal and Jourian, acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at different locations besides seizing 6 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles included two tractor-trolleys without registration numbers seized by R S Pura police; a dumper (JK21H-9629) seized by Bishnah Police; a tractor-trolley bearing engine no. 47.5011/SAN24411 seized by Phallian Mandal Police and 2 Tractor-Trolleys without Registration number seized by Jourian Police. DMO Jammu was also intimated about the same. The recoveries were made by SHO Police Station R S Pura Insp. Pawan Kumar, SHO Bishnah Insp. Vikram Sharma, Incharge Police Posts Phallian Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal and Jourian-PSI Karnail Singh in their respective jurisdictions.

Budgam Police also arrested 5 persons and seized 5 vehicles involved in illegal mining. During patrolling at Uthgam Budgam, a party from Police Station Beerwah intercepted 5 vehicles loaded with illegally extracted sand. The accused drivers, identified as Ali Mohammad Malla, son of Mohammad Jaffar; Shahzad Ahmad Mir; son of Bashir Ahmad, both residents of Chandpora Budgam, Sajad Hussain Wani, son of Muhammad Jaffar; Asif Hussain Wani, son of Ghulam Hussain and Jehangir Ahmad Ganai, son of Muhammad Ibrahim, all residents of Gariend Kalan, Budgam were arrested. Vehicles (Tippers) bearing registration numbers JK01S-5011, JK04A-2037, JK03G-7034, JK15-0614 & JK09-618997 used in commission of crime were also seized. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Beerwah and further investigation started.

At Kathua, a team of Mining Deptt Kathua seized an excavator and 3 vehicles involved in illegal mining at Sahar Khad. Acting swiftly on a complaint lodged by residents of Kathura, District Mineral Officer Rajinder Singh along with mining guards rushed to Sahar Khad and seized 3 dumpers and an excavator found involved in illegal mining. A tractor-trolley fled from the spot, while the area of excavation in Sahar Khad was measured by officials and it was found that 1115 MT Nallah muck has been lifted thereby resulting in
