## DDC member holds meeting with jal shakti, flood control and irrigation officials

AKHNOOR: BJP leader and member DDC, Suresh Sharma on Friday held a review meeting with the officers of Jal Shakti, Flood Control and Irrigation Department at PWD (R&B) Guest House Akhnoor. While reviewing the progress of Jal Shakti Department, the main concern was scarcity of drinking water and requirement of necessary measures to ensure adequate water supply to the public.

Suresh Sharma viewed that people in hilly areas are struggling to get drinking water and if a motor pump gets defunct, it takes one month to repair it as a result of which many water supply schemes are not working and public is suffering badly. He asked the officers to ensure that motor pumps are got repaired within 3 to 4 days so that public may not suffer for drinking water. He also emphasized to speed the process of water supply schemes that are being developed under Jal Jeevan Mission and NRDWP.

The officers of Flood Control Department were asked to take necessary steps to protect those lands which have gotten damaged and eroded due to flash floods during rainy season. A detailed discussion was also held in respect of those villages that have suffered a great loss due to raise in water of

river Chenab. He asked them to ensure timely action to protect the land of farmers so that they may not suffer in future.

Suresh Sharma also discussed development works related to Irrigation department especially in respect of Pratap Canal. He viewed that the farmer of block Khour and complaining that they are not getting proper benefit of the canal because the water is not reaching up to tail end. He asked the officers to take necessary steps to improve irrigation facilities for farmers.

Suresh Sharma also asked the officers of Irrigation department to construct new channels of existing Irrigation schemes in block Chowki Choura and block Maira mandrian and also start new schemes for the benefit of farmers. He also insisted for timely desiltation of canal and its channels.
