

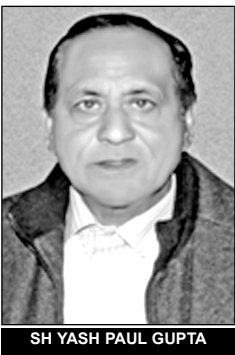

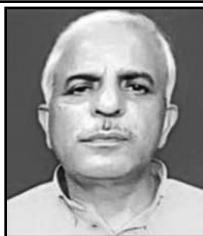

Video of traffic cop playing cards goes viral, inquiry ordered

Bike catches fire, rider safe

VDC members open fire after suspects spotted, search operation launched

RAJOURI: A search operation by Army and SOG personnel is going on in Budhal area of District Rajouri after some suspects were spotted in the village.

As per the police, a member of the Village Defense Committee VDC was patrolling the village during the night and on noticing a suspect firstly he pelted stones and later opened fire. In response, the suspect also started firing. After a while the sound of gunfire subsided and suspects fled from there. According to the information, this incident took place at around 9 pm on Tuesday when a VDC member of Shahpur village who was patrolling the village during night time, some suspects started pelting stones at him. He gave a warning to them but when he was injured by stone pelting, he opened fire. Hearing the gun shots, other VDC members also reached the spot and they also opened fire on the suspects. In response, the suspects also started firing bullets. Due to the firing from both the sides, an atmosphere of panic prevailed in the village. Before the villagers were alert, the suspects fled. VDC members immediately informed the army and police about this. On this, Army and SOG personnel reached spot and cordoned off the village. The search operation which was going on since night is still going on. Police said that no suspect has been seen so far.

Cyber Police Jammu arrests man for sharing obscene pics & videos of girl

JAMMU: Cyber Police Jammu on Wednesday nabbed a man for sharing obscene pics & videos of a girl. As per the details, On July 31, 2022, a written complaint was submitted by a victim (name withheld), resident of Kupwara, Srinagar at present Jammu stated therein that an unknown person started threatening and black mailing her through Whatsapp messenger and Instagram. by sending her morphed videos/pictures and also the said unknown person made viral these photographs/ videos through online social media platforms. On this information, FIR No. 41/2022 U/S 66-E/67-67-A IT ACT was registered at Cyber Police Station Gandhi Nagar Jammu and investigation of the case was entrusted to Insp. Javid Chowdhary of Cyber Police Station Jammu. On further investigation/technical analysis one person namely Ashkay Dogra, son of Ashok Kumar; resident of Gangwal Jammu surfaced in the commission of said crime. SP Operation Naresh Singh constituted special teams comprising of Inspector Javid Chowdhary and Inspector Ravi Kant, along with other Police Officials under the supervision DSP Cyber Wasim Hamdani and the team acted swiftly and raided on different suspected locations to apprehend the accused/black mailer. The three mobiles and one Laptop were recovered from the possession of the accused and it was found that the said accused have used the 3 mobiles for the commission of above said crime. Cyber Police Jammu appeal general public to remain aware against such Cyber crimes and not to get trapped and report immediately the commission of any such cyber crime to the Cyber Police Station Jammu.

