

Justice Moksha Khajuria Kazmi visits Ganderbal

GANDERBAL: Justice Moksha Khajuria Kazmi, Judge High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, Administrative Judge of District Ganderbal on Saturday visited District Court Ganderbal. During the visit, the Administrative Judge Ganderbal chaired a meeting to inspect judicial work and take stock of the status of infrastructure matters of the District Judiciary Ganderbal.

The meeting was attended by Principal District and Sessions Judge Ganderbal, Jeena



Bashir, Deputy Commissioner Ganderbal, Shyambir, Sr. Superintendent of Police Ganderbal, Nikhil Borkar, Executive Engineer R&B Division Ganderbal, Judicial Officers and the members of Executive Committee of Bar

Association. During the meeting, issues pertaining to judicial infrastructure including the land acquired for the construction of the new District Court Complex, Ganderbal was discussed. Justice Moksha directed the Executive Engineer,

R&B to identify space for construction of an additional building for accommodation of the Court of Additional District & Sessions Judge, Ganderbal, Bar room and Bar Library. The Judge impressed upon the judicial officers to ensure the speedy disposal of the cases. After taking stock of the Court functioning, the Administrative Judge also interacted with the members of Bar Association Ganderbal during which officiating President of the Bar Association Ganderbal apprised the Judge of various issues including the providing

of Chambers for Lawyers equipped with necessary facilities. The Administrative Judge assured them that their demands would be considered on priority and will be resolved in a time bound manner. Meanwhile, the Administrative Judge also visited the land earmarked for construction of new District Court Complex, Ganderbal and directed the Executive Engineer concerned to furnish the latest updated status of the same. Earlier, Judge was accorded Guard of Honour by the District Police, Ganderbal.

CRIME REPORT

House burgled at New Plot; cash, jewellery stolen

JAMMU: A house was burgled in Puran Nagar, New Plot area from where thieves decamped with jewellery and cash amounting to Rs 15,000. As per details, a complainant namely Prem Kumar Khajuria, son of Late Rattan Lal Khajuria, resident of F-455, Puran Nagar, New Plot lodged a complaint with Police Post Rehari stating that thieves targeted his house when he along with family members were out for some work. He further stated that thieves broke panel of main door and entered the house. He told that thieves decamped with Rs 15,000 cash, a ladies gold ring, two sets of gold ear-rings; two ATM cards, etc. Taking cognizance of the matter, police has registered a case under sections 454/380 of IPC and started investigation.



3 vehicle theft cases solved; accused held, 6 stolen bikes recovered

KATHUA: In continuation to drive launched by District Police Kathua against vehicle/bike lifters active in District, Kathua Police under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal apprehended an intra-state vehicle lifter namely Mohd Altaf, son of Late Peer Mohd Shah, resident of Dungara, Tehsil Billawar District Kathua while his brother namely Alkaz alias Sonu is absconding, who used to steal vehicles and further sold the same at cheaper rates. During sustained questioning, he confessed his involvement in theft cases in the jurisdiction of Police Stations Lakhnappur & Billawar. On his disclosure, 6 motorcycles (3-Pulsar; 1-Splendor; 1-Passion Pro and 1-Bullet) worth Rs 7,25,000 were recovered by Police Station Lakhnappur. In this way, theft cases of Police Station Lakhnappur and Billawar were solved whereas Kathua Police has launched a manhunt for other persons involved. The interrogation of t suspect is going on as it is expected that he will disclose many links thereby resulting in recovery of more vehicles. The recovery of motorcycles were made by Incharge Police Post Basantpur; SHO Police Station Lakhnappur under the guidance of DySP DAR Kathua. It is pertinent to mention here that out of six vehicle theft cases solved, two cases were registered at Police Station Billawar vide FIR No. 100, 101/2022 under sections 379 of IPC and other cases were registered at Police Station Lakhnappur vide FIR No. 69/2022 under sections 379 of IPC.



Five narco-smugglers nabbed with heroin

RAJOURI: Continuing drive against all those involved in illegal trade and smuggling of narcotics, Rajouri police on Saturday arrested five peddlers along with a consignment of heroine like substance. Police said that during routine checking and frisking at Salani bridge, a team of Police Station Rajouri led by SHO Rajouri Fareed Ahmed under Supervision of DySP Hqs Rajouri Vinod Sharma intercepted a Santro Car (JK11F 3273), driven by one Aurangzeb Ali, son of Mohd Iqbal, resident of Sialsali, at present Dhanidhar with a co-driver identified as Zulfikar Ali, son of Mohd Iqbal, resident of Koteldhara. During checking, police recovered 50 gm heroin from possession of duo who was arrested and FIR No 420/2022 under sections 8/21/22/25 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Rajouri. Earlier, Rajouri Police arrested three persons along with 15 gm Heroin like narcotic substance. A team headed by SHO Rajouri Fareed Ahmed under supervision of DySP Hqs Vinod Sharma while on patrolling intercepted three person who were found smuggling narcotics. The arrested persons were identified as Assad Iqbal, son of Mohd Yaqoob, resident of Dhanidhar; Ajaz Ahmed, son of Mohd Rayaz, resident of Dhanore Gorsian and Munshi Khan, son of Khan Mohd, resident of Dhanidhar. FIR No. 419/2022 under sections 8/21/25 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Rajouri.

