Fencing work:- The key materials, like, Black Annealed Barbed wire, paint, brush, nails, ladder & Sign board etc. will be procured by contractor itself. The contractor shall ensure quality of fencing material as per the specifications mentioned in the tender documents. **Successful bidder shall seek a quality certificate in respect of Barbed Wire from SICOP/Authorized agency and passed certificate from the verifying committee formed by this Division on spot physical inspection of the material before using of the same.**Further, in respect of wooden fence posts, these shall be provided from the available material in nearby forest compartment duly extracted under the close supervision of Range Forest Officer concerned. Whereas, vide Notice No. SSB/COE/CBT/2022/857-66 dated 02-02-2022, the Board called upon all such candidates falling in consideration zones to appear physically for Document Verification before the designated Counselling Cum Document Verification Committees w.e.f., 07-02-2022 onwards as per the dates/time shown against each in the Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board, Divisional Office, Sehkari Bhawan, Rail Head Complex, Jammu (Jammu Based Candidates) and in the Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board, Central Office, Zumzum Building Rambagh, Srinagar (Kashmir Based Kashmir) respectively; and,

Whereas, in order to fill up all the requisitioned vacancies, the JKSSB vide notice no: SSB/COE/CBT/2022/3801-08, dated: 08-04-2022, all such candidates who had submitted multiple (2) application forms for aforesaid posts/items, were called to indicate order or preference for all such posts/ items, through the link provided on the official website of the board and were falling under the consideration zone to indicate their order of preference for all such posts/items which they had filled through the link provided on the official website of the board [www/jkssb.nic.in](http://www.jkssb.nic.in) from 15-04-2022 to 18-04-2022; and

Whereas, the selection Committee on the basis of merit cum preference principle prepared a provisional Selection List/ Allocation of departments of eligible candidates; and

Whereas, the provisional Selection List/ Allocation of cadre was placed before the Board in its 205th meeting held on 13th of July 2022, and after threadbare discussions, the Provisional Selection List was notified vide Notification No. SSB/Secy/Sel/2022/5220-28 dated 13.07.2022; and

Whereas, objections/representations were sought from the candidates through online mode for five days, from the date of issuance of provisional selection list; and

Whereas, the Board received 34 representations from the candidates including those in whose cases the recommendations were withheld subject to production of valid requisite documents; and

Whereas, these representations alongwith the recommendations of the committee were placed before the Board in its 207th Board meeting held on 29.07.2022; and

Whereas, the Board after threadbare discussion and verifying all the documents, considered the representations on merit and decided to release the withheld recommendations in favour of candidates who have submitted relevant requisite documents.