Drug peddler nabbed with 300 bottles of banned syrup, 700 intoxicating capsules

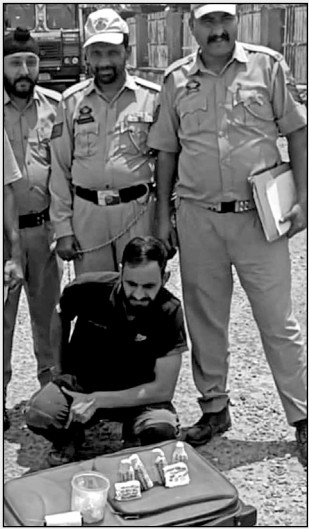

KATHUA: Foiling a Major bid of smuggling banned drugs, Kathua Police under the overall supervision of SSP Kathua R C Kotwal on Wednesday nabbed a drug peddler and recovered/seized 300 bottles (100 ml each) Cocorex and Omerex cough syrup like contraband along with 700 Spasmo-Proxyvon Plus (SPX+) capsules which were being smuggled from Punjab towards Kashmir Valley, J&K UT. As per the details, acting on specific information, a team of Police Station Lakhampur led by Insp. Vijay Kotwal SHO Lakhampur under the supervision of DySP DAR Kathua Sukhdev Singh laid Naka at Lakhampur and intercepted one person namely Irshad Ahmed Shah, son of Ab. Rehman Shah, resident of Takiya Hugam Tehsil Bijbehara District Anantnag who was enroute from Punjab towards Kashmir Valley. During frisking, 300 bottles of "Cocorex and Omerex" cough syrup like contraband alongwith 700 Spasmo Proxyvon Plus (SPX+) capsules were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 67/2022 under sections 8/21/22/ NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Lakhampur.

79 bovines rescued, 5 smugglers nabbed

UDHAMPUR/JHAJJAR KOTLI: Police on Wednesday foiled bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 79 bovines and arrested 5 smugglers. As per the details, a party of Police Station Chenani headed by SHO PS Chenani Insp. Om Parkash under the supervision Ahmad Shaafi SDPO Chenani established a Naka at motorshed area for checking of vehicles. During checking, police signalled to stop 2 trucks (JK14D 4248 and HR61 A 4815) for checking. On physical checking of both the vehicles, police team found 50 bovines illegally loaded in the above said vehicles in a very cruel manner and were rescued by police. The driver of both the trucks namely Mohd. Maroof, son of Hussain Din, resident of Gran Morh Reasi and Mohd. Riyaz, son of Mohd. Bashir, resident of Jallo Chak, Jammu were arrested on the spot and 2 FIRs under relevant sections of law were registered against them in Police Station Chenani. In another case, a party of Police Station Udhampur led by Insp. Chaman Gorkha SHO Udhampur under the supervision of Sahil Mahajan DySP Hqrs. Udhampur intercepted one vehicle (JK14F 0240) and rescued 27 bovines at Jakhani Naka point which were illegally transported towards Kashmir valley without any valid permission. 2 smugglers namely Shabir



Ahmed, son of Mohd. Saleem, resident of Basantgarh and Rehmat Ali, son of Sawar Din, resident of Jharkhar Udhampur were arrested. In this regards, case under relevant sections of law was registered against them in Police Station Udhampur. Meanwhile, at Naka Point Suketar, One Mahindra Pick-up (JK02BK/1803) which was on its way from Jammu to its destination point stopped for checking purpose by police. During checking, police found that the said vehicle loaded with two bovines without any permission in a cruel and merciless manner without fodder and water. Driver namely Jaswant Singh, son of Gian Singh, resident of Pargwal Akhnoor was arrested, vehicle seized and bovine animal rescued. FIR No.190/2022 under sections 188 IPC,11 PCA Act,50,52,54,56 Transportation of Animals of Rules of 1978 was registered against him in Police Station Jhajjar Kotli.

Two arrested for eve-teasing

JHAJJAR KOTLI: Police on Wednesday arrested two persons for eve-teasing.

As per details, a complaint was lodged by a man resident of New Delhi with Police Station Jhajjar Kotli in which he alleged that he along with his wife after returning from Katra were taking bath in the Jhajjar Nallah when some boys started doing obscene acts in public to his wife. Acting over the complaint, a case under FIR Number 191/2022 under section 294 and 34 IPC was registered and a team from Police Station Jhajjar Kotli led by SHO Inspector Vikram Sharma conducted raid on the spot and arrested two persons. The arrested persons were identified as Ramesh Singh of Shailain Tehsil Ramkot District Kathua and Makhan Lal of Jhajjar Kotli District Jammu. Further investigation into the case is going on.

Woman immolates self; in-laws booked

As per the details, Priya Devi, wife of Rahul, resident of Last Morh, Bagh-e Bahu tried to commit suicide by setting herself ablaze by sprinkling kerosene oil. She was shifted to hospital where she is under treatment. Later, parents of the victim lodged a complaint with police that her in-laws were harassing her for dowry for the couple of time. After complaint, police has registered a case against her in-laws and started investigation.

Two rape accused nabbed