Shopkeeper arrested with 30 rolls of banned Chinese thread

JAMMU: Police on Saturday nabbed a shopkeeper with 30 rolls of banned Chinese thread. As per the details, information was received at Police Post Chowk Chabutra regarding sale of banned synthetic thread. On this, a team from Police Post Chowk Chabutra under supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kahl led by SHO Pacea Danga Inspr Raghubir Singh assisted by Incharge Police Post Chowk Chabutra PSI Jyoti Choudhary raided at suspected place near Dak-khana Chowk and rounded up a suspect, who was selling banned Chinese Manja. During search, 30 bundles of Chinese Manja (Gattu) were



recovered from his possession. In this regard docket was sent to Police Station Pacea Danga for registration of FIR and accused was arrested. The arrest was made in violation of DM order regarding ban on sale of plastic/synthetic threads (Manja). The arrested person was later identified as Ajay Singh Chib, son of Subash Singh Chib, resident of House No 855, Janipur colony, near Tri-Murti Mandir, Jammu.

Minor boy among two missing persons traced, reunited with families

AKHNOOR/JAMMU: Police on Saturday traced two persons including a minor boy and reunited them with their respective families. As per details, on February 25, 2019 a complainant namely Monika Sharma reported at Police Station Domana that her husband, Amrit Sharma, son of Shiv Ram Sharma, resident of Muthi went missing from home. On this, a missing report was registered and a team was constituted led by ASI Rattan Lal, which after putting in hectic efforts, traced out the missing person. After completing all the legal formalities, he was handed-over to his legal heirs. Meanwhile, on July 20, 2022 a complaint was lodged at Police Post Jourian by legal heirs of a boy, stating that he went missing from his house. In this regard, FIR. No 224/2022 under sections 363 IPC was registered at Police Station Akhnor and investigation started. Special police team led by SHO Akhnor Hilal Azhar and Incharge Jourian Karnail Singh was constituted under the supervision of SDPO Akhnor Varun Jandial, which on basis of technical inputs, traced and recovered missing boy from Karnal, Haryana. Subsequently family of missing boy was informed and he was handed over to family members after completing all legal formalities.

Bootlegger arrested with 40 bottles of illicit liquor

JAMMU: Police on Saturday nabbed a bootlegger and recovered 40 quarters of illicit liquor from his possession. As per details, information was received at Police Station Domana regarding a bootlegger indulged in selling illicit liquor in the area. After this, a team of Police Station Domana constituted under supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh led by SHO Domana Inspr Tilak Raj rounded-up an accused namely Laxman Sahu, son of Baisakhi Sahu, resident of Jahangir Champa, Chhattisgarh at present Machine Domana, Jammu. During search, 40 quarters of illicit liquor were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Domana.

Two arrested; 7.4 Kg poppy straw recovered

RAMBAN: Police on Saturday foiled narco-smuggling bids by arresting two peddlers and recovered 7.4 Kg poppy straw from their possession. As per details, a Naka party from Police Station Ramsoo intercepted a Truck (PB 07 AS 0661) for checking, driven by one Tarseem Lal, son of Underjeet, resident of Dharampura Rajada Qadian District Gurdaspur; Punjab. During search of vehicle, 3 Kg Poppy Straw like substance was recovered from the possession of accused, who was arrested and FIR No 85/2022 under sections 8/15 of NDPS Act was registered against him in Police Station Ramsoo. In an another, during the routine checking of vehicles at Naka point near main gate Police Station Ramsoo, a police party intercepted a Santro car (JK02-AC 5989) for checking driven by one Rishav, son of Kamal Kumar, resident of Hardonuthi Rajbagh, Tehsil Marheen, District Kathua. During search of vehicle, 4 Kg 490 gm Poppy Straw like substance was recovered. The driver was arrested on the spot and FIR No 86/2022 under sections 8/15 of NDPS Act was registered against him in Police Station Ramsoo. The overall recoveries and arrests were made by police parties headed by PSI Arun Singh and PSI Arun Thakyal under supervision of Insp Naeem Ul Haq, SHO Ramsoo and Nissar Ahmad Khoja, SDPO Banihal and under overall supervision of Mohita Sharma, SSP Ramban.

LPG cylinder caught fire, 4 injured

RAJOURI: Four persons suffered burn injuries after a LPG cylinder caught fire in a Govt School, when officials were preparing mid-day meal. As per details, at about 11:45 AM, while cooking mid-day meal at Government Middle School Draman, LPG cylinder caught fire due to leakage in gas pipe, causing burn in injuries to 4 persons, who were shifted to CHC Kandi from where they were further referred to GMC Rajouri. The injured were identified as Maryam Begum (32), daughter of Abdul Latief (Teacher); Shahnaz Akhter (35), wife of Shoket Ali (Cook); Shoket Ali (40), son of Abdul Hameed (local) and Saleem Akhter (55), wife of Mohd Iqbal (local); all residents of Draman Budhal.

3 drug-peddlers arrested, contraband substances recovered

AWANTIPORA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs from the society, Police has arrested three drug peddlers in Awantipora and recovered contraband substances from their possession. As per details, a party of Police Post Reshipora led by Incharge Police Post Reshipora under the supervision of SDPO Awantipora Mumtaz Ali Bhatti intercepted two suspects at Railway Station crossing Panzgam. On checking, 1500 gm Charas like substance was recovered from their possession. The accused, identified as Abdul Rashid Bhat, son of Somullah Bhat & Shanin Ahmad Ganie, son of Ghulam Ahmad Ganie, both residents of Pattan, Baramulla, were arrested and shifted to Police Station where they remained in custody. During preliminary questioning, they revealed that one more notorious/ habitual drug peddler namely Bilal Ahmad Dar, son of Asan Dar, resident of Lidernud is also involved in business of selling, purchasing and consumption of Narcotics. Accordingly, on their disclosure a police party along with Executive Magistrate Litter raided house of Bilal Ahmad Dar and during search, recovered 1 Kg Cannabis powder (Charas) and other incriminating materials used in drug peddling. The drug-peddler Bilal Ahmad Dar was also arrested from the spot. Accordingly, FIR No. 186/2022 under relevant sections of law stands registered at Police Station Awantipora and investigation started.
